REMARKS

\*\*\*\*\*ASSET FORFETURE\*\*\*\*\*

On Thursday, October 1st, 2020, Detectives from the Middletown Police Department Narcotics Unit prepared to execute a signed narcotics search and seizure warrant on 40 Broad Street, Apt 502, Middletown, CT and the person of Vincett Godet. Using DMV records, In-house history, C.I. accounts, and surveillance by Middletown Police Narcotics detectives, it was confirmed that Godet was residing there.

This search warrant was obtained as a result of numerous complaints from neighboring residents, as well as numerous hours of surveillance of the residence, and controlled purchases of narcotics using reliable C.I.(s). The investigation was conducted by the Narcotics Unit in their ongoing investigation into illegal narcotic sales occurring in Middletown.

The Narcotics Unit has received reports from all of the above mentioned sources that Godet has been utilizing 40 Broad Street, Apt 502, Middletown, CT, to sell crack/cocaine.

At approximately 0630 hours, the Middletown Police Narcotics Unit, assisted by members of the Patrol Division, and members of the Middletown Police Major Investigations Unit, proceeded to 40 Broad Street, Apt 502. to serve a search and seizure warrant on Godet and the residence.

Access to the building was gained using a key provided by the Middletown Housing Authority. Police proceeded to apartment 502 and once there, we loudly announced our presence and intent to serve a signed search and seizure warrant. After several seconds of no one answering the door, the key was used by Detective Peck to unlock the door. We then entered the apartment and encountered a male, who was standing in the kitchen. Godet was contacted near her bed. She was secured in handcuffs without issue. The male was identified as . An check was conducted and was found to be free of any warrants and was free of contraband. He was allowed to leave the apartment.

Once the residence was secured Detectives began a thorough search of the apartment.

The following items were found in 40 Broad Street, Apt 502. It should be noted that the apartment consisted of a kitchen area, a one room living area/bedroom, and a small bathroom.

In the living area/bedroom;

Godet's wallet, which was in her purse on the bed. Upon examining her wallet, Detective Peck located a sum of money found to be \$400.

On a night stand, three blue lip balm containers, which each contained suspected crack/cocaine, later found to weight a total of 2.0 grams

On a night stand, mail addressed to "Vincett Godet 40 Broad Street"

Black digital scale, cocaine residue on weight plate

Inside a black lockable cabinet, a metal tin containing multiple razor blade

Inside the same cabinet, numerous plastic bags

On top of the same cabinet, black ZTE cell phone

Top dresser draw, numerous Social Service benefit cards

The suspected crack/cocaine was tested using NARK test kit 4 and returned a positive result for the presence of cocaine. The test was performed by Detective Peck. The total amount of crack/cocaine found within the residence 2 grams. It has a known price of \$10 per 0.1 grams. If divided up for sale, the crack/cocaine has an approximate value of \$200. The scale had white residue on the weight face and that residue was tested by Detective Peck, using a NIK wipe, and returned a positive result for cocaine.

It is a common practice for individuals who are selling narcotics, to take other items, in place of cash, as payment for the narcotics. One of these items, constantly seen by detectives, is Social Service benefit cards. The cards are given to the dealer by the purchaser, along with the PIN number, so that the person selling the narcotics can access the funds attached to the card. Detectives located 12 benefit cards in Godet's dresser, from various people.

The \$400 cash that was located in Godet's wallet was paper clipped in to \$100 increments and was separate form an additional \$14 located in her wallet. Detectives know that drug dealers will intentionally keep money separate that is related to the sale of narcotics and organize it in such a fashion that the amount can be quickly known to the drug dealer.

The presence of the narcotics, multiple plastic bags which are typically used store and divide narcotics into smaller amounts for sale, the scale with residue, and numerous Social Service benefit cards, clearly demonstrates to Detectives that Godet was engaged in the sale of narcotics. All the above mentioned items were seized.

