Following our call today please find this email confirming the proposed extend of existing buildings to be removed during the construction of the proposed New Wesleyan Science Project.

1. Four houses on the north side of Lawn Avenue are proposed to be removed. These include:
  - 38 Lawn Avenue
  - 34 Lawn Avenue
  - 22 Lawn Avenue
  - 20 Lawn Avenue
2. Additionally the existing Hall Atwater Science Building, on the north side of Lawn Avenue, will also be removed following occupation of the New Science Building.
3. No other buildings either on or off site are proposed to be removed as part of the project scope.

Attached please also find a simple site plan confirming the same. The dashed buildings in the attached plan are those buildings to be removed.

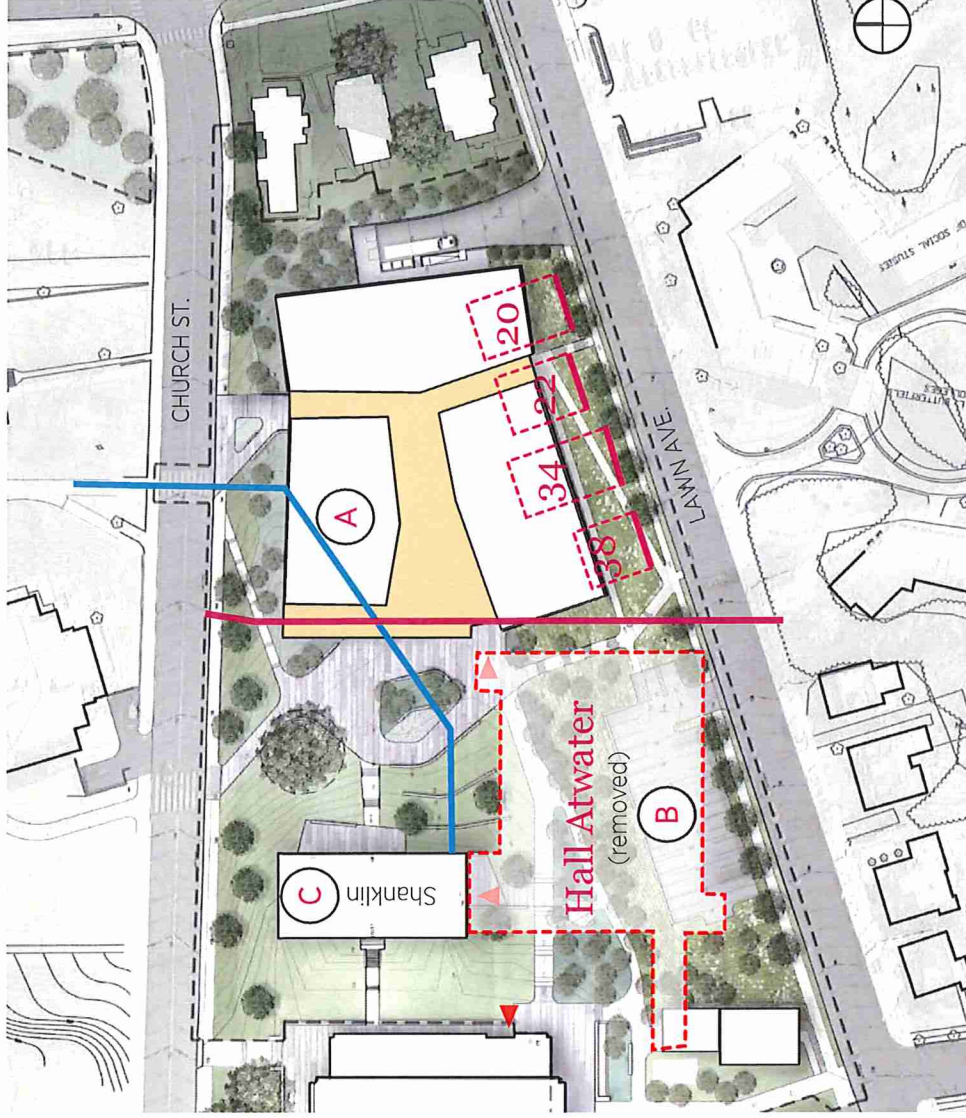
