The Middletown Police Department in conjunction with the Cromwell Police Department conducted an investigation into the sale of narcotics occurring in both jurisdictions by the above arrested, Goodrich and Landry.

At approximately 6:15pm Middletown Officers stopped Goodrich while he was operating a 2012 Dodge Ram. Goodrich, the Dodge Ram and his residence were all subject to a search and seizure warrant. While attempting to stop Goodrich he lead the police on a slow paced pursuit violating several motor vehicle statutes and then crashing his vehicle into a garage door at 256 Condon Street East in Middletown. Goodrich fought with officers while they were trying to conduct their investigation and advised the officers that he was under the influence of PCP. Heroin was later found in Goodrich's vehicle and his passenger, the above arrested, Jordan, who was threatened by Goodrich to hide more heroin. Jordan hid the heroin in her genital area.

Middletown and Cromwell officers then proceeded to Goodrich's residence where he resides with the above arrested Nichole Landry. Landry was located at a package store and detained. While at the package store, officers determined that Landry left her two-year-old child unattended at the residence. There was a slider door left open that lead to a balcony on the third floor posing an immediate risk to the two-year-old. DCF was contacted and also initiated an investigation. The two-year-old was turned over to a suitable care giver.

In the residence more heroin was found as well as packaging material, a scale and several other narcotic related items.

The total street value of the heroin was estimated to be worth \$19,600.
