REMARKS

On August 19, 2020, at approximately 2219 hours, I was dispatched to the area of Cottage St. and Burr Ave. on a disturbance.

When I arrived on scene I observed a white female lying on the eastern sidewalk in front of 38 Burr Ave. The female had blood on her face, on her beige hooded sweatshirt and hands/arms. The female was later identified as Melissa Mishler (33). Mishler got off the ground and ran over to the passenger side of Officer Nettis's police car as he put it in park. She ran around to the drivers side yelling vulgarities and rambling incoherent sentences at officers as well as a small group of individuals in front of 38 Burr Ave. As we were trying to investigate what was happening, it was clear that Mishler got into some sort of altercation with the group in front of 38 Burr Ave. Mishler ran away from us and towards the group trying to throw punches at a female but they did not connect. Mishler was yelling profanities at the individuals, as well as officers, non stop while on scene. She was escorted to the ground by Officer Nettis and detained in handcuffs.

Mishler continued to be uncooperative with Officer Nettis and tried to get off the ground repeatedly in an attempt to flee and/or rush a female on scene again. Attempts to have her remain on the ground for EMS's arrival were unsuccessful and I ultimately made the decision to place Mishler in the rear of Nettis's police car. As Officer Nettis and I attempted to place her in the police car, Mishler tensed up on us and was physically and verbally refusing to go into the car. As we were trying to negotiate with her she was yelling profanities and proceeded to say, "fuck you Matt" and spit blood at Officer Nettis and myself.

It was determined that Mishler had an active warrant from this agency for credit card fraud dating back to January 01, 2020. MPD Case #20-00041. She was ultimately transported by Officer Nettis to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing. At Middletown Police Headquarters Mishler remained uncooperative and needed to be placed in the EDP cell because of this. Officers in booking were unable to read Mishler her rights or fingerprint her because of these behaviors. As Officer Nettis was attempting to close the cell door Mishler for the second time spit at Officer Nettis.

She was ultimately charged with violating CGS 53a-181, Breach of Peace, 53a-167A(A), 53a-167c, Assault on a Public Safety Officer (3 counts), 53a-167a, Interfering with an Officer, and 29-12, Failure to Fingerprint. She was held on a \$250,000 surety bond and issued a next day court date for August 20, 2020, at GA9 for 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 8-19-20 I, Officer Small was assigned to the Patrol Division on the Evening Shift.

Officers responded to the area of 52 North Main St for what was initially called in as someone almost getting struck by a car, then the operator attempted to drag a female into the vehicle. The vehicle was reported to be a gray Ford Escape which proceeded towards Portland via the Arrigoni Bridge.

Upon arrival I spoke with the victim, [redacted] stated that she was going for a walk on North Main St. While doing so a male party backed his vehicle up next to her and asked her to be his friend. [redacted] declined the offer and continued to walk away on the sidewalk. That same vehicle then traveled in reverse at a high rate of speed nearly striking [redacted] stated the vehicle came within inches of hitting her. The male again asked [redacted] to be his friend, which she yelled "No". [redacted] began to walk the other way to get away from the vehicle. The vehicle pulled up to her a third time and the male yelled "get into the car".

yelled and ran away from the road to get away from the male, and so he would be unable to attempt to run her over. A witness reported hearing screaming and began heading to her location. Upon doing so the vehicle took off at a high rate of speed.

A witness to the incident provided a consistent statement and surveillance footage from the area confirmed what stated occurred.

Portland Police Department provided a name of a male party who they interacted with earlier in the day, that matched the description of the vehicle and male operator. That male, identified as Dennis Sanborn was later located by Portland PD and detained. A One on One Shop Up was performed, which stating she was 99.9%-100% sure he was the same person who nearly struck her.

Sanborn was taken into custody and transported to this department. Sanborn was read the Notice of Rights and Waiver form, which he acknowledged and signed. Sanborn was charged with Breach of Peace in the Second Degree (53a-181) and Reckless Endangerment in the First Degree (53a-63). Bond was set at \$30,000 Cash/surety. Unable to post bond Sanborn was secured in a cell to await transport to GA 9 in Middletown on 8-20-20.

Sanborn's criminal history shows that he is on Probation, a Registered Sex Offender and convictions for the following: Two separate Sexual Assault 4th degrees, multiple DUI's, Possession of Narcotics, Threatening, Disorderly Conduct, and Breach of Peace

REMARKS

On 08/19/2020 I responded to CVS on Main Street Extension in Middletown for a report of a shoplifting. Upon my arrival, I met with [redacted], the employee from CVS who had witnessed the shoplifting and called police. [redacted] stated that she had observed a short, bald, male, possibly Hispanic, who had loaded a bag with soap and deodorant and walked out the front door. [redacted] said that she had followed him out the door and told him to stop but the individual told her that he was not stopping. She went on to say that the suspect left walking northbound on Main Street Extension carrying a large bag. Officer Tetreault canvassed the area but was unsuccessful in locating the suspect. [redacted] estimated the larceny at approximately \$450.00.

I returned to the back office of CVS with [redacted] to review the security footage. I observed the suspect; a short, light skinned, male with black pants and a grey long sleeved shirt with a thick black stripe across the chest as he selected numerous items and placed them into a canvas shopping bag. I could see that the bag

was full to the top as the suspect picked up the bag and walked out the door making no attempt to pay for the items. I was able to take photos from the video to help identify the suspect.

I left CVS and traveled north on Main Street in order to try and locate the suspect and observed a short, bald, male with black pants and a gray short sleeve t-shirt that resembled the suspect. As I got closer, I could see that he had a long sleeved gray shirt with a thick, black stripe on it draped over his shoulder matching the shirt I observed in the surveillance video. He was identified as Joseph Ferraro of Middletown.

While questioning Ferraro he admitted to the shoplifting at CVS. I placed Ferraro under arrest and secured him in handcuffs. I searched Ferraro, incident to arrest, and located twenty five dollars, a crack pipe and a lighter in his front left pocket of his pants.

created a receipt showing the value of the stolen items at \$453.40.

Ferraro was transported to Middletown Police for processing where he was charged with Larceny 6th, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Ferraro was held on a \$2000.00 surety bond with a pending court date of 11/30/2020.

REMARKS

On 8-12-20 at 1147 hours, I was dispatched to 416 East Main St, Marshall's, for an unwanted person. The manager of Marshall's, , had called because Thomas Hirsch had come back into the store.

On 8-11-20 Hirsch had walked into the police department and stated that he was going to Marshall's to expose himself to women. The desk Sergeant had called Officer Tetrault when Hirsch left to check the area.

Officer Tetrault and I responded and located Hirsch exiting the store. He told us that he went there to expose himself to women because he cannot stop himself. He had not done so yet and this was confirmed by the store manager. Both Officer Tetrault and I advised Hirsch to leave the property and not return or he would be arrested for trespassing. He stated that he understood and that he was going to go to Kohl's in Rocky Hill and expose himself to women there. This was case #20-21973.

I contacted the Rocky Hill Police Department and advised them.

Hirsch had returned to the store on 8-12-20 and was following women in the store. The manager stated that he then left and it did not appear that he had exposed himself at that point.
