REMARKS

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

On 08/05/20, at approximately 07:29 hours, police responded to an undisclosed address within Middletown, CT jurisdiction on a domestic violence complaint.


During a dispute with the victim over money and social media postings, the arguments escalated throughout the night to a point where the accused Tramaine GOFORTH (AGE 24) pushed, struck and choked the victim with his bare hands inside of their home, resulting in minor injuries.

The accused was subsequently taken into police custody without incident and transported to police headquarters. While in the booking room at headquarters the accused was advised of his notice of rights (Miranda Warning) and processed on the charges of being in violation of (1CT) of C.G.S. SEC. 53a-64cc,

Strangulation 3rd degree and (1CT) of C.G.S. SEC. 53a-182, Disorder Conduct.

The accused was unable to post bail and was escorted to holding cell # 3 at the Middletown Police Department and held in lieu of \$25,000 surety-bond. Court set for 08/06/20, at 09:00 hours, (GA-09) 1 Court Street, Middletown, CT 06457.

On 8/6/20, around 0109 hours, while on routine patrol I observed a person sleeping on the floor of the gazebo at the South Green park, located at the intersection of Main ST and Pleasant ST. The park is a city park, which is closed from sunset to sunrise. There has been a problem with homeless people sleeping in the gazebo, oftentimes leaving trash behind. Officers Murphy, Magnano, and Zadjura responded as backup.

I approached the gazebo and saw that it was Gary Rountree who was on the ground sleeping. Roundtree had been at the gazebo the previous night and left with no issues when advised that the park was closed. I saw him later that night sleeping on the sidewalk at Metro Square. When I told him he couldn't stay there he told me to arrest him as he was tired of staying on the streets and just wanted to go to jail. I advised him that I wouldn't arrest him as he hadn't broken any laws. He then left without further incident.

When I spoke to him this evening, he said he wasn't going to leave. He then said that he was "tired of bitches fucking with him" and that he would "shoot any bitch that fucks with him." I asked him whom he was talking about and he said, "All of them." He then said that there were too many women in Middletown. He said if he had to leave he would, "Set that house on fire," pointing to 15 Pleasant ST. He said that he wasn't leaving but he would go with us. Other officers on scene also asked him to leave but he still refused.

It was apparent to me based on his actions and what he had told me the night before that he was trying to get himself arrested. I gave him one final warning to leave to avoid arrest and he said no. I then advised him to stand up and put his hands behind his back and he did without incident. He was taken into custody and transported to the station by Officer Murphy.

Roundtree refused to submit to the booking process. He was charged with Criminal Trespass 1st, 53a-107, and Failure to Submit to Fingerprinting, 29-12. He was held on a \$250 bond and will appear at G.A. 9 on 8/6/20.
