REMARKS

On 10/07/2020, I responded to a hotel in Middletown for a report of a fight in the lobby.

Upon arrival, I observed a male (Victim # 1) standing at the top of the stairwell in the main lobby and a female (Tamisha Belin) standing halfway down the flight of stairs. Both individuals were engaged in a heated verbal argument and screaming loudly.

Victim # 1 and Belin are currently in a dating relationship. Both Victim # 1 and Belin were detained.

Belin stated that the argument started because she thought Victim # 1 was talking to another female. Belin was extremely argumentative and did not state what had occurred.

Victim # 1 stated that he was cleaning their hotel room when Belin walked in with a bottle of vodka and started screaming at him. Belin had thought that Victim # 1 had another female inside the room and then started hitting him. Victim # 1 started to pack up his belongings because he didn't want to keep arguing and began bringing it upstairs to the main lobby. Belin followed Victim # 1 and continued to hit him and started biting him on his forearms. Victim # 1 reported that he never assaulted Belin. Victim # 1 had three bite marks on his forearms that he stated was from Belin biting him.

I met with the front desk employee of the hotel, _____ stated that while he was working the above two individuals came up to the lobby in an argument. He stated that the argument became physical and the female was hitting the male. Video surveillance footage of the main lobby was reviewed. The female was observed on several occasions hitting the male in the head and appeared to be the primary aggressor in the matter.

A guest of the hotel, _____ stated that he was staying in a hotel room directly above the above two individuals. He reported that when in his room he heard the two of them arguing and heard a male say "don't touch me" and "you always put your hands on me".

Belin was advised that she was under arrest. Belin was transported to this department for processing.


During transport Belin made several suicidal comments to Ofc Kominske and was later transported to Middlesex Hospital on a PEER.

_____ indicated Belin was the respondent in an active Protective Order listing Victim # 1 as the protected person. The order states for Belin to surrender or transfer all firearms and ammunition, to not assault, threaten, abuse, harass, follow, interfere with, or stalk the protected person, to stay away from the home of the protected person or wherever the protective person shall reside and that Belin may return to the protected person's home one time with police to retrieve belongings. This order is to remain in effect until further order of the court.


Belin was processed and charged with Assault in the Third Degree (53a-61), Breach of Peace in the Second Degree (53a-181) and Violation of Protective Order (53a-223). Belin was released on a \$25,000 non-surety bond. Belin is scheduled to appear before Middletown Superior Court GA-9 on 10/07/2020, at 0900 hours. A Conditions of Release Family Violence form was completed, all boxes were checked.

It should be noted that while attempting to have Belin transported to the hospital on a PEER she became extremely irate, uncooperative and threatening towards officers. She had to be physically restrained in order to be secured on the stretcher. Belin continued to state that she was going to bite and spit on officers. While attempting to get Belin into the ambulance she spit at me hitting me directly in my face. Belin was put into the ambulance and transported to Middlesex Hospital. Arrest warrant for Assault on a Public Safety Officer (53a-167c) to be completed.

REMARKS

On 10-07-2020 at approximately 1317 hours I, Officer Hillman, was dispatched to Cross St. by Vine St. for an intoxicated person. The call originated from the fire department and said a vehicle was stopped in the middle of the road and the driver was impaired.

Upon arrival, I observed Daniel Phillips who was sitting inside his vehicle and appeared intoxicated. Phillips was suspected of operating under the influence and agreed to submit to the standardized field sobriety tests. He failed all three tests including the horizontal gaze nystagmus, walk and turn and the one leg stand. Phillips was then placed under arrest and transported to headquarters for processing.

I later spoke of Middletown fire department who stated Phillips was sitting in his vehicle at a green light. A fire truck was stopped behind Phillips and they went to the vehicle to check on the driver. Phillips was observed with a bottle of vodka in one hand and a nipper of vodka in his other hand while

alternating drinking.

At headquarters, Phillips was read his rights and the implied consent advisory. He agreed to submit to the chemical alcohol breath test which he failed both times. The first test showed an elevated BAC of 0.3725 and the second test showed an elevated BAC of 0.3662.

Phillips was charged with violation of CGS 14-227a, Operating under the Influence. He was held on a \$500 surety bond and will be arraigned at GA 9 on 10-08-2020. He was identified by his CT drivers license which will be held for twenty four hours.

REMARKS

On 10-7-20 at approx.. 23:17hrs these officers were on patrol in the area of Main St. and Rapallo Ave. These officers were in our marked MPD cruiser #1804 which is equipped with overhead lights and an audible siren. While on patrol in the area these officers heard, what we believed to be people arguing loudly, on Rapallo just east of Main St.

When this officer turned onto Rapallo from Main we immediately observed a light skinned, black male, walking west on Rapallo towards Main. These officers immediately recognized the male as Adam Marrero. These officers had just dealt with Marrero minutes earlier on Main St. At that time Marrero was involved in an altercation with another party, whom at the time did not wish to pursue charges. This officer is extremely familiar with Marrero due to

numerous past police encounters.

As these officers passed Marrero, we observed an older male on the porch of #39 Rapallo attempting to help a woman up off the ground. The man then yelled to these officers that the woman just been assaulted by Marrero. The woman then reiterated what the man had stated, saying Marrero had just beaten her for no reason. She then stated that she would wait at #39 Rapallo for these officers to return. The witness was later identified as Pillarella would later give a sworn written statement of the following events. Pillarella stated he heard a loud noise outside of his apartment at #39 Rapallo Ave.

He stated when he came outside, he saw a man on top of someone at the building next to his. He stated the man was punching the person who was on the ground. [redacted] stated he ran inside to get some mace to fend off the attacker, however when he came out, the suspect (Marrero) was already walking away west bound on Rapallo. He stated after he saw these officers, he attempted to help the woman, whom only stated her name was [redacted]

At this time, these officers then drove back on to Main St. where we observed Marrero running into the alleyway adjacent to #605.

When we caught up with Marrero he did not resist and was subsequently detained in handcuffs. This officer then radioed for officers to respond to #39 Rapallo to speak with the female victim. Upon arrival to the area the unidentified female victim had left the scene apparently a result of possibly having warrants out for her arrest. This information was relayed to officers by the witness at #39 Rapallo. Several officers canvassed the area for the female victim with negative results.

Marrero was subsequently taken into custody and transported to the Middletown Police Dept. booking area. Marrero was charged with and processed for the charge of 53a-181 Breach of Peace. Marrero was held on a \$25,000 Surety bond and given a court date of 10-8-20 at 09:30hrs.
