REMARKS

On 4-7-16, at or about 2059 hrs, I was at the intersection of Grandview and East Street, on Grandview. I observed a vehicle traveling south on East Street, with only one operational headlight, in violation of Connecticut General Statute 14-96b. I pulled onto East Street and then observed that the vehicle only had one operational tail light, in violation of CGS 14-96c.

I got behind the vehicle and activated my emergency lights and siren and stopped the vehicle on Glenwood Terrace by East Street. The vehicle was a gray Nissan, bearing CT registration plate 141KJM.

I had illuminated the vehicle with the spot light on my cruiser. I noticed that the driver and lone occupant of the vehicle, started smoking something as soon as he stopped the vehicle, creating a large amount of smoke inside the vehicle. I know through my training and experience as a police officer, that people will use the smell of smoke to conceal the smell of narcotics inside a vehicle.

I approached the vehicle on the driver's side and made contact with the driver, identified as Marquese Flowers, by his CT drivers license. Flowers was smoking a vapor device and I requested that he stop smoking it, as the interior of the vehicle was completely filled with smoke. I illuminated the inside of the vehicle with my flashlight and noticed the inside of cigars on the floor board and on the center console. I also noticed a green/brown leafy substance inside the vehicle, that I recognized through my training and experience as a police officer, as suspected marijuana. As I interacted with Flowers, asking for his registration and insurance and informing him about his light, I started to smell the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle.

I asked Flowers when the last time he smoking marijuana inside the vehicle. Flowers said that he had smoked marijuana a few hours ago. Due to Flowers admitted marijuana use inside the vehicle, the small amounts of marijuana I observed inside the vehicle, and the smell of marijuana coming from the vehicle, I asked Flowers to step out for the car, which he did, but protested, asking why he was being asked to step out.

I conducted a search of Flowers and did not find any contraband, however, I detected the smell of marijuana coming from his person.

I then began to search the vehicle. In the center console, I located a clear, plastic, ziplock type bag, which contained another bag, which contained an amount of suspected marijuana. The suspected marijuana was tested, using NARK test kit 8 and came back with a positive result as marijuana. The total weight was 30 grams. The marijuana was removed from the vehicle and secured in my cruiser.

I then got my narcotics detection K9, Otto, from my vehicle and conducted a search of the vehicle utilizing him. When Otto came to the trunk area, on the exterior of the vehicle, he alerted. I asked Flowers if there was any other marijuana or other narcotics inside the vehicle and he said that there wasn't. I opened the trunk of the vehicle and presented Otto to it. Otto then alerted on a blue back pack which was inside the trunk. I opened the back pack and found two clear, plastic, vacuum seal style bags inside, which both contained suspected marijuana. I also located an number of clear, plastic, zip lock type bags, similar to the ones that contained the marijuana that was located inside the center console. The suspected marijuana inside each of the vacuum bags was tested using NARK test kit 8 and both came back positive as marijuana. The total weight of both bags was 56 grams. The total amount of marijuana found was 86 grams or 3.03 ounces. The total street value of the marijuana was estimated between \$750 and \$900.

The amount of marijuana located inside the vehicle was well above the amount typically seen for personal use. That, in addition to the multiple plastic bags found with the larger amount of marijuana in the trunk of the vehicle, leads me to believe that the marijuana was not strictly being used by Flowers and that Flowers was selling marijuana.

Flowers was then placed under arrest. He was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters to be processed. There he read and signed his right form. He was charged with Possession of Marijuana, 21a-279(c), and Possession with Intent to sell, 21a-277(a). During the book process, Flowers continually argued that he was not selling marijuana and that it was all for his personal use. Flowers was assigned a court date if 4-21-16 and released on a \$5000 non-surety bond.

Flowers was issued a verbal warning for the violations of 14-96b and 14-96c, which was the original reason for the stop.

Flowers did not have any criminal history displayed on a State Police Records Check ()

REMARKS

On 4/11/16 at approximately 17:24 hours, I, Officer Remotti, responded to the area of 7 Countryside Lane for a report of two black males in a tan SUV snorting a white powder.

