Upon arrival to the rear parking lot area of apartment 30F Rose Circle, I spoke to _____ who stated her tan 2003 Mitsubishi Lancer that was parked in a visitor's parking spot was hit by a green 1997 Chevrolet C1500, which was operated by David Whitehill who then fled the scene.


While speaking with Whitehill I, could smell the odor of alcohol emanating from his breath. When questioned about the crash, Whitehill denied hitting the vehicle and said he could not remember if he did. Whitehill also admitted to leaving the parking lot and stated he did not evade responsibility because he returned to the scene. It should be noted Whitehill made no attempts to report the crash, call 911 or contact Beck.


The damages on both vehicles were consistent and an independent witness to the collision also provided a sworn written statement which corroborated the occurrence of the incident.

Due to the above facts and circumstances, Whitehill was placed under arrest for the following violation of the Connecticut General Statute:

14-224(b) Evading Responsibility/ Property Damage.

Whitehill was transported to headquarters where he was photographed, fingerprinted, and processed. Whitehead was released on a \$2,000 department-set non-surety bond, and is scheduled to appear at G.A. 09 on November 18, 2020, at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 09/20/2020 at approximately 2151 hours, Sergeant Dirga, Officer Wasilewski, and I were dispatched to Sliders Bar and Grill, 1265 South Main Street, to investigate a disturbance complaint. The caller who was the manager at Sliders, reported that there were 5 unruly middle aged white male patrons inside of the bar area at Sliders that were sexually harassing her and the female bartender. She reported that they were also making several racially motivated statements towards the black employees that work in the kitchen at Sliders. The caller reported that these 5 white male patrons continued heckling the black employees by insinuating that they had a gun and saying that you should be able to kill black people if you want all while trying to fight the black employees.

When we arrived we observed 2 of the above described males as the other 2 had reportedly left the scene. We were asked by the caller and the female bartender to get the unruly patrons to leave Sliders after they had repeatedly asked them to leave several times prior to contacting the police. The caller stated that they

did not leave and continued to sexually harass them and yell racially motivated statements at the black kitchen crew employees of Sliders. She stated that they even told her that they were "strapped" and that all black people should get shot.

We then spoke with the 2 males who were sitting at a booth inside of Sliders. We explained to them why we were called to Sliders and the accusations against them. We then asked the males for identification, which gave use his Ct. operator license and the other male became confrontational and never gave us his identification. This caused [redacted] to become confrontational, which also caused his wife Amy Venditti to come over to us and become confrontational and belligerent with us as well. We pleaded for approximately 13 minutes with [redacted] and Amy to leave which they never did and continued to be belligerent towards us saying that they are not leaving because they did nothing wrong. [redacted] then stood up aggressively towards us and got real close to us, yelling for us to arrest him. Amy also got close to us during this incident as she was yelling and swearing at us. Twice during this incident, Amy pointed her index finger at me, almost making contact with my chest area.

Amy Venditti was then placed into custody for violation of C.G.S. 53a-181-Breach of Peace in the Second Degree and 53a-108-Criminal Trespass in the Second Degree. She was then escorted by Officer Ceccolini to his cruiser where she was transported to police headquarters for processing. Amy was later booked and processed by Officer Wade for the above charges under UAR #8877997. She was issued a court date of 11/11/2020 at 0900 hours at GA 9, Middletown. She was released on a \$2,500.00 Non Surety bond.

There is no further information.

REMARKS





REMARKS

On 09-25-2020 at approximately 2140 hours I, Officer Thompson, was dispatched to Main St. and Washington St. for the report of a fight. Dispatch stated a male and female were actively fighting outside.

Upon arrival I observed a black male, later to be identified as Ceone Fraser, screaming at a black female. The female was partially inside the doorway of H&H House of Beauty, located at 472 Main Street. The female was attempting to close the door on Fraser who was forcing the door open. Fraser was visibly bleeding from the mouth and extremely agitated. I put my hand on Fraser's chest and attempted to push him back. He pushed my hand away and yelled "get the fuck off of me".

Moments later, Sgt. Dirga arrived on scene and we both attempted to move Fraser away from the female. Fraser began to fight with us which led to a struggle and caused Fraser to land on the ground. Multiple units assisted while Fraser was eventually handcuffed and placed in my cruiser.

Officer Milardo later spoke with the female who stated she was hanging out with Fraser earlier in the evening at his apartment. She left and while walking home Fraser followed her. She then tried to get into H&H and Fraser tried forcing his way in behind her. A passerby by called the police and Fraser was arrested a short while later.

