Upon arrival I observed a male whom I knew from previous incidents as Robert Spencer. Spencer informed me he had been approached by Victim#1 about removing items from their shared garage. Spencer admitted to being involved in a verbal altercation with Victim#1 whom he had an active no contact protective order with in which he was the respondent.

Through Spencer's own admission, the witness's verbal statement as well as cellular telephone video footage of the altercation, Spencer was handcuffed and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters to be processed for violation of 53a-223: Violation of a Protective Order.

Spencer was read his Notice of Rights at approximately 1600 hours, which he stated he understood and willingly signed in the designated area. Additionally Spencer was read his Conditions of Release and Criminal appearance bond at approximately 1700 hours, which he stated he understood and willingly signed in the designated area. Spencer was released on a non-surety 5,000.00 dollar bond and given a court date at G.A#09 on 09/16/2020 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 09/16/2020 at approximately 1523 hours, I, Officer Santostefano was dispatched to an undisclosed address in Middletown for a report of harassment. Upon arrival I spoke with Victim#1 whom I knew from previous incidents. Victim#1 stated he was approached by Liza Paolini began a verbal altercation with him about removing items from their shared garage space. It should be noted Victim#1 and Paolini had an active protective order at the time of the incident in which Paolini was the protected party.

Paolini was on scene and admitted to having a verbal altercation with Victim#1 and proceeded to provide me with video footage evidence of the incident she had recorded with her cellular telephone. The video footage of the incident proved Paolini to be in violation of 53a-223: Violation of a Protective order. Through Paolini's own admission, the witness's verbal statement as well as cellular telephone video footage of the altercation, Paolini was handcuffed and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing.

Paolini was read her Notice of Rights at approximately 1710 hours, which she stated she understood and willingly signed in the designated area. Additionally Paolini was read his Conditions of Release and Criminal appearance bond at approximately 1735 hours, which she stated she understood and willingly signed in the designated area. Paolini was released on a non-surety 5,000.00 dollar bond and given a court date at G.A#09 on 09/16/2020 at 0900 hours.
