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On Friday, April 9, 2021 at 1646 hrs Victim 1 who resides in this City contacted Middletown Dispatch to report her ex-husband was touching her inappropriately.

I, Ofc. Zadjura was assigned to investigate the incident and arrived on scene a short time later with Ofc. Haddad. Upon my arrival, I was met by Victim 1.

Victim 1 stated Charles Mishler who lives with her was intoxicated. The agreement they have which allows him to stay within her home is that he must remain sober. She learned today he had been drinking and when she confronted him she noticed he appeared to be intoxicated. While he was in his room, she entered his room to look for his alcohol and he became agitated. He then grabbed her by her right breast and squeezed until it caused her pain. At that point Victim 1 said she slapped Mr. Mishler in the face while he was still squeezing her right breast, she was hoping this would stop his actions. He then let go of her breast and grabbed on to her right arm and twisted it, he then slammed her right arm in to the wall which caused some minor abrasions. While he was twisting her arm a bracelet she was wearing broke, the bracelet had no value other than sentimental.

Victim 1 provided Ofc. Haddad a written sworn statement which stated the above information.

I observed Victim 1's right arm and saw her skin was red and irritated and appeared to have fresh surface abrasions to her skin. Ofc. Haddad documented those injuries by taking photographs.

Victim 1 informed us that prior to our arrival, a friend of Mr. Mishler's came to the house to help calm him

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down. Before we entered the home that male party came out and said he spoke with Mr. Mishler and he was currently calm. This individual did not witness the incident and only arrived after being called to help calm Mr. Mishler down.

I then went in to the residence and entered a bedroom where I located a male party laying down in bed, fully clothed and wearing sneakers. This male was identified as Charles Mishler I called out to him and he responded telling officers he was asleep. Mr. Mishler initially told officers had only consumed a little bit of alcohol, but then later stated he did not consume any alcohol. I asked Mr. Mishler if he and Victim 1 had any interaction prior to our arrival, he said they had not and that he was sleeping. He was asked again, and he again stated they had not.

Mr. Mishler was asked to stand up at which point he stood up and placed his own hands behind his back. At that point he was placed in to double locked handcuffs which were checked for proper fit.

During my interaction with Mr. Mishler he appeared to be intoxicated by alcohol, his eyes were very watery he was unsteady on his feet and I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his person.

Based on the above facts and circumstances it was determined that Mr. Mishler appeared to be the dominant aggressor and that Victim 1's actions were in self-defense.

Mr. Mishler was advised her was under arrest, he was then placed into the rear seat of my clearly marked police cruiser, seat belted in and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for Processing. Mr. Mishler was processed for the violations of CGS 53a-182 - Disorderly Conduct and 53a-117 Criminal Mischief in the Third Degree. He was released from Middletown Police custody in lieu of a \$5,000 non-surety bond. He is scheduled to appear at GA-09 (1 Court St Middletown, CT 06457) on April 12, 2021 at 09:00 hrs.

A Check was conducted and it appears Mr. Mishler has had several convictions regarding Family Violence incidents.

On 04/10/2021 at approximately 1009 hours, I Officer Kominske was on routine patrol in a marked Middletown Police cruiser. I observed a brown Mazda 3 bearing (GA temporary registration) parked directly in front of Price Chopper grocery store (855 Washington Street, Middletown). The Mazda was parked in a clearly marked "no parking fire lane tow zone." The no parking zone was marked on the pavement with yellow strips and lettering as well as a red and white sign posted on the wall of the building. The Mazda's engine was on and music was playing from inside the vehicle loudly. While standing next to the vehicle I could detect the distinct odor of unburnt marijuana emanating from the interior of the vehicle. I was able to identify the odor through my training and experience. There were no occupants inside the Mazda and the rear window was partially down.

Further, while standing next to the vehicle I could see an open plastic bag containing a large amount of green leafy material (suspected marijuana) on the passenger side rear seat. I was immediately able to identify the leafy material as marijuana through my training and experience. I could also see an open plastic sandwich bag containing the same green leafy material (suspected marijuana) in the center console cup holder. I entered price chopper and observed a male exiting the store carrying a 12 pack of new glass mason jars on his shoulders. The male was later identified as Shaquille Mitchell (

by his CT Driver's license which he provided me. I asked Mitchell if he was the owner of the Mazda 3 parked in the fire lane. Mitchell replied "yes I was just buying something quick." Mitchell also stated he was operating the Mazda on Washington Street prior to parking the vehicle.

A check with dispatch revealed the Mazda's registration was expired as of 11/26/2020 and unconfirmed insurance. I asked Mitchell if the Mazda was insured. Mitchell stated "no, I am working on it. I just got pulled over by the New Haven Police Department yesterday and he told me to get insurance." Mitchell also text messaged his Insurance agent who told him the Mazda was not insured and he should not have moved the vehicle.

At this time, Officer Maio arrived on scene. I asked Mitchell about the marijuana inside the vehicle and he stated it was for personal consumption. Mitchell stated he does not sell marijuana because he is an Uber/Lyft driver. I asked Mitchell if he had a medical marijuana card and he replied "no." I quickly searched the interior of the Mazda and observed a plethora of marijuana and drug paraphernalia. At this time Sgt. Dirga arrived on scene and I placed Mitchell into handcuffs. Sgt. Dirga read Mitchell his Miranda rights which he waived and agreed to speak with officers.

