REMARKS

On 04/11/16 at approximately 0122 hours I Officer Murphy was parked in a marked police cruiser at 155 Washington St. when I observed a dark colored sedan bearing CTReg.#AA68756 traveling east on Washington St. at a high rate of speed.

I then observed said vehicle take a right hand turn onto Main St. and drop off a female passenger in front of 437 Main St. As I turned right onto Main St said vehicle made an illegal "U-Turn" in front of 437 Main St. to head north back towards Washington St. While making the illegal "U-Turn" the above vehicle almost struck

my Police vehicle and then proceeded through the intersection of Main St and Washington St. while the traffic signal above displayed red.

I subsequently activated my emergency lights and siren prompting a motor vehicle stop just west of the intersection of Main St. and Washington St. Officer Foster arrived on scene simultaneously to provide assistance.

Operator and sole occupant Arikono, Lorrein was positively identified via his CT Operators license upon making contact. While initially speaking with Lorrein I could immediately smell the distinct odor of alcohol emanating from his breath. Lorrein additionally had distinct redness in his eyes and unusual difficulty answering my basic investigative questions.

Based on the above information I requested Lorrein to step out of his vehicle to submit to the Standard Field Sobriety Tests which he agreed to do without incident. All three of The Standardized Field Sobriety Tests resulted in failure.

Lorrein was then placed in handcuffs and informed that he was under arrest for C.G.S 14-227a (Operating a Motor Vehicle while Under the Influence of Drugs and/or Alcohol). Once at police headquarters, Lorrein was read a Notice of Rights form, which he acknowledged and signed at 0154 hours. I then read Lorrein verbatim Section E: Implied Consent Advisory section of the A-44 form.

Lorrein was given the opportunity to contact an attorney immediately after being read his rights at 0154 hours but refused to do so. I then requested that Lorrein provide me with a breath test, which he agreed to do. The tests were performed on our in house Drager Machine which I am currently certified in using. Lorrein's results were as follows:

Test #1: B.A.C .2648 @ 0211 hours




Lorrein was issued Misdemeanor Summons Complaint #MC330302 for C.G.S 14-227a (Operating a Motor Vehicle While Under the Influence of Drugs and/or Alcohol), C.G.S. 14-299 (Failure to Obey Traffic Signal), and C.G.S. 14-242 (Improper U-Turn).

Lorrein was informed that his CT Operators license was suspended for 24 hours from the time of the arrest.. Upon completion of the booking process Lorrein remained in temporary Police custody in male cell #8 in order to sober up before being released. He is scheduled to appear in court at GA 9 on April 25, 2016 at 0900 hours. Lorrein was subsequently released on a \$500.00 Non-Surety Bond.

REMARKS



Lassiter left the area, walking through the parking lot towards the Stop and Shop parking lot and was stopped by Detective Stead and Peck.


Lassiter admitted he had illicit drugs on his person. Detective Peck found a bundle of five wax paper folds, each

containing and off white substance that he was able to identify through his training and experience as suspected heroin.

The suspected heroin tested positive for the presumptive presence of heroin with NARK 3. It also tested positive for the presumptive presence of fentanyl with NARK 33.

Lassiter was released on a \$25,000 non-surety bond for violation of CGS 21a-279(a) Possession of Narcotics. He is scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 5/3/2016 at 0900 hours.

Black then handed the suspected heroin to the male on foot. Black and the driver got back into the Pontiac. I was able to identify this behavior as a suspected drug transaction through my training and experience in narcotics investigations.

The man on foot left the area, walking through the parking lot towards the Stop and Shop parking lot and was stopped by Detective Stead and Peck.

Simultaneously, I ran the Pontiac's registration through dispatch and discovered the vehicle's registration was expired. I initiated a traffic/investigatory stop on Bow Lane.

The male on foot admitted he had illicit drugs on his person. Detective Peck found a bundle of five wax paper folds, each containing an off white substance that he was able to identify through his training and experience as suspected heroin. He admitted that he purchased the heroin from a large black male he knows as G Black. Detective Peck called me over the radio and advised me of his findings

Black, the driver and the Pontiac were searched with negative results. Black had \$120 in US currency in his wallet and a Kyocera touch screen cellular phone.

Black was taken into custody and transported to the Middletown Police Department, where he was processed. He was advised of his Miranda rights verbally at the scene and in writing at the police department. Black refused to be fingerprinted or photographed.

The suspected heroin tested positive for the presumptive presence of heroin with NARK 3. It also tested positive for the presumptive presence of fentanyl with NARK 33.

Black held on a \$100,000 surety bond for violation of CGS 29-12 Failure to Submit to Fingerprints, 21a-279(a) Possession of Narcotics and 21a-278(b) Sale of Narcotics. He is scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 4/20/2016.
