REMARKS

On August 7, 2020 I, Officer Wade, was assigned to evening shift patrol with Officer Small. On this date I was dispatched to 416 E Main St. (Stop & Shop) for a larceny complaint. The described suspect was that of the same female I made contact with about an hour prior for a larceny complaint in the same plaza at Bobs Store. I notified officers via radio of who the suspect may be based on my previous interaction.

Upon arrival to the area I observed officers with the suspect, Crystal Davis (40) in the area of Marshalls and Dollar Tree (same plaza as Stop & Shop.) At this time Davis was drinking a vitamin water which was later discovered on video to be an item she stole from Stop & Shop. I asked Davis if she had anything on her and she replied "yes, a beer bottle" concealed in her back pants. A pat down of Davis reveal a total of five (5) concealed unopened beer bottles to which Davis responded "I got those from the liquor store, not Stop & Shop."

Stop & Shop Store Detective "S&S Detective" walked to where officers and Davis were and positively identified Davis as the person who shoplifted from the store. S&S Detective told me that Davis intentionally exited the store without offering payment, with a carriage containing full reusable bags of store merchandise. S&S Detective said she identified herself to Davis and once she realized S&S Detective was calling the police she asked S&S Detective if she "wanted to get poked" as well as said "I'll fucking stab you" and began reaching in her backpack. S&S Detective said she told Davis to leave and she repeated she was going to stab S&S Detective and made a "slashing across the throat motion" at her. S&S Detective said all merchandise was recovered after Davis passed all points of sale. The merchandise totaled three hundred thirty-seven dollars and seventy cents (\$337.70.)

Davis was placed under arrest and transported by Ofc. Nettis to Middletown Police Department for booking and processing. A search incident to arrest of Davis' bags revealed two (2) more unopened beer bottles.

Ofc. Small and I went to Stop & Shop and obtained a sworn written statement from S&S Detective who also provided me with a CD containing video footage of some of the incident, as well as a receipt of all the items that Davis exited the store with. All evidence was submitted to MPD evidence lab in locker number "3". S&S Detective recognized the recovered concealed beer bottles to be from Stop & Shop as well.

While in the fingerprinting room at Middletown Police Department Davis mentioned to myself and Officer Small various stories about how she steals from various stores. Davis told me she works for someone stealing from "stores but not people." Davis mentioned stealing from stores in Brooklyn, NY, as well as "selling stolen shrimp to bodega's." When asked why she constantly steals Davis said "because my EBT card isn't working." Davis also said she is not going to stop stealing.

Davis was charged with 53a-136 Robbery 3rd and 53a-125b Larceny 6th and released on a non-surety bond of \$10,000 with Special Conditions of Release; stay off Stop & Shop property in Middletown, CT. Davis was given a court date of November 10, 2020 at 0900 hours at GA 9 court. Davis was verbally explained these stipulations and signed the Criminal Appearance Bond form.

It should be noted that a check through revealed Davis has various prior convictions including: Larceny 6, Criminal Trespass 1, Interfering with Arrest, Violation of Probation, Breach of Peace 2, Failure to Appear 1, Failure to Appear 2, Burglary 2, Burglary 3, Carrying a Dangerous Weapon, Assault of Public Safety Personnel, Risk of Injury, and Assault 3.