All items listed above were tagged as evidence and secured in a locker at Middletown Police Headquarters. All the suspected crack/cocaine tested positive for the presence of cocaine, using NARK test kit 4 or NARK cocaine ID wipe. All tests were performed by Detective Peck. A total of \$400 cash was seized as Asset Forfeiture.

It should be noted that 40 Broad Street is designated as "Public Housing," and is owned and operated by the Middletown Housing Authority.

Godet was arrested and was transported back to the Middletown Police Headquarters to complete the booking process. There, he was charged with the following:

- 21a-279(a)(1) Possession of Controlled Substance
- 21a-278(b) Possession with intent to sell
- 21a-278a(b) Possession WITS within public housing
- 21a-279(d) Possession of narcotics within public housing
- 21a-267(a) Possession of drug paraphernalia

During the booking process, Godet was advised of her rights and stated that she understood them. She also signed a written advisement of her rights. She, at one point, stated to Detective Lemieux that she sold drugs, but only to support her own drug habit.

She was assigned a \$100,000 non-surety bond and a court date of 11/30/2020 at GA-09.


A Check revealed that Vincett Godet has the following criminal conviction history in Connecticut: July 2005, Possession of Narcotics, July 2005, Possession near Prohibited Place, Possession of Narcotics, January 2002, Possession of Narcotics, Possession of Narcotics with Intent to Sell, January 2002, Possession of Narcotics, Failure to Appear 1st, August 2000, Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Narcotics, June 1999, Possession of Narcotics, September 1998, Possession of Narcotics. This case resulted in several Failure to Appear convictions and

Probation Violation convictions. September 1998, Criminal Impersonation, February 1997, Possession of Narcotics, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Possession of Marijuana, Criminal Impersonation. Godet is a CONVICTED felon.

"...when I get my money right watch me and Imma have guns too..."

"You going to wind up getting somebody hurt watch"

THE VICTIM stated she was not sure what would happen if Alvin came home that night but was fearful and felt threatened enough that she immediately contacted police.


Alvin Knight met with officers and admitted to sending these text messages saying he was "just mad" and meant nothing by them.

### REMARKS

On 10/11/20 at approximately 0933 hours I was dispatched to 36 Silver St. for a domestic disturbance. OFC. Maio and OFC. Capozzo also responded.

Upon arrival I spoke with VICTIM 1 and his brother, VICTIM 2. Both stated that their uncle, Jose Rivera as a substance abuse issue and they and his mother, VICTIM 3 have been trying to get him into a treatment program.

They stated that Rivera was currently under the influence of heroin and was extremely agitated. They stated that Rivera was screaming at VICTIM 3 and throwing things around the apartment. They stated that this upset VICTIM 3 so much that she nearly fainted and they brought her outside for fresh air.

They further stated that when they were outside in the driveway Rivera exited the apartment and was holding a pocket knife. They stated that the blade was opened and Rivera began advancing towards them in a threatening manner. They stated that this caused them to fear for their safety. They stated Rivera then went back into the apartment.

I spoke with VICTIM 3. I offered her medical attention which she declined. She confirmed that above statements were accurate. VICTIM 3 stated that she did see Rivera with the knife and he was making statements to the effect of "Just kill me." Or "Just kill them." She stated Rivera was on drugs and was out of control.

I then requested an ambulance to stage in the area.

OFC. Maio, OFC. Capozzo, and I entered the apartment. OFC. Maio informed me that he believed Rivera had an active arrest warrant for a previous domestic. I could hear Rivera upstairs talking to someone and I could here rapid movements and items being banged around. I had call up to Rivera to have him come down.

