SUMMARY:

The accused Brandon BELL was issued a Summons (MC807716) for violating CGS 14-147(c) Operating under a Mis-use, 14-12(a)* Un-registered motor vehicle, 14-13 Failure to carry insurance, and 14-36(a) No license. Brandon BELL lost control of his vehicle where he became stuck in a snow bank while operating the vehicle. The facts and circumstances are as follows:

NARRATIVE:

On 1/27/21 at 1535hrs, while on duty assigned to the MPD Patrol Division Ofc Tetrault and I Ofc Nettis were dispatched to the area of David Dr and Margarite Rd for a disabled motor vehicle. Upon arrival I spoke to the operator identified as Brandon BELL by his valid identification card. Brandon BELL stated he was traveling north on Margarite Rd and soon lost control of the vehicle sliding into a snow bank. No injuries were reported.

The vehicle's front end was stuck in a snow and did not appear to have any visual damage. The vehicle: 1999 Honda Accord LX color tan bearing This plate was ran through DMV records and found to be a misuse. See DMV documents attached to further details. The maker plate belongs on a 2003 Hyundai Sonata color silver. Brandon BELL'S stated he recently purchased this vehicle and has yet to register or insured it. A Vin Check on the vehicle was done no status.

On 02/08/2021 at approximately 21:52 HRS, I (Officer Van Almkerk) was stopped at a red traffic signal at the intersection of Main Street and Washington Street. While waiting for the red traffic signal to turn green, I observed a blue 2006 Toyota Solara (Bearing Rhode Island registration traveling west on Washington Street well below the 30 MPH posted speed limit. Dispatch advised there was no information found regarding Rhode Island registration indicating the operator of the vehicle was in violation of Connecticut General Statute (CGS) 14-12(a)*.

When the red traffic signal turned green, I began to travel west on Washington Street in attempt to initiate a motor vehicle stop. It appeared the operator of the aforementioned vehicle observed me traveling west on Washington Street and began to travel at a high rate of speed north on High Street in attempt to possibly elude me. When I continued north onto High Street, the vehicle was no longer in sight. I started to canvass the area and observed the vehicle parked in the parking lot behind The Flood Law Firm (190 Washington Street). The vehicle's headlights were off and it was parked in the most desolate and darkened area of the parking lot.

As I approached the driver side of the vehicle, the operator (Later positively identified by as Jamal Lawson) rolled down the driver side window and put his hands in the air. Lawson explained he pulled into

the above mentioned address because he had to urinate. I later canvassed the area and there was no evidence of urination found. I asked Lawson for his driver's license, vehicle registration, and proof of insurance. Lawson said he did not have a driver's license, and the vehicle was not registered or insured. Lawson recently took ownership of the vehicle and had not had the time to properly register or insure it.

While speaking to Lawson, I observed what appeared to be a digital scale on the driver's side floor board below him. Digital scales are commonly used by individuals involved in the sale of illegal drugs. Typically, the drug dealer will buy the illegal drug in bulk at a discounted price. They will then break the illegal drug down into smaller amounts by weight and repackage it to increase profits through street level sales. Next to the digital scale, I observed several large zip lock bags containing a granular crystal substance which I immediately identified as suspect crystal methamphetamine. The zip lock bags appeared to be full with suspected crystal methamphetamine prior to our encounter. When I illuminated the back seat of the vehicle with my flashlight, I observed several smaller empty zip lock bags on floor board behind Lawson's seat. Although the empty zip lock bags were smaller in size, they were consistent with the ones observed on the driver's side floor board below Lawson.

During the search of the interior of the vehicle, I located two cellular telephones on driver seat where Lawson was seated. It is common for individuals involved in the sale of illegal drugs to be in possession of multiple cellular telephones. Typically, one of the phones is referred as a "burner phone", "work phone" or "trap phone", and is mostly used to make contact with drug users or other drug dealers. The phones are usually cheaper and often pre-paid in an attempt to avoid detection from law enforcement. This is also done so the drug dealer can discard it without losing much money and get a new one, or change phone numbers after a period of time. Further inspection of the digital scale revealed suspected crystal methamphetamine residue on the scale's stainless steel platform. I then found a large zip lock bag containing suspected crystal methamphetamine in the sunglass storage compartment above the dashboard. Next to the small empty zip lock bags on the floor board behind Lawson's seat, I located a wallet containing debit cards embroidered with Lawson's name. The wallet also contained a large sum of currency, later determined to be \$211, folded in a manner consistent with illegal drug sales. The currency was separated and organized in a manner consistent with an individual engaged in the sale of illegal drugs. Individuals involved in the sale of illegal drugs will organize currency in this particular manner to conduct expedited transactions and account for their sales and inventory.

Utilizing a NIK 6423 Methamphetamine Test, the suspected crystal methamphetamine tested positive for the presence of methamphetamine. The crystal methamphetamine weighed 3.77 grams. The street value of the crystal methamphetamine was determined to be \$377.00 if sold at \$100.00 per 1 gram.

The large quantity of crystal methamphetamine found was far more than an individual would have for personal use, and is indicative of illegal drug sales. Furthermore, how the crystal methamphetamine was

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packaged and packaging material located made it evident Lawson was directly involved in the sale of crystal methamphetamine.

It should be noted, the motor vehicle stop was initiated within 1500 feet (1,256.79 feet) of 300 Washington Street (ACES Middlesex County Early Head Start/ACES Middletown Community Education Center). See attached Google Maps.

A criminal history check of Lawson indicated no previous convictions.

An out of state criminal history check of Lawson indicated an extensive criminal history including possession of a controlled substance, assault, and possession of a dangerous weapon.

Lawson was charged with violation of CGS 14-36(a) Operating MV Without License, CGS 14-12(a)* Operate/Tow Unregistered Motor Vehicle, CGS 14-213b Illegal Operation Motor Vehicle Without Minimum Insurance, CGS 14-147(c) Improper Use of Marker Plate; CGS 21a-279(a)(1) Possession of Controlled Substance, CGS 21a-279(b) Possession of Controlled Substance within 1,500 Feet, CGS 21a-267(a) Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, CGS 21a-267(c) Possession of Drug Paraphernalia with 1,500 Feet, CGS 21a-278(b) Possession of Controlled Substance with Intent to Sell by Non-Drug-Dependent Person, CGS 21a-278(b) Possession of Controlled Substance with Intent to Sell by Non-Drug-Dependent Person within 1,500 Feet. Lawson was released on a \$25,000 non-surety bond, and is scheduled to appear at GA9 Middletown Superior Court on 04/09/2021 at approximately 09:00 HRS.
