On August 29 2020, I was dispatched to a two vehicle crash that occurred in the parking lot of 31 Stoneycrest Dr.



REMARKS

On August 29 2020, I was dispatched to The Home Depot, 909 Washington St, on report of a larceny in progress. Multiple MPD units responded.

Dispatch stated at the time that two black males were involved in a larceny. One male was described as black, wearing a red shirt, and pushing a shopping cart full of merchandise, entering a white Chrysler 300. The second male was described as black, wearing blue jeans, and a black hat, arguing with loss prevention inside the store. Dispatch later updated arriving units that the Chrysler 300 had turned left, westbound onto Washington St.

Upon arrival, Sgt Bartolatta, Ofc Arroyo and I canvassed Washington St to Higby Rd and were unable to locate the vehicle. Ofc Haddad and Ofc St Peter responded to The Home Depot and detained the suspect who was still inside the store, later identified as David Hobby, Hobby was identified by his ID card, CT

Hobby had approximately \$477.00 worth of merchandise in his shopping cart at the time of being stopped inside the store by of Loss Prevention. Hobby admitted that he and his friends came to The Home Depot with the intent of stealing, which provided in a written statement. I estimated the total stolen merchandise by suspect one and suspect three, who got away, to total \$598.00. estimated the total stolen merchandise (\$598.00) plus total attempted stolen merchandise by Hobby (\$477.00) to total \$1075.00.

Hobby was searched on scene prior to being placed in the back of a cruiser. I located a folded piece of newspaper, containing a clear crystal type substance, which I suspected to be methamphetamines, located in his right front change pocket. It was subsequently weighted (0.26 grams) and tested with a Narc2 test kit, at Middletown PD. The test was positive for the presence of methamphetamines, presenting an orange color. I located Hobby to have four social security cards in his wallet, which was located in his rear right pocket. Only one of the social security cards belonged to him.

Hobby was initially placed in the rear of Ofc Ortiz vehicle. Ofc Ortiz got called off scene to go to another incident; therefore Hobby was removed from Ofc Ortiz cruiser. Hobby got out of Ofc Ortiz cruiser without incident, but refused to get into the rear of another cruiser and was actively resisting Sgt Bartolotta, Ofc Haddad and Ofc Ortiz. Eventually officers were able to get Hobby into the rear of cruiser 1710. I was not present during this incident, as I was inside speaking to . See Ofc Haddad's case supplement.

Hobby was transported to Middletown Police Department in cruiser 1710, where he was again uncooperative for the booking process and read his Miranda Rights, which he refused to sign for. Hobby refused to put on a face mask, which is policy in our booking area. Hobby refused to let officers' conduct an additional pat down in the booking area, without incident, which is again policy. After much effort, a total of six officers were able to hold Hobby as an officer completed a full pat down for officers and Hobby's safety. Hobby refused to complete the fingerprinting process. At one point while in the holding cell, Hobby got fully naked and continued screaming at officers. Hobby refused to exit the holding cell and told officers that they would have to fight him. Ofc St Peter, Ofc Arroyo and I grabbed Hobby's arms and assisted him to the EDP cell naked, after giving him multiple opportunities to put his clothes back on and walk on his own. Hobby was arrested for violation of the following CGS.



On 08/30/2020 at approximately 00:36 hours I, Officer Austin Smith was dispatched to an apartment building in Middletown for a domestic incident. The caller was a neighbor in the building who stated to emergency dispatchers that the witnessed a man named Justin Rodriguez fighting with his girlfriend and that Rodriguez had also pushed the caller.

Upon arrival I spoke to Justin Rodriguez. He stated that he and his girlfriend, Victim #1 had been in a verbal altercation tonight. I asked Rodriguez if the altercation had become physical in any way, he stated unequivocally that it was not physical.

Sergeant D. Puorro spoke interviewed Victim #1 along with two other witnesses. Victim #1 stated to Sergeant Puorro that she and Rodriguez had been fighting and that Rodriguez took her phone and purse away from her and that as he did, he struck her in the face accidentally. Victim #1 had no visible injuries. Sergeant Puorro also spoke to _____ and _____. They both stated that they did not actually see the incident, but that they were told by Victim #1 that she was hit by Rodriguez. See Sergeant Puorro's supplement.

Officer Scoppetto interviewed the caller, _____, who stated that he observed Rodriguez get angry

and punch Victim #1 in the mouth.

Rodriguez was taken into to custody without incident and transported to police headquarters for processing.



REMARKS

On 08/29/2020 at approximately 2217 hours, Officer Silvestrini and I were dispatched to an address in Middletown to investigate a domestic violence incident that occurred at another address in Middletown. It was reported by the caller who will be referred to as V1 (Victim #1) that her baby's father Luis Hernandez attacked her.

When I arrived, I spoke with V1 who appeared visibly shaken. She presented with no injuries. She explained that during this incident with Hernandez, he pushed her on her bed, straddled her, held her down, and would not let her go for approximately 2 minutes. She stated that Hernandez does not presently live with her and that they have a 1 year old daughter together.

V1 stated that on 08/29/2020, she arrived home at approximately 6:00PM, with her daughter. She stated that Hernandez was inside of her apartment as he had been all day. V1 stated that at about 9:45PM, she put her daughter to bed. V1 stated that she then laid down on her bed to watch T.V. while Hernandez was in another room. She stated that shortly after laying down, she decided to clean her bedroom. She explained that while she was sweeping, Hernandez came to her and asked her why she was sweeping and then proceeded to say that the only time that she cleans is when another man is coming over. V1 stated that she did not answer Hernandez and she kept sweeping. She stated that at this time, Hernandez was

yelling at her because she was not answering him. V1 stated that she finished sweeping and then sat down at the foot of her bed. She stated that V1 then came into her bedroom still yelling at her. He then pushed her onto her back on the bed and then got on top of her, straddled her, held her arms down, and proceeded to shake her as he was yelling at her. She stated that he did this for approximately 1 minute and the only reason that he stopped was because their daughter, who was sleeping, had woken up and she was able to kick Hernandez off of her.


I later located Hernandez at V1's residence. Hernandez admitted to me that he pushed V1 onto her back on the bed and then got on top of her, straddled her, held her arms down, and proceeded to shake her as he was yelling at her. He stated that he did this because she would not talk to him.

Hernandez was then placed into custody for violation of C.G.S. 53a-182-Disorderly Conduct. He was issued a court date of 08/31/2020 at 0900 hours, at GA 9, Middletown. Hernandez was unable to post his \$2,500.00 Surety bond and was held at police headquarters.







On 8/29/20 at approximately 00:23 hours I, Officer L. Woolard was dispatched to a residence in Middletown for a domestic complaint.




