Executive Committee

- The Executive Committee is empowered to complete items on a Commission agenda not covered at a Commission meeting.
- Commissioners have the prerogative of changing the order of business at a meeting (with majority approval) in order to attend to items that are considered to be of special importance.
- When the Executive Committee deals with agenda items outside of Commission meetings, decisions will be based on committee recommendations and budgeted expenditures.
- Items outside of Committee and budget, of a routine nature, will also be handled.
- Those items the Executive Committee considers to be of an extraordinary nature will result in full Commission contact and/or special meeting.
- Executive Committee decisions will be reported at the earliest Commission meeting.
