The Role of a Commissioner of the City of Middletown Commission on the Arts is:

- To work towards the fulfillment of the mandates outlined in the Establishing Ordinance and the Bylaws of the Commission
- To regularly attend monthly meetings generally held on the fourth Wednesday of each month (except in Nov. & Dec. when meeting takes place on the third Wednesday of ea. Month) at 7:00 p.m. in a City owned public facility within Middletown
- To serve on at least one grants (funding awards) panel per year
- To actively participate on at least one of several committees (of the Commission)
- To participate in events organized (and presented) by the Commission
- To attend as many grant funded programs as possible and bring a report back to the Commission meeting
- To base all decisions on the “best interests of the whole community” disregarding politics and personal interests
- To become aware of and able to analyze the arts (in the community)
- To be an advocate for arts and cultural activities in the community
