Victim #1 stated she decided to drive Bolton back to his residence at 66 Stoneycrest Dr. When they arrived, Victim #1 stated that they got into another verbal argument over their relationship. To avoid further conflict, Victim #1 exited the vehicle and went to the rear and opened the hatch door and sat down. Victim #1 stated that Bolton grabbed her to get her out of the vehicle which caused the scratches on both arms and upper chest. Victim #1 said that Bolton did not want to speak with her outside of the vehicle because he didn't want his neighbors to hear then arguing. Victim #1 stated that Bolton continued to grab her out of the vehicle and she kept pushing him away.



## REMARKS

On 09/29/2020 at approximately 13:47 hours I, Officer Austin Smith was dispatched to the area of Town Colony Drive and East Street for a woman who appeared to be in distress. The caller stated that she was walking through the apartment complex crying and had dirt all over her clothes.

Upon arrival I located the woman seated on the curb in front of building #5 on Town Colony Drive. She was extremely upset and crying. When I attempted to ascertain her name and what had happened she began to hyperventilate and stated that she could not breathe and needed an inhaler. I immediately called for Westfield Fire and Hunters Ambulance to respond to the scene and treat her.

Fire department personnel arrived on scene a short time later and gave her oxygen. She was able to calm down after a few minutes and breathe normally. At that time she identified and will be referred to as Victim #1.

Victim #1 indicated that she was upset due to a domestic incident with her husband, Veltris Patterson. Victim #1 stated that Patterson had accused her of cheating on him and that she was planning to leave the apartment. She stated that he demanded that she leave the cell phone that he pays for before leaving. Victim #1 stated that she did not want to give up the phone because she wanted to call and talk to her

mother. She stated that Patterson grabbed for her purse because he believed that the phone was in it. She let him have the purse and continued outside.

Victim #1 stated that the phone was in the right front pocket of her pants and that Patterson followed her outside when he realized that she still had it. Victim #1 stated that when Patterson caught up to her that she clutched the phone inside her pocket and dropped to the ground laying on her right side so that her body weight would prevent him from getting the phone. Victim #1 stated that Patterson was strong enough to reach into her pocket despite her attempt to stop him and that he pulled the phone out. Victim #1 stated that Patterson caused her pocket to tear, but that he immediately went back in the apartment as soon as he had the phone.

Victim #1 stated that she was not assaulted by Patterson and that nothing like this has ever happened before. Victim #1 stated that she does not fear for her safety and did not screen in as a high danger on the LAP assessment.

Patterson was cooperative and provided a similar account of the incident. He acknowledged that he should have just let her hang on to the phone, but that he was upset at the time and was not thinking clearly.

A short term safety plan was developed with Victim #1 and she was given a victim's rights card from the office of victims services. Family violence conditions of release were set and entered into

Veltris Patterson was issued Misdemeanor Summons #MC330069 and charged with violating CGS 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct. Patterson was released on a promise to appear and scheduled to appear at GA09 Middletown on 09/30/2020.
