REMARKS

On 10/4/2020, at approximately 08:51 hours, I, Officer Foss-Rugan was traveling north on Pearl Street when I was flagged down by a passing motorist. The passing motorist informed me that he went to Portland to go grocery shopping

and had passed a maroon colored Chevrolet Impala with a female sitting in the driver seat at the intersection of Spring Street and Main Street. The complainant said that the female in the driver seat appeared to be slumped over the wheel.

At the intersection of Spring Street and Main Street, I located a maroon colored Impala bearing CT registration


The vehicle was parked slightly into the east bound travel lane and was occupied by a female and male passenger. The female was positively identified as the registered owner and the male passenger identified himself as Calvin Spivey

As I was speaking with the driver, I saw a crack pipe in the driver side door handle area and in the center console ash tray I saw several bundles of small wax like baggies. I advised the driver that I saw that she had narcotics and drug paraphernalia in plain view. Spivey then informed me that all of the drugs and paraphernalia in the vehicle belonged to him.

I searched the vehicle and located an unmarked orange pill bottle containing numerous burnt suspected marijuana cigarette ends in the center console, a capped insulin needle and Charboy in the glove box, a crack pipe in the driver side door handle, three crack pipes in the driver's door pocket, three bundles of wax style baggies containing an off white substance in the center console ash tray and six loose baggies in the center console cup holders. I tested the off white substance in the wax baggies with Nark Kit test #3 and it tested positive for heroin. I tested the suspected marijuana with Nark Kit test #8 and it tested positive for marijuana. All of these items were tagged into Middletown Police Evidence.

Spivey was transported to Middletown Police Department by Officer Tetrault and was processed by Officer Kevin White. Spivey was charged with the following: 21a-279(a) - Possession of Narcotics, 21a-278(b)- Possession with intent to sell narcotics, 21a-267(a)- Possession of drug paraphernalia and 21a-279a(a)1st-Possession of Marijuana. Spivey was processed and released from police custody on a \$2,500.00 non-surety bond. A court date of 11/24/2020 at 09:00 hours at Middlesex Superior Court was issued.

REMARKS

On 10/02/20 at approximately 0015 hours, I was traveling west on Washington Street while en route to another call for service. As I was approaching the area 400 Washington Street, I observed a white vehicle stopped in the right travel lane in front of 400 Washington Street. The vehicle seemed like it was attempting to take a right hand turn into the drive way but had stopped. The vehicle did not pull into the drive way and I was behind it for approximately 15 to 20 seconds. I now became concerned thinking the operator was in some sort of medical distress or possibly intoxicated. I then initiated my over head lights to and then it pulled into the drive way and continued down the hill to the rear parking lot of the apartments. I ran the license plate through dispatch, CT REG . It stopped and I got out of my cruiser to make contact with the operator. As I was walking up to the vehicle, the operator started to drive away and I started to walk faster. When I approached the vehicle, I knocked on the window and the operator jumped as if I startled him.

The operator was identified by his CT DL as Evan Appel. I had Appel exit the vehicle and asked him again if he had been drinking tonight. Appel stated that he was at Mezzos and had a couple of beers. I could also smell the odor of alcohol coming from his person. I asked Appel if he was able to perform the Standardized Field Sobriety Test and he stated he would but he's going to fail. I asked Appel why and he said he knows he shouldn't be driving. After the completion of the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, Appel failed and was then arrested and transported to Middletown Police Department for processing. Appel was advised of


Implied Consent form and given the opportunity to contact an attorney at 0100 hours which he refused.

After the completion of the tests on the Draeger Alcotest, Appel had a BAC of .0955 at 0101 hours for test #1. After the completion of test #2, Appel had a BAC of .1047 0129 hours.

