### REMARKS

On 09/18/20, at approximately 1628 hours, I, Officer DiFonzo, was dispatched to the area of DeKoven Drive and Martin Luther King Jr. Way in Middletown CT for a motor vehicle accident complaint.

Upon arrival I met with Joshua Owens who was the operator of vehicle #1, CT registration ; and who was the operator of vehicle #2, CT registration:

Operator #1, Joshua Owens, stated he was traveling west bound on RT9 exit 14 off ramp approaching DeKoven Drive. Operator #1 stated he looked left and right on DeKoven Drive momentarily, did not come to a complete stop at the posted stop sign and continued across DeKoven Drive causing the front end area of vehicle #1 to make contact with the rear passenger side area of vehicle #2 which was traveling north bound on DeKoven Drive.


Operator #2 stated he was traveling north bound on DeKoven Drive approaching the RT9 exit 14 off ramp when he observed vehicle #1 traveling fast towards the stop sign at the corner of RT9 exit 14 off ramp and DeKoven Drive. Operator #2 stated he then observed vehicle #1 fail to stop at the stop sign and traveled into his travel lane causing the front end area of vehicle #1 to make contact with rear passenger side area of vehicle #2.

During the course of my investigation it was revealed that vehicle #1 did not have valid insurance.

Operator #1 was issued Misdemeanor Summons and Complaint #MC807715 for 14-13 (operating a motor vehicle without insurance) and 14-301 (failure to obey a stop sign). Operator #1 is scheduled to appear in court (GA09) on 11/16/20 at 0900 hours.

## REMARKS

On 10/06/20 at approximately 1834 hours, Ofc. Haddad, Ofc. Van Almkerk, and I, Ofc. Passacantando were dispatched to the intersection of Randolph Road and Farm Hill Road for the report of a motor vehicle accident and one of the vehicles evaded.

While in route to the crash dispatch advised that the evading vehicle was seen parking on Clover Street and a tall white male exited the vehicle wearing a white tank top. The male was seen taking bags from the car and started walking northbound on Farm Hill Road.

Upon my arrival to the scene, the male and evading driver who is later identified as Duane Wilfred Ziembra was located on Hunting Hill Avenue by Lake Street by Ofc. Van Almkerk. Ziembra verbally stated to Ofc. Van Almkerk that he left the scene because he had a suspended driver's license and he was scared.

On the scene of the collision my investigation revealed that Unit 1, CT Reg. [redacted] a 2016 Kia Forte LX was traveling westbound on Randolph Road approaching the intersection with Farm Hill Road. The vehicle was being operated by [redacted]. A second vehicle, Unit 2, CT Reg. [redacted] a 2009 Nissan Rogue was stopped for the stop sign on Farm Hill Road prior to the intersection with Randolph Road. The Rogue was being operated by [redacted]. Ziembra was operating Unit 3, CT Reg. [redacted] a 1993 Chrysler New Yorker Salon. Unit 3 was driving eastbound on Randolph Road and attempted to make a left turn (northbound) onto Farm Hill Road when his vehicle was struck by unit 1. Unit 3 was pushed into unit 2 as a result of the initial impact. No injuries were reported on scene.

A DMV check of Ziembra's identification revealed he had a suspended driver's license and the vehicle he was driving the registration had expired on 09/24/20. Ziembra was placed under arrest by Ofc. Van Almkerk and was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing.

Ziembra was charged with C.G.S. 14-224(b) "evading responsibility," 14-215(a) "operating a motor vehicle with a suspended driver's license," 14-12(a) "failure to renew registration," 14-245 "failure to grant right of way at an intersection."

Ziembra was processed without incident and held on a \$10,000 bond set by Lt. Maturo. Ziembra has a scheduled arraignment date of 10/07/20 at GA09 Middletown at 0900 hours.

On 09-16-20 the accused, Massimo Demedici, burned a large area of trees in the back yard of 115 Wanda Lane. The area was a fourteen by fourteen foot area and was of concern as the fire risk has been high due to the severe lack of rain. Said area was very close to the home.

Accused did NOT have a permit for said burn and the Westfield Fire Marshall stated that a permit would NOT ever be issued for an open burn in someone's back yard due to the risk of a home burning down. The WFD Fire Marshall warned the residence in August 2020 to cease their burning, yet it continues.

The accused admitted to setting the fire and was issued a MSC for Open burning. Court date 11-20-20.
