
REMARKS

On Saturday, August 22, 2020 at approximately 18:45hrs a witness contacted Middletown Dispatch and reported that she had been following a possible intoxicated party and was approaching the Portland Bridge and headed in to Middletown. The described vehicle was a 2011 Toyota Corolla 4-Dr color black bearing CT reg She stated the vehicle was all over the road, crossing the double yellow line, nearly striking other vehicles head on. I, Officer Zadjura, observed the vehicle exiting the bridge and continuing south on Main St. I initiated a traffic stop, at first the operator did not acknowledge the police lights and sirens. Eventually coming to an abrupt stop in the middle to the right most lane. Later pulling off in to a stall. The operator was identified as Peter Zarabozo of Kensington, CT.

Peter refused to participate in the Field Sobriety Test and refused to provide a Breath sample. During the investigation, Peter's eyes were watery, his skin was clammy, a distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage was emanating from him. Additionally he was unstable of his feet needing to use his vehicle to steady himself. He needed to be given repeated and literal instruction and while walking his movements were slow and deliberate.


Peter was processed for the violation of CGS 14-227a (Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol) and 14-236 (Failure to Maintain Proper Lane). He was released on a \$500 Surety bond and is scheduled to appear in Court on October 22, 2020 at GA9 located at 1 Court St. this City no later than 0900 hrs.

REMARKS

On Monday, 8/24/2020 at approximately 1844 hours, Ofc. Van Almkerk and Ofc. Pixley were dispatched to the area of Vet's Park located in the area of Walnut Grove Road and Newfield Court, for a report of a 911 hang up. The complainant said, "get here quick" and hung up. A short time later, the complainant called back and reported a vehicle was driving erratically through the park, crashing at least two times. The vehicle was said to be bearing CT REG [redacted] Ofc. Travis started towards the area in case officers needed assistance.

I, Ofc. Travis was traveling north on Newfield Street, operating Middletown Police Cruiser 1706. I observed a silver Saturn Ion bearing CT REG [redacted] at the intersection of Fisher Road and Newfield Street. The passenger side of the vehicle was on the sidewalk, while the driver's side was in the roadway. I observed the vehicle take a left onto Newfield Street, traveling south on Newfield Street. I observed the operator of a vehicle following, later identified as [redacted], motion his hand towards the vehicle driving erratically; the operator was later identified as the reporting party.

I followed behind the vehicle and observed the vehicle cross the double yellow lines, entering the northbound traffic lane. I activated my emergency lights and siren in an attempt to stop the vehicle. The vehicle was traveling at a slow rate of speed, continuing to swerve in and out of the proper lane of travel. I changed the tone of my siren several times in an attempt to gain the compliance of the operator. The vehicle continued to travel south, crossing the intersection of Washington Street, traveling onto Vine Street. The vehicle continued to strike the curb and enter into oncoming traffic. In the area of 105 Vine Street, in front of Wesleyan Tennis Courts, the vehicle stopped.

I approached the vehicle; I immediately identified the strong and distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the vehicle. I instructed the operator, _____ identified by CT DL _____ to put the vehicle in park and the keys out of the ignition. Inside the vehicle, I observed several cans of beer, one Budweiser brand beer can in the driver's side cup holder, several other cans on the floor of the passenger side and two Popov brand vodka bottles. All alcohol containers were observed in plain view in the vehicle. _____ had what appeared to be blood dripping from her mouth. I also observed blood on her hands, it appeared the blood had dripped down her chest and onto her skirt. Any further injuries were unknown at this time, as she was unable to communicate in any way. _____ appeared to be under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.

Right as I approached the vehicle, the passenger, later identified as Ernest Allen _____ by (CT ID _____ exited the vehicle and began to walk behind the car towards my cruiser. At this time, I was the only officer on scene. I gave commands for Allen to get back inside the vehicle. He stated he was going to get his license and continued walking towards my cruiser, which had the driver's side window down and would be easily accessible at the time. After refusing several commands, Allen finally started walking back towards _____ vehicle.

Allen began to walk towards my cruiser again, I gave several commands for him to get back inside the vehicle. After several commands to get back in the vehicle, he began yelling obscene language and eventually got back into the vehicle. He said that he did not have to listen to me, yelling, "you just want my license right?" he followed up by yelling profanities, such as "bitch" and "asshole". There were several people at the tennis courts during this time, I observed several onlookers stop their normal activities to watch as Allen was yelling. It was evident his actions were causing disruption and alarm to those on the tennis courts and in the immediate area.

When Allen got back inside the vehicle, he continued to yell and he was reaching behind the driver's seat and in between the center consol. I was still alone at this time, I was unsure whether or not there was a weapon concealed in the vehicle. It was also unclear where _____ had sustained the injury to her mouth, therefore I was unsure if a domestic incident had just occurred. Allen's immediate compliance was crucial to ensure the safety of _____ and myself. I asked Allen several times to stop reaching around the vehicle. When I was giving commands, he would respond by saying "fuck you" while continuing furtive movements inside the vehicle.

Ofc. Van Almkerk arrived on scene as I was still giving Allen commands to stop reaching behind the driver's seat. Ofc. Van Almkerk asked Allen to get out of the vehicle, Allen responded by continuing to yell profanities and saying, "fuck you". Allen continued to reach around the vehicle, at which time Ofc. Van Almkerk grabbed Allen's wrist to escort him out of the vehicle. I proceeded around the vehicle, as I observed Allen attempt to pull away from Ofc. Van Almkerk. Ofc. Pixley arrived on scene at this time. Allen was told he was going to be placed in handcuffs, he would not comply and continued to pull his arms in an attempt to get away from officers. Ofc. Pixley performed a take down, at which time Allen landed on his stomach on the grass which lined the sidewalk. I held Allen's left arm behind his back as I secured him in handcuffs. See Ofc. Van Almkerk and Ofc. Pixley's supplemental narratives and Use of Force reports for further information.

Allen was placed under arrest, Ofc. Van Almkerk transported Allen to Middletown Headquarters for processing.

There were two witnesses who were playing tennis in the immediate area of the motor vehicle stop. Lt. Maturo spoke to those individuals, identified as _____ and _____. See Lt. Maturo's supplemental narrative for further information.

While Ofc. Van Almkerk was processing Allen, he appeared to begin seizing. Hunters Ambulance was immediately contacted and reported to Middletown Headquarters to assess Allen, he was then transferred to Middlesex Hospital for medical treatment.

Allen was subsequently released in lieu of a \$50,000 non-surety bond for violation of C.G.S. Breach of Peace (53a-181) and Interfering (53a-167A). Allen is due to appear at GA09 for said charges on 11/9/2020 at 0900 hours.