After several minutes Rivera came down the stairs. Fearing that he had a knife or other dangerous weapon on his person I told him not to move and took hold of his left wrist. As I was telling him I was going to check him for weapons Rivera attempted to pull his arm away from me. OFC. Capozzo grabbed his right arm and Rivera began aggressively resisting both of us, pulling us back towards the stairwell. We were unable to secure Rivera in the standing position and were forced to take him to the ground. OFC. Maio gave Rivera clear verbal commands to stop resisting and give up his arms. During this time Rivera's girlfriend, , came downstairs and began yelling. Further adding to the difficulty of the situation. After a struggle we were able to secure Rivera in handcuffs.

The handcuffs were checked for proper fit and double locked. During a search of Rivera's person a used, uncapped syringe was located in his left coat pocket. The end of the syringe was protruding through his jacket and presented an extreme hazard to officers. Rivera did not appear injured and did not complain of any injury. I observed a small abrasion on his right hand. After running Rivera's name and date of birth it was confirmed that he had an active domestic violence arrest warrant for Strangulation 2nd Degree and Assault 3rd Degree. MPD Case # 20-24806.

Rivera was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing. Rivera was charged with Threatening 2nd Degree, 53a-62, Disorderly Conduct, 53a-182, and Interfering with an Officer, 53a-167a. Rivera was held on a \$150,000 cash / surety bond with a court date of 10/13/20 at Middletown Superior Court.

Rivera was additionally processed on the arrest warrant for Strangulation 2nd Degree and Assault 3rd Degree, with a court set bond of \$10,000.

The following items were seized and stored in the Middletown Police Department evidence holding area.

- 1) Silver pocket knife with a blade approximately 3.5 inches long.
- 2) Used, uncapped, syringe.

Nothing further.

#### Domestic Violence




Rivera is currently being held at the MPD in lieu of a \$10,000 Surety bond.

### REMARKS

On 10/09/2020 at 1927 hours, I was dispatched to a residence in Middletown, Ct. to investigate a domestic violence incident. The male caller, who will be referred to as V1 (Victim #1) throughout this report, stated that his ex fiance and mother of daughter, Jasmine Passinese, attacked him and hit him in the head several times with an object.

When I arrived, I spoke with V1 who stated that Passinese came to their residence to do laundry. He stated that when she was there, he asked her to see their daughter which she said no. He stated that he later told her that he was going to go to Cromwell to see their daughter, which is where their daughter had been staying with Passinese and her parents since they separated and she left their residence several weeks ago. V1 stated that their conversation continued and Passinese continued to be smug and disrespectful to him. V1 stated that at one point, Passinese assaulted him because he told her that he wanted to see their daughter, which he stated that he has not seen for several weeks. He stated that Passinese told him that it


was her decision when to let him see their daughter and she has decided not to let him see her.

V1 stated that when Passinese assaulted him, he was sitting on the couch in his living room. He stated that she struck him on the back head twice with a metal Febreze spray bottle. I later observed and photographed the bottle which had damage to the lower portion consistent to it striking someone. I felt 2 contusions on the back of his head. V1 stated that Passinese then jumped on him and straddled him as she clawed at his head, face, and neck. I observed and photographed the physical evidence substantiating this claim. V1 stated that he was able to break free from Passinese, which he then ran out of the house and called the police.

When I later interview Passinese at police headquarters, she adamantly denied that she assaulted V1 in any way. She stated that she only went to their residence to do laundry and when it was done, she left.

### REMARKS

On 10/12/2020, at approximately 09:26 hours, I, Officer Foss-Rugan along with Officer Tetrault and Lt. Aresco responded to an address in Middletown, CT to investigate a domestic disturbance. At approximately 11:01 hours, the victim called the police again for assistance. During both calls to this residence, all of the previous officers were on scene.