It was also determined that Fraser briefly fought with a male that tried assisting female during the argument.

Fraser was transported to headquarters and processed on the following violations of CT general statutes.

- 53a-181 - Breach of Peace 2nd degree
- 53a-167a - Interfering with an Officer

Fraser was held on a \$2500 surety bond and identified by his CT ID card.


I ran Strothers with dispatch, who advised me that Strothers had a warrant for violation of CGS 53a-32 Violation of Probation.

REMARKS

On 09-27-2020 at approximately 1035 hours I, Officer Thompson, was dispatched to Hillside Ave. for a domestic dispute. An anonymous caller reported two parties were arguing in a parking lot.

Upon arrival I spoke with a neighbor who was standing in her apartment door by the parking lot. I asked if anyone was arguing and she pointed at an apartment behind her. As I approached the apartment door, I could hear arguing from inside the apartment.

I then made contact with both individuals who confirmed they were arguing. Both parties stated the argument was verbal only and was not physical at any time. During my investigation, I confirmed through dispatch that Skylar Stassola had an active protective order which listed CT03 stating stay away from the home of the protected party.

Stassola appeared to be in violation of the order and I asked why she was at the residence of the protected party. Stassola stated she thought she was allowed to meet the protected party at a public place, so they met in the parking lot of the apartment complex. She claimed she only went in the apartment to use the bathroom.

Stassola was placed under arrest and transported to headquarters for processing. She was charged with the following violation of CT general statute.

REMARKS

On 9/27/2020 at approximately 1737hrs Officer Thompson and I (Officer Wasilewski) were dispatched to a residence in Middletown for a report of a physical domestic. The caller, (Hereby referred to as Victim 1 stated he was punched by Rochye Simmons Jr. He reported that Simmons Jr. was currently walking outside in the front yard wearing gray sweat pants.

Upon my arrival I located Simmons Jr. sitting on the front concrete steps drinking a beer. I approached him and asked what was going on. Simmons Jr. ignored me and kept drinking his beer. At that time Victim 1 walked over from the other side of the street where he was standing with another male party. He pointed at Simmons Jr and stated "That's him. He punched me in my face. I want him arrested!" As Victim 1 walked closer I could see that the left side of his face was noticeably red and swollen. His left eye was also partially swollen shut but still open. He also had a small amount of blood on the front of his shirt from a cut above his left eye. Victim 1 appeared somewhat sluggish and possibly in pain from his injuries. I walked him to the front of my cruiser and asked him to sit down. I then walked over to Simmons Jr. and placed him in handcuffs which were double locked and checked for proper fit. I advised Simmons Jr. that he was being detained until I could further investigate the possible domestic disturbance. I asked if he wanted to speak with me at all but he ignored me again and refused to talk.

I asked Victim 1 if he would provide me with a written statement about the incident. He stated he wasn't giving a statement because he just "wanted Simmons Jr gone". Victim 1 allowed this Officer to photograph his facial injuries which were uploaded and submitted with the case documents. I then asked if he wanted to get checked out by ambulance personnel. He stated he did not. Victim 1 continued to refuse medical treatment, however EMT's were called to the scene anyway and evaluated Victim 1.

After speaking with the EMT's and I, Victim 1 eventually agreed to go to the hospital to get checked. While I transported Simmons Jr. to the Middletown Police Department Officer Thompson remained on scene until Victim 1 was transported to the Middlesex Hospital for evaluation.


Simmons Jr was transported to the Middletown Police Department where he was read his rights, fingerprinted and photographed. He was charged with violation of CGS 53a-60 Assault 2nd Degree and CGS 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct. Simmons Jr was held on a \$50,000 surety bond and given a next day court date of 9/28/2020 at 0900hrs. He was told he would have to appear at the GA 9 Court House on that date and time.

Both Victim 1 and Simmons Jr were seen at the Middlesex Hospital for physical injuries. Simmons Jr. sustained a broken bone in his right hand from punching Victim 1. Victim 1 sustained a broken neck, fractured facial bone and a brain bleed. At the Hartford Hospital Victim 1 later stated he hurt his neck during a fall on the sidewalk "last Saturday" which he never sought medical attention for. While speaking to Victim 1 at the hospital, the only further information he provided was that Simmons Jr. punched him approximately 10 times in the face but he never fell down or hit his head on anything else.

Both Victim 1 and Simmons Jr. signed hospital medical release forms.

Nothing further at this time.
