### REMARKS

On 09-09-2020 at 1644 hours, I, Officer Haddad, responded to an address in Middletown regarding a past domestic dispute. Upon arrival, I found that the address was an apartment building. I asked the dispatcher for an apartment number but none had been given by the caller. The dispatcher then notified me that the caller was coming outside.

He identified himself as Daniel Massey

I asked him why he did not call at the time of the incidents. Daniel Massey replied, " she reported on me so now I'm going to report on her, she wants to play that game, I can play that game too." I asked Massey what he meant by that and he told me that Victim # 1 had a marshal serve him with a restraining order today. I told him that he is then not allowed to be there and he said, " I'm not going anywhere".

While Massey was filling out his statement form, I checked the address, and Massey, for court orders. There is in fact an Ex-Parte restraining order on file, that was served on this date, 09-09-2020. The docket number is M . All boxes are checked, including that Massey must stay away from the protected persons home or wherever the protected person shall reside. I then spoke to Victim # 1 on the telephone and she stated that she stills lives at that adress. I informed her of the situation and told her that

Massey was going to be arrested and taken to jail. A safety plan was discussed with Victim # 1 in a subsequent phone call.

Massey was arrested for Criminal Violation of a Protective Order, 53a-223b. He was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where he refused to be fingerprinted. Massey was then subsequently charged with Failure to Submit to Fingerprinting, 29-12.

Massey was held on a \$5000.00 surety bond and was issued a court date of 09-10-2020 at 0900 hours.

Court is GA 9, located at 1 Court Street in Middletown.

### REMARKS

On 9/3/2020 at 1121 hours I (Officer Ceccolini) was dispatched to a two vehicle intersecting paths collision that occurred on Washington Street and the Walgreens parking lot (633 Washington Street).

I arrived on scene and made contact with both drivers. Robert Watson stated that he was traveling eastbound on Washington Street when a vehicle attempted to make a left turn across traffic, into the Walgreens parking lot in front of his vehicle. Watson explained that he had no time to react or stop before striking the front of the turning vehicle.

Watson stated that he was driving his nephews vehicle and that he had a suspended license. A records check confirmed that Watson's CT driver license was suspended indefinitely. He was issued a misdemeanor summons ( MC 455255) for violating CGS 14-215(a)- Operating a MV w/ a Susp. License. He was released at the scene on a promise to appear and is due in Middletown Superior Court on 11/12/20 to answer for the above charge.