Upon my arrival, I located the victim who was standing on the sidewalk across the street from where the domestic occurred. The victim said that his fiance/the accused, Patricia Taylor keeps causing problems for him. The victim said prior to calling the police, he took his house keys off the kitchen table and told Taylor that he was going to go check on the neighbor. The victim said that Taylor started an argument with him over the keys claiming they belonged to her. The victim said he continued to leave and as he was exiting the front door, Taylor slammed the door on his hand and pushed him. The victim said that he did not sustain any injuries and there were no visible markings on his hand. Officers made contact with Taylor and she said that she was in the kitchen making cinnamon rolls when the victim came in and took the keys to the residence. Taylor said that the keys were hers and that she told the victim that. Taylor said that they were verbally arguing but there was no physical acts of violence. When asked about slamming the door on the victim's hand, Taylor said this was not true. Taylor said that she was in the kitchen the whole time and that the victim was slamming doors. During the initial call, there was no evidence that a physical

domestic had occurred.

The victim said shortly after the police left, he went inside the residence because he decided he was going to move his personal property into an office area inside the residence. The victim said while moving furniture, Taylor entered the living room where he was to ask what he was doing. The victim said Taylor began yelling at him as he told her he was moving his stuff so that they could separate until things calmed down. The victim said Taylor became more upset and as he was trying to exit the office area, she stood in front of the doorway blocking him. The victim said he told Taylor to move and she did not. The victim then walked back towards one of the corners of the room and Taylor grabbed onto him while his back was turned towards her. The victim said Taylor grabbed him in the area of his elbows which resulted in Taylor scratching both of his arms. The victim said as he made his way towards the kitchen, Taylor again grabbed his left arm in the same spot. The victim said he was able to pull away and make his way out the front door where he was able to call the police. The victim said he wanted Taylor to be arrested. A signed written statement was secured from the victim and the Family Violence Conditions of Release was completed.

I then made contact with Taylor who was in the residence. Taylor said that \_\_\_\_\_ came inside after we (the police) initially left. Taylor said that \_\_\_\_\_ began moving furniture around and was upset. Taylor said that \_\_\_\_\_ then left the house and went outside. Taylor kept telling officers that the keys were hers and that she did not do anything to \_\_\_\_\_. I explained that \_\_\_\_\_ had fresh scratches on his arms and she again said she did not do anything.

I issued Taylor a Misdemeanor Summons (MC455396) charging her with 53a-182- Disorderly Conduct. A court date of 10/13/2020 at 09:00 hours at Middlesex Superior Court was issued.

### REMARKS

On 09/02/2020 at approximately 1700 I, Officer Sinclair was en-route to Middlesex Hospital for a call for service prior to encountering a two car motor vehicle collision in the area of 99 Union Street.

I observed one of the vehicles a white Buick Enclave bearing CT. Reg ; had been stopped in the right eastbound travel lane. I made contact with the operator who was later identified as Washington by his CT issued drivers license. Washington stated while traveling eastbound in the right traveling lane, his vehicle was struck by an unknown gray vehicle which fled the scene eastbound towards Dekoven Drive.

I spoke to s who was an independent witness to the collision. ; said she heard the collision but, was unable to verify the facts of the accident. s stated a gray Honda was involved in the collision and had fled the scene towards DeKoven Drive after the collision. ; said she was able to capture a photograph of the evading vehicle's registration plate which she provided. The photo displayed a gray Honda which displayed CT.Reg on the rear of the vehicle.

I contacted the Middletown Central Dispatch Center who later ran the above stated registration through DVM Dispatch advised me the plated came back valid and was registered to Mark Conlon


I contacted Conlon who later agreed to drive the vehicle to the police department. When questioned about the accident, Conlon admitted he was involved in the accident on Union Street. He said while operating a gray 2001 Honda Accord bearing CT.Reg. he slowed down to look for the entrance to Walgreen on Union Street before his vehicle was rear ended by Washington's vehicle. Conlon said even though he was rear-ended he did not stop and drove home to Deep River after the incident.

Due to the above facts and circumstances, it was determined that Conlon evaded responsibility, he did not provide his insurance information to the other operator involved in the crash, and did not make any attempt to contact the police to report the accident. Conlon was issued Misdemeanor Summons (MC807843) for the following violation of the Connecticut General Statute:


