T Levine signed the summons. T Levine was identified by CT License number I issued T Levine Conditions of Release, with all boxes checked off, which he signed for.

REMARKS

On 1-27-20, at or about 18:40hrs, this officer was dispatched to the intersection of West Lake Dr. and East Street, for the report of an evading accident. Upon arrival this officer met with the complainant, identified as

explained, and later gave a sworn written statement of the following events. She stated that she was stopped at the traffic signal on West lake drive at East Street. stated she was directly behind a dark blue colored, Dodge Caravan, bearing Ct registration vehicle did sustain very minor damage to the front licence plate and the front bumper in the area of the licences plate.

On 1-27-21 a check of DMV records indicated that the vehicle is registered to a Destiny Wells, of #147 Trolley Crossing Middletown. This Officer is very familiar with Wells due to numerous past police encounters.

stated that the van began to roll back, at which time she honked her horn in an attempt to get the drivers attention. She stated the vehicle did not stop in time and as a result struck the front of her vehicle.

stated the light then turned green and the driver then drove away without any acknowledgment of the collision. stated she then followed the vehicle as it drove north on East St., for approximately one block. She stated the vehicle then stopped at the light for the intersection of East St. and Route #372. stated she then exited her vehicle and approached the drivers side of the evading vehicle. When she met at the drives door the operator, later identified by this officer as Wells, did not acknowledge the fact that was standing at her

door. tated Wells then drove away traveling west on Route #372 into the town of Cromwell.

hen explained to this officer that prior to Wells leaving the scene, she was able to take a photograph of her license plate as well as a clear photo of Wells in the drivers seat of the vehicle.

When this officer observed the photographs, I was immediately able to identify the female operator as Destiny Wells. This officer was able to positively ID Wells due to numerous past Police encounters with her.

On 1-27-21 at approximately 13:00hrs this Officer Brooks and myself went to #147 Trolley Crossing where we met with Wells. Wells first tried to deny any involvement in the incident, however after I explained to her that there were actual photos of her, she changed her story and admitted she was there. Wells claimed she had no knowledge of her vehicle rolling back and she did not believe she did anything wrong. Wells then immediately changed her story and admitted her vehicle struck vehicle. Wells stated she didn't acknowledge the incident because she didn't believe there was any damage.

On 1-27-21 this officer issued Wells a Misdemeanor summons #Mc715732 for the charge of C.G.S 14-224 Evading responsibility. She was also given a verbal warning for C.G.S 14-243 Unsafe starting or backing. Wells was given a court date of 4-16-21 at 09:30hrs at GA# 9. Nothing further end.