A search of the interior of the Mazda resulted in locating the following items.

One open plastic bag containing 152.09 grams (with packaging) of green leafy material found on the passenger side rear seat (weighed on department scale).

One plastic bag with writing "Rsoo1" containing 126.55 grams (with packaging) of green leafy material found on the passenger side rear floor board (weighed on department scale).

14 new unused metallic foil bags with "runtz" printed on them found in the center console. These types of bags are commonly used to package marijuana.

One black plastic shopping bag containing 7 gold plastic containers containing 104.97 grams (with packaging) of green leafy material found on the front passenger side floor board. (weighed on department scale).

One grey plastic shopping bag containing 13 clear plastic containers containing 169.57 grams (with packaging) of green leafy material found on the front passenger side floor board. (Weighed on department scale).

One open plastic sandwich bag containing 15.76 grams (with packaging) of green leafy material found in the cup holder of the center console (weighed on department scale).

Three metallic foil bags with "runtz" printed on them containing 25.38 grams (with packaging) of green leafy material found on the driver side rear seat in a white plastic shopping bag (weighed on department scale).

One box of sandwich bags, package of cigars, four plastic bags containing 76.70 grams (with packaging) of green leafy material found in a white plastic shopping bag on the driver side rear seat (weighed on department scale).

One brown glass jar containing 114.77 grams (glass jar not weighed) of green leafy material found in a white plastic shopping bag on the driver side rear seat (weighed on department scale).

One glass jar containing 12.18 grams (glass jar not weighed) of green leafy material found in a white plastic shopping bag on the driver side rear seat (weighed on department scale).

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Sgt. Dirga located two glass jars containing 162.47 and 93.84 grams (glass jars not weighed) of green leafy material found in the trunk of the Mazda (weighed on department scale).

Sgt. Dirga located two boxes containing 108 plastic containers and a large amount of plastic zippered bags with a red apple "3030 made in china original" printed on them found in the trunk of the Mazda.

These bags are also frequently used to package marijuana.

Sgt. Dirga located one black digital scale in the center console. Scales are used to used by drug dealers to break large amounts of marijuana into smaller amounts for sale.

The above listed items were seized and entered into evidence including the 12 pack of mason jars and Mitchell's cell phone (Apple Iphone). While on scene Mitchell voluntarily provided me the password to his Iphone (6370). Inside the Mazda Sgt. Dirga located a service/ maintenance receipt for the Mazda listing Mitchell as the customer.

I know the large volume of suspected marijuana in Mitchell's possession was far more than an individual would have for personal use, but is rather indicative of sales. That coupled with unused/ new packaging material, and the digital scale, made it evident that Mitchell was directly involved in the sale of marijuana.

Mitchell was placed under arrest and I transported Mitchell to HQ. Officer Maio remained with the Mazda until it was towed from the scene. Officer Brooks booked and processed Mitchell charging him with the following CGS 21a-267(a)Use of Drug paraphernalia, Drug paraphernalia, 21a-277(b) Possession of controlled substance with intent to sell, 21a-279(a)(1) Possession of cannabis greater than half ounce, 14-213b failure to have minimum insurance, 14-251 Improper motor vehicle parking and 14-12(a)* Operating an unregistered motor vehicle. Mitchell was held on a \$25,000 bond and scheduled to be presented at GA 09 04/12/2021.

A small amount of green leafy material (suspected marijuana) was placed into Duquenois-Levine Reagent test NARK 8 for THC. After following the manufacturer's test procedures, the material tested indicated the presumptive presence of marijuana. The total weight of suspected marijuana was 1,059.28 grams (2.33 lbs). A known street value of marijuana is \$20 a gram would put the total value of all suspected marijuana seized at \$21,185.60.

Officer Van Almkerk canvassed the area for Scott and observed him in front of 80 Nutmeg Court. Officer Van Almkerk stated Scott told him he has not been compliant with his medications and wanted to kill himself.

I arrived on scene at 80 Nutmeg Court and spoke with Scott. He confirmed he was involved in a verbal

On 4-11-21 I, Officer Small was assigned to the Patrol Division on the Overnight Shift.

Shortly after 4am, Officers were dispatched to Bridge St for a report of an altercation between a male and female, with additional males standing around.

Upon arrival, a group of uncooperative parties were located. Two of the parties were found to be siblings (Brother/sister). Those two siblings engaged in a physical altercation, with Jakwan Walton determined to be the primary aggressor. The female victim had a bloody nose, bloody lip and blood on her sweatshirt.

A witness who wanted to remain anonymous videotaped a part of the incident. On the video, the two sibling are engaging in a physical altercation with punches thrown. The parties are separated, then Walton re-engages the victim and throws a punch to her face.

Walton was advised that he was under arrest for the domestic charges. During the transport to the police department, Walton threatened Ofc. van Almkerk, with "I'll fuck you", "I'll beat your ass."

Walton continued to act out of control, and remained uncooperative. Walton refused to be processed and was secured in cell #5. While inside, Walton threw a wet ball of toilet paper at the cell camera. Due to the safety concern, Walton was escorted to the EDP cell. Walton was uncooperative and threw a punch towards me, which did not hit me. Walton was secured in the cell.
