Minutes of the Board of Ethics
Special Meeting of 11 July 2023

Present: Chair John F. Shaw, other members Gregory Harris, Deborah Kleckowski (as of 4:15 p.m.), Stanley Sadinsky. Absent: Sarah Steinfeld.

Mr. Harris acted as temporary secretary by unanimous consent.

Mr. Shaw called the meeting to order at 4:03 p.m.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved by unanimous consent.

The Board officially received complaint no. 23-05.

The Board went into executive session at 4:04 p.m. by unanimous consent to consider and discuss complaint no. 23-05.

In executive session, the Board considered and discussed complaint no. 23-05. Ms. Kleckowski joined the meeting at 4:15 p.m. during the executive session.

At 4:31 p.m., the Board rose from executive session by unanimous consent.

In regular session, Mr. Harris moved adoption of the following resolution:

“RESOLVED that complaint no. 23-05 be and it hereby is DISMISSED because it repeats the substance of the complainant’s previous complaint already dismissed. Had we entertained the present complaint on its merits, we would have dismissed it for failure to make out a violation by the respondent of any part of the Ethics Code, including the one cited in the present complaint.”

Mr. Shaw inquired whether any member wished to remark. Hearing none, he asked if there were any objection to the adoption of the resolution. Hearing

none, Mr. Shaw announced that the resolution was adopted by unanimous consent.

At 4:35, Ms. Kleckowski moved to adjourn. Mr. Sadinsky seconded the motion. There being no objection, Mr. Shaw declared the meeting adjourned by unanimous consent at 4:35 p.m.