Upon arrival, I identified the operator as Donnell Cherry. Cherry had a white powder residue on the top of and inside his left nostril. While waiting for officer Schreiner to arrive, Cherry informed me he owned the vehicle and that there was nothing illegal within it. I asked him for consent to search the vehicle to which he stated "search there is nothing in here".


Once Officer Schreiner arrived on-scene, Cherry was removed from the vehicle and searched for weapons and contraband In the front left pants pocket of D. Cherry, I felt a cylindrical tube which I later determined to be a pill case. Inside the case, was a white powder which later tested positive for an opiate based drug using NARK test kit #3. The powder had a T.A.W. of 1.65 grams and was identified by D. Cherry as

crushed Oxycodone pills. A search of the vehicle revealed a paper envelope, typically utilized by banks to put cash in, folded inside the flip down sun glass case on the ceiling of the vehicle. Inside the envelope, I located 5.5 white oval pills which were identified as Oxycodone (325mg/10mg).

As a result of these findings, D. Cherry was placed in handcuffs which were checked for tightness and double locked before he was transported by me to police headquarters. D. Cherry was advised of his rights at 1815 hours which he signed indicating he understood. D. Cherry was photographed, fingerprinted, and processed under UAR# 8872886 for the charges of Possession of Narcotics; 21a-279(a), and Illegal Storage of Narcotics; 21a-257 in violation of C.G.S. He was assigned a G.A. 9 court appearance date of 4/22/16 and was released on a \$10,000 non-surety bond. The seized narcotics were tagged into evidence and a JDCR18 form was completed.

No further police action was taken at this time.

REMARKS

On 4/15/16 at approximately 1951hrs Officer Terribile and I (Officer Wasilewski) checked on a suspicious party in the rear parking lot of 700 Main Street. The white male (later identified as Michael Kolenda) was looking in the window of a Dodge Caravan parked on the north side of the parking lot.

As we pulled up behind the caravan, Kolenda walked away from our vehicle toward the front of the Caravan. Kolenda admitted to smoking a marijuana cigarette. He stated he dropped it on the ground as we drove up.

A subsequent search of Kolenda's person revealed a clear tube, similar in size to a clear plastic pen, with white powdery residue inside. The trace amount of powder inside was too little to test with a drug test kit. Kolenda was also found to be possessing a round half broken yellowish-orange pill which was hidden in the bottom of his cigarette pack. From the remaining piece of pill I was able to see that the pill had an imprint of "40" on one side and "OP" on the other side. I researched the pill on the "Drugs.com" website app on my smart phone. The website provided a matching photograph of the pill which was listed as "Oxycontin 40mg". The Oxycontin40mg pill is a Schedule 2 Narcotic Analgesic with a high potential for abuse. It is classified as a Controlled Substance under the (CSA) Controlled Substance Act. Kolenda later admitted to buying the pill in the north end of Middletown and crushing half of the pill to snort it.

Later at the Police Department I (Officer Wasilewski) researched the State of Connecticut Patient RX History Report. Kolenda was listed as being prescribed Suboxone solution in 2015 but did not currently have any prescription for Oxycodone listed in his name. The State of Connecticut Patient RX History Report and Oxycodone information researched on the Drugs.com website were submitted with the cast documents. The pill, snorting tube, cigarette pack, and marijuana cigarette were seized and tagged as evidence.

Kolenda was placed under arrest and transported to the Middletown Police Department where he was read his rights, photographed, finger printed, and processed. Kolenda was charged with violation of CGS 21a-279a Possession of a Controlled Substance and 21a-267d Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. He was released on a \$5,000 Non-Surety bond and issued a court date of 5/4/16 at 0900hrs. It was explained to him that he would have to appear at the GA 9 court house on that date and time. He stated he understood.



The warrant was cancelled through dispatch and they provided me with _____ and _____



The arrestee bit the victim's left hand, which caused a laceration and left scratches / marks to the victim's chest and arms.


The arrestee was transported to MPD HQ where she was processed on the following charges of the C.G.S.
