REMARKS

****Domestic Violence****

On September 24, 2020, at approximately 1002 hours, I was dispatched to 131 Tuttle Rd. on a harassment complaint. Central Dispatch advised me the caller was a Jexan Rivera (41) who had accused his ex, VICTIM #1, of harassing him. Central Dispatch also advised me there was a full no contact restraining in place with VICTIM #1 being the protected party and Jexan being the subject.

When I made contact with Jexan I asked him about the restraining order. He admitted there was one in place. I informed him it was a no contact restraining order meaning he could in no way contact VICTIM #1, among the other conditions listed in the order (CT01, CT03, CT05, CT14, CTF). At this point I could see Jexan's demeanor change, and could sense that he was guilty of communicating with VICTIM #1. He informed me that VICTIM #1 had been messaging him and he wanted her to stop. I asked him what she was saying to him and he said a lot of the messages had to do with their son so he would respond to her about those. He said she messaged him calling him a bad father. Jexan admitted he took exception to that message and had to respond saying he loved his son and would do anything from him. I asked Jexan to elaborate and asked if I could see the messages and he refused. He said he knew if he showed me the messages it would lead to him get him arrested.

I was able to make contact with VICTIM #1 who stated the order was put in place in November 2019. She said originally they both communicated through a third party (which is VICTIM #1's mother), but as of 6 months ago Jexan refused to use the third party. VICTIM #1 said her son misses Jexan and because Jexan refuses to use the third party, she has been forced to message him directly to schedule visitation. VICTIM #1 said that besides talking about their son, Jexan has been messaging her on and off about their relationship and sometimes has been disrespectful to her. I informed her about the order and how he is not allowed to respond back, which she stated she knew was in place. I advised her to try using her mother as the third party in the future because based on the restraining order, and upcoming protective order, he could not speak to her.

VICTIM #1 provided me with screen shots showing Jexan text messaging her on September 23, 2020 and September 24, 2020.

As a result of this incident, Jexan Rivera, was arrested for violating CGS 53a-223a, Criminal Violation of a Restraining Order. He was released on a \$2,000 Non Surety Bond and assigned a next day court date (09/25/2020), at GA9 for 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 9/24/20 at 0803 hours, I, Officer Carta, was dispatched to an undisclosed address for a domestic disturbance. Dispatch stated that the caller could hear a female yelling "I told you to stop putting your hands on me." Dispatch stated that the domestic was between a and ' Officer Foss-Rugan, Officer Tetrault, and Lt. Hubbs responded as well.

Upon arrival, Officer Foss-Rugan and I could hear screaming coming from the 3rd floor apartment. I knocked on the door, and a female party opened the door. As Officer Foss-Rugan and I entered the apartment, I observed a male and female party arguing loudly. As we approached the male party, later identified as Tyriq Quinonez, I asked him what happened. Quinonez immediately turned his back towards us and put his hands behind his back, and stated "just take me to jail". Quinonez was immediately detained in handcuffs.

I then made contact with the victim who was arguing with Quinonez. The victim stated that her and Quinonez have been in a dating relationship for 3 years and have 1 child together. The victim stated that her mother was supposed to drop their daughter off this morning, and Quinonez was going to watch their child while she was at work. The victim stated that Quinonez became angry because he did not want her mother to drop their child off, which started an argument. The victim stated that Quinonez then began telling

her to take her stuff and leave. The victim stated that Quinonez then began packing her belongings, which she told him to stop. The victim stated that she then grabbed Quinonez's Xbox controller and put it in her pocket, due to him packing her belongings. The victim stated that when she put Quinonez's Xbox controller in her pocket, he became extremely angry and began chasing her around the apartment. The victim stated that Quinonez caught up to her and pushed her onto their couch. The victim stated that Quinonez then got on top of her and began trying to pull the Xbox controller out of her pocket. The victim stated that she was yelling at Quinonez to get off of her, but he continued trying to pull the Xbox controller out of her pocket. The victim stated that she then acted in self-defense and bit Quinonez on his left shoulder blade in order to get him off of her, which he did. It should be noted that there was a witness on scene as well, that confirmed this series of events.

Officer Foss-Rugan spoke to Quinonez who confirmed the victim's story. Quinonez admitted to Officer Foss-Rugan that he pushed the victim onto the couch because she took his Xbox controller.

Officer Foss Rugan transported Quinonez to Middletown Police Headquarters where he was read his rights, fingerprinted and processed. Quinonez was charged with C.G.S. 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct and was released on a \$2,500 non-surety bond. Quinonez must appear to Middletown Superior Court GA 9 on 9/25/20 at 0900 hours.
