Upon arrival, Michael stepped outside onto the front porch and began telling me his version of events about the dispute between himself and his tenant _____. Upon viewing Michael, his face was reddened with small droplets of sweat on his forehead. I did not observe any injuries to his person or signs that he had been involved in a physical altercation.

Michael was detained on the front porch with Officer Colon, while I entered the residence and made contact with _____. _____ was found uninjured and she did not appear to have been involved in a physical altercation.

Upon interviewing Michael, he stated that he was involved in a verbal dispute with his tenant _____ about her cats and the cat food she leaves out for them. Michael explained that the cats are a disturbance and their food creates a mess that he should not have to deal with. Michael initially stated that he merely tried to swipe _____ phone off the kitchen table during the argument. After questioning Michael about his version of events Michael was forthcoming and admitted to having taken _____ cellular phone away from her when she was attempting to contact the Police.

_____ stated that she rents a bedroom from Michael and has been living with him for the past two weeks. _____ explained that she pays \$100.00 per week rent and she is required to pay one week rent in advance.

further stated that Michael does not like her cats and has had an issue with the cats and the food she leaves out for them since she moved in. stated that Michael arrived home at about 2300 hours, and was unhappy again about her cats. Michael began yelling at and told her that if she did not keep her cats and their food in an orderly manner as he instructed her to, he was going to kick her out of the apartment. argued with Michael and then she said he began to scare her with how angry he was becoming. took her cellular phone out of her purse and informed Michael that she was going to call the Police. Michael then grabbed the cellular phone out of her hands preventing her from contacting 911. began to yell and scream for help hoping a neighbor would hear her. was able to snatch the phone back from Michael and call 911. The altercation never became physical other than the grabbing of the cellular phone.

stated that she is scared of Michael and she wished to pursue criminal charges. provided a written statement which is attached to this report.

Michael was charged with violation of C.G.S. 530182 – Disorderly Conduct and 53a-183b - Interfering with an Emergency Call. Michael was held on a \$10,000.00 surety bond and is due to appear at GA-9 Middlesex Superior Court on 4/7/2021, to answer to the above charges.

This case is closed by arrest.
