

phone had been destroyed when his father smashed it.



He told his son that he was taking his phone away. Edward stated that his son said that if he tried taking the phone away that he would call the police. Edward stated that he knew that his son was trying to call the police when he tried taking the phone away. Edward stated that he and his son began to wrestle and fight over the phone, but stated that at no time did he put his son into a head lock.

After speaking to Edward, he gave the victim back his phone. The phone did not appear to be damaged in anyway and the victim used it to make sleeping arrangements for the night.

Edward Zehren was issued Misdemeanor Summons #MC380248 and charged with violating CGS 53a-182 Disorderly Conduct and 53a-183b Interfering with an emergency call. Family violence conditions of release were set and Zehren was released on a promise to appear. Zehren was scheduled to appear at GA09 Middletown on 08/10/2016.

REMARKS

On 06 August 2016 at 1953 hours, I was dispatched to the area of #727 Atkins Street for a reported Motor Vehicle Accident in which a vehicle struck mail boxes at the above address and proceeded to travel to #150 Footit Drive where the vehicle struck a tree.

Upon speaking to the operator; Susan Wilton (58 YO) I observed that there was an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her person, her eyes were bloodshot and glossy and her speech was slurred and slowed. She admitted to being involved in a motor vehicle accident.

I also observed that her gait was very unsteady and she was constantly stumbling and swaying back and forth. Wilton admitted to drinking vodka and wine.

Based on the above mentioned behavior and observations, I asked Wilton to submit to the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, which she agreed to do so.

The Standardized Field Sobriety Tests which consist of the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test, Walk and Turn test & the One Leg Stand test were not performed to standard.

Wilton was then placed under arrest and transported back to police headquarters.

Once back at Police Headquarters, Wilton was read his Notice of Rights form, which she signed. I then read Martin; verbatim Section E: Implied Consent Advisory of the A-44 form. She was given the opportunity to contact an attorney at approximately 2102 hours. I then requested that Wilton provide me with a breathe test, which she agreed to do so. The test results are as follows:

Breathe Test #1: B.A.C .1692 @ 2110 hours

Breathe Test #2: B.A.C .1598 @ 2130 hours

Note that throughout the entire booking process, an odor of an alcoholic beverage was emanating from Wilton's person.

Wilton was consequently issued a Misdemeanor Summons and Complaint ticket #MC330310 for CGS: 14-227a; Operating a Motor Vehicle Under the Influence of Drugs and/or Alcohol, CGS: 14-236; Failure to Maintain Lane & CGS: 14-224(a); Evading Responsibility. She is scheduled to appear at GA:09 on August 11, 2016 at 0900 hours. Wilton was released on a \$500.00 non-surety bond.

REMARKS

On 08/06/2016, at approximately 2014 hours, I responded to the Sagamore Hills apartment complex, located at 1151 Washington St, for a report of a motor vehicle accident where one operator may have been intoxicated.

As I was approaching Sagamore Hills, I observed a vehicle matching the description of one of the vehicle's involved leaving the Sagamore Hills parking lot. The vehicle turned onto Washington St and came to a stop in the roadway.

The vehicle stopped was a white 1997 Cadillac Deville bearing Ohio Registration EMX4155. This registration came back expired on a 1991 black Ford. No active registration on the VIN.

I could smell the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the operator's person and breath. The operator was later identified as Gilbert Johnson. Johnson was unable to provide me with a registration or insurance document.

Johnson was unsteady on his feet and frequently held onto his vehicle for balance. Johnson reported that he was involved in an accident and the other operator involved told him "not to worry about it".

Johnson reported that he had several beers. Johnson stated that he was drunk and high and told me to do what I had to do. There were several empty beer cans visible in the vehicle.

Johnson was either unable to perform or failed all portions of the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests.

The owner of the other vehicle involved in the accident, _____ reported Johnson backed into her vehicle causing minor damage. Johnson left without exchanging information.

Johnson's provided this officer with two breath samples.

Test #1 - Taken on 08/06/2016 at 2142 hours = .2545 Bac

Test #2 - Taken on 08/06/2016 at 2202 hours = .2549 Bac

Johnson was issued MSC # MC 455196 and MC 455197 for Driving Under the Influence, Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle, Insufficient Insurance Coverage, Evading Responsibility, and Improper Use of Registration in violation of C.G.S. 14-227a, 14-12(a)*, 14-213b, 14-224(a) and 14-147(c), respectively.

Johnson was released at 2233 hours on a \$500 non-surety bond. Johnson is scheduled to appear before Middletown Superior Court GA-9 on 08/15/2016, at 0900 hours.