Appel's license was seized on a 24 hour revocation. Appel has 1 prior DUI from 04/10/2010. Appel was charged with CGS 14-227a Operating Under the Influence and was released on a \$500 non surety bond and is scheduled to appear in GA9 on 11/10/20 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 10/03/20 at approximately 0213 hours, I, Ofc Hillman and K9 Officer Aura Smith were traveling West on Washington St when I noticed a red Jeep Grand Cherokee (CT reg# [REDACTED] traveling in front of me that had an excessively loud muffler. When I ran the registration through DMV files it showed the vehicle's license plate was valid, but belonged on a Ford Focus. DMV files showed the Jeep had a cancelled registration due to being sold as of 05/02/2020.

I initiated a motor vehicle stop on Rome Ave. The operator, identified by his CT Drivers license as Tyler Dunn, 26 admitted the vehicle was uninsured and unregistered, and the marker plates belonged on his old vehicle, the Ford Focus. He provided me with the title of the Jeep and stated he recently bought it and has not been able to register and insure it because of the pandemic and personal issues. Dunn was consequently issued a misdemeanor summons complaint ticket (MC807639) and assigned a court date of Wednesday, 11/25/20, 0900 hours at GA9 Middletown where he will answer for the violation of C.G.S 14-12 (a), Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle, 14-213b, Failure to Carry Minimum Insurance and 14-147 (c) Misuse Marker Plate respectively.

REMARKS


On 10-2-20 at 1401 hours Middletown Police observed a red Chevrolet Monte Carlo traveling southbound on Newfield Street by Congdon Street East. A query of the vehicle's registration plate, CT came back to a 2002 Nissan Xterra out of East Hartford. The accused vehicle then made an abrupt right hand turn into the Corner Stop at 221 Newfield Street. A motor vehicle stop was initiated in the parking lot of the Corner Stop. Dispatch confirmed the vehicle was a misuse.

Contact with the operator who was identified as . He stated that the vehicle belonged to his mother, Patricia Saflicki, who was sitting in the passenger seat at the time of the stop. Saflicki confirmed that she owned the vehicle. Saflicki was unable to provide a registration, any insurance, and or any paperwork for the vehicle and stated that due to the Coronavirus pandemic all the paperwork had gotten "screwed up". 
could have it properly registered and insured.

REMARKS

On 9-28-20 at 19:16hrs, these officers were parked stationary, on west side of Main St. near Grand St. These officers were in our marked MPD cruiser #1804 which is equipped with emergency lights and audible siren.

At this time, we could hear a man screaming and yelling across the street, at the corner of Main and Grand. The man was later identified as Kenneth Pina

This officer is familiar with Pina due to numerous past police encounters. This officer has always had a good rapport with Pina in all of our previous encounters.

These officers then drove across the street and were immediately met by unidentified black female. The woman stated she has several protective orders against Pina and that he had just violated one by screaming at her.

At this time Pina was yelling, screaming and pacing back and forth in front of the Main Street garden. Pina was clearly, high or severely intoxicated as he was screaming incoherently as he paced back and forth. This officer approached Pina and asked him if he was ok this evening, and if there was anything I could do to help him. Pina became agitated and immediately tensed his arms up as he yelled at this officer. Pina yelled that he wanted the unidentified woman arrested and then he continued to pace rapidly back and forth.

It should be noted that after running Pina on 9-28-20 in _____ it was determined that there were no protective orders currently in place involving Pina.

At this time this officer continually asked Pina, what could I do to help him this evening. There were numerous bystanders on Main St. who were witness to this event. Several of the witness stated to these officers that Pina is extremely high and he needs help. Pina then ran out onto Main street, where he was almost struck by an on coming vehicle. It was clear at this time that these officers were going to intervene by sending Pina to the hospital for an emergency evaluation.

Fearing that Pina was a danger to himself and others, this officer approached him again as he walked south down Main St. Pina was now yelling that he was going to kill this officer and have me killed by his unidentified brother. As this officer approached Pina, he stopped turned and raised his arms up tensing up with clenched fists.

