City of Middletown Hosts Electronics Recycling Day

Mayor Dan Drew reminds residents that The City of Middletown in cooperation with Take 2, Inc. will be hosting a **FREE** Residential Electronic Recycling Collection event at Lawrence School on Kaplan Drive. Residents are encouraged to bring their unwanted residential electronics to Lawrence School on Saturday October 1st, 2016 between 9am and 1 pm.

Take 2 Inc. will be on site to unload vehicles and safely package and transport all equipment to their Waterbury facility to be responsibly and securely recycled. All of these services are being provided with no cost to the taxpayers.

Accepted materials include, but are not limited to: Computers, Laptops, Printers, Fax Machines, Monitors, TVs, Cell Phones, Tablets, Video Games, game consoles, VCR/DVD Machines, Remotes, Keyboards, Small Appliances, Light Bulbs and Batteries. **Unaccepted materials** include: smoke detectors,

propane tanks, paint, household hazardous waste and appliances containing Freon, i.e. air conditioners, refrigerators, dehumidifiers.

This event is open to all Connecticut residents. Middletown residents who cannot make this event, may bring their residential electronics to the Middletown Recycling Center, located on the corner of Johnson St and North Main Street. The Recycling Center is open Monday – Friday 7am – 3pm and every Saturday through November 7am – 12noon.

Take 2 Inc. is a Waterbury based electronics recycler. Take 2 is approved by the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection as a Covered Electronics Recycler in conjunction with Connecticut's Electronics Recycling Law, RCSA 22a-638-1. All equipment will be transported by Take 2 to their facility for responsible and secure recycling.
