1. Call to Order

Deputy Mayor Vincent Loffredo, as Chair, calls the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Call of the Meeting

The Acting Clerk of the Common Council reads the Call of the Meeting and the Chair declares the call a legal call and the meeting a legal meeting.
