



Connecticut's Jobs Bill

One of the most encouraging, and important, accomplishments of the 2010 legislative session was the passage of the "jobs bill", Public Act 10-75. This bipartisan measure provides Connecticut businesses and entrepreneurs with a number of new tools to grow and expand operations in the state. Below are the newly created programs and their contacts.

New Programs

Small Business Assistance Revolving Loan Program

Creation of a \$15 million small business loan program where small businesses and nonprofits can receive up to \$500,000 in loans and lines of credit.

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Small Business & Vocational Rehabilitation Job Creation Tax Credit Programs

Expansion of the state's job creation tax credit program to include small businesses and companies that hire workers with disabilities.

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Angel Investor Tax Credit Program

Creation of an angel investor tax credit program that will provide 25 percent personal income tax credits for up to \$100,000 in angel investments in bioscience, photonics, information technology and green technology businesses. Visit www.ctangeltaxcredit.com for more information.

Pre-seed Financing Program

Creation of a \$5 million pre-seed financing program for businesses developing innovative concepts.