This officer tried to calm Pina, however there seemed to be no reasoning with him. I then asked Pina several times to turn around and put his hands behind his back. Due to Pina's irrational behavior these officers wanted to detain Pina in handcuffs for his and our safety.

Pina tensed up harder as if he was about to fight this officer. I then quickly reached out and grabbed hold of Pina's right wrist and spun him around ,where

I was able to get a hold of both his arms. At this time I put Pina up against a store front window, in an attempt to hold him until officer Skarzinski could assist in handcuffing. Pina was now escalating his threats on this officer and repeatedly stated he was going to kill me.


Officer's Skarzinski and Ortiz arrived at the same time to assist. As soon as the officers arrived Pina pushed off the store front window causing this officer to fall backwards onto the concrete sidewalk landing on my right shoulder and back. This officer still had a hold of Pina so he fell to the ground with me. Pina then began to actively fight and struggle to get away from these officers.

While fighting with Pina, the numerous bystanders, who had just witnessed these officers attempting to help Pina, were now screaming at us and attempting to video the incident. The bystanders were now almost on top of us yelling obscenities and claiming these officers were harming Pina. This was escalating the situation further and causing Pina to fight with these officers even harder. This officer even yelled to the crowd at one point to help us instead of yelling at us.


This officer did have control of both of Pina's arms and eventually was able to roll him over and secure him in cuffs. Once Pina was cuffed he stopped resisting. Pina continued to yell and incite the crowd while the officers pat him down. Pina was subsequently transported to Middlesex hospital for a Police emergency examination. Officer Skarzinski completed a 17a-503 Emergency evaluation form and submitted the proper copies to hospital and EMS staff. Once Pina was transported this, officer went back to Main and Green in an attempt to speak with the unidentified female. The woman had since left the area. Pina did not sustain any injuries as a result of the altercation, however this officer did sustain a large abrasion to my left elbow and well as pain my right shoulder.

Due to the facts and circumstances mentioned above these officers issued Pina Misdemeanor summons #MC 807512, for the charges of C.G.S 53a-181 Breach of Peace and 53a-167 a Interfering with and officer. Pina signed the summons and was issued a court date of 11-8-20 at 09:30hrs.

REMARKS

On 10/04/2020 at approximately 04:11 hours I, Officer Austin Smith was dispatched to an apartment in the West Lake section of Middletown for a domestic incident. Emergency dispatchers had received a 911 in which the caller stated that he wouldn't leave and then hung up without giving any further information.

Upon arrival I was able to locate the apartment and spoke to the caller outside in the hallway. The caller was identified as William Steffy.

Steffy stated that he and Victim #1 have been dating for about two months and that they had both been drinking tonight. Steffy stated that he and Victim #1 began to argue because Steffy noticed that Victim #1's ex-boyfriend was liking his posts on social media. Steffy stated that they were in his apartment and demanded that Victim #1 leave. Steffy stated that he began to throw Victim #1's property out of the apartment and into the common hallway and that the pushing and shoving then began. When asked to elaborate about the pushing and shoving, Steffy stated that he had been drinking and could not remember exactly how it happened.

Victim #1 stated that when Steffy became enraged and began demanding for him to leave that he tried to remain calm. Victim #1 stated that Steffy punched a hole in the bedroom door. Victim #1 stated that he had

been drinking and did not have a ride home. Victim #1 stated that Steffy threw his property out into the common hallway and that Steffy then began dragging and shoving him out the door. Victim #1 stated that the neighbor across the hall witnessed Steffy shoving him.

Sergeant D. Puorro spoke to the resident in the apartment across the hall. She stated that she wished to remain anonymous, but that she was awoken by the sound of Steffy throwing items into the hallway. She stated that when she looked out of her door to see what was going on that she did witness Steffy physically dragging Victim #1 from the apartment.


Victim #1 stated that Steffy did not assault him and that he had no injuries. Officer Van Almkerk provided Victim #1 with a ride to the lobby of the Police Department where his ride was going to meet him.
