REMARKS

On Saturday, 8/22/20 at approximately 2108 hours I, Officer St. Peter, responded to the area of 23 Hubbard St for the report of a motor vehicle accident.

Upon arrival I observed a tan 2004 Honda Odyssey bearing CT reg. partially parked on the road and partially parked on the sidewalk. The vehicle was running and the operator (Samuel Rosado) was in the vehicle as I arrived on scene. As I approached the vehicle Rosado exited the vehicle. He reached into the vehicle and shut the vehicle off. I ran the plate. This check revealed the plate belonged on a Nissan Quest. I observed heavy damage to the front driver side tire and suspension. The ball joint had snapped and the tire was at a 90 degree angle.

I observed the curbing that Rosado hit on the east side of Hubbard St. There was a black tire scuff but no damage to the curbing.

I questioned Rosado as to what happened. As he spoke his speech was slow and slurred. His eyes were bloodshot and glossy. His pupils were pin point and did not react to light. He was sweating profusely. He began to nod off while we spoke. I suspected Rosado was under the influence of some type of opioid. I asked if he had any medical conditions and Rosado stated he did not. I then asked if he used any drugs or alcohol. Rosado stated he took Suboxone.

I requested he submit to a standardized field sobriety test. Rosado stated he would submit to the test.

Rosado did not perform the tests to standard.

Based on the totality of my observations I placed Rosado in handcuffs and advised him he was under arrest. I advised him I would be searching his person incident to arrest and asked if he had any contraband on his person. He stated he did not. I reached into his right front pocket and located a used syringe with powder residue. When I asked what the syringe was for Rosado stated he melts his Suboxone down and shoots it. No other contraband was located. I requested dispatch run Rosado. I was informed his license was suspended.

At Middletown Police Headquarters I advised Rosado of his rights at 2159 hours. I read the implied consent advisory to Rosado and afforded him an opportunity to call an attorney at 2203 hours. I requested he submit to a breath test. He refused to take the test. Officer Zadjura witnessed the refusal.

I tested the residue powder in the cap of the syringe using a Nark03 test kit which test for the presence of heroin. The test instantly revealed a bright yellow color confirming the residue was heroin.

Rosado was issued MSC # 188870 for violation of CGS: 14-147(c) Misuse of plates, 14-215 Operation while license is suspended, 14-12a* Operation of an unregistered motor vehicle, 14-227b DUI (refusal) and 21a-267 Possession of drug paraphernalia. He was issued a court date of 11/11/20 at GA09 in Middletown and released on a \$10,000 non-surety bond .
