REMARKS

On August 28, 2016 at approximately 1531 hours, Officers were advised a shoplifting that had just occurred at Rite Aid (10 Main Street). The two males were last seen heading North on Main Street.

Two males, matching the description provided were located on the North side of Metro Movies. Lawrence Henderson of Grand Island, NY and were stopped and questioned regarding the incident. Henderson was eating from a can of tuna when we approached. As described, Henderson had a green messenger bag containing items reported taken from Rite Aid. The contents of the bag were brought back to Rite Aid and were confirmed as being stolen.

Rite-Aid provided a store receipt of the stolen items. The total came to \$27.46. The Rite Aid manager provided a written statement about the incident and that the parties were spoken to about taking the items. The Rite Aid manager stated she approached the males in the store when she observed Henderson put items into his bag. Henderson denied the accusations, stating he got the items from the Soup Kitchen. Rite Aid is pressing charges.

I asked Henderson when was the last time he came to Connecticut. He stated he'd been away for about nine months, and that he was planning to return home to New York tomorrow. He did not have a plan to return to Connecticut.

Based on the statement provided and Henderson being in possession of the stolen items, Henderson was handcuffed, searched and transported to the Middletown Police Department. Henderson was read his rights, photographed and fingerprinted as part of the arrest process.

Henderson is being charged with violating C.G.S. 53a-125b Larceny 6th degree. He is being held on \$5000 surety bond and is scheduled to appear at GA9 on 8/29/2016 at 0900 hours.


REMARKS



REMARKS

On 29 August 2016 at 0010 hours, officers responded to a residence for a reported Physical Domestic.

Upon arrival to the area officers first spoke to Demar Boxley (24 YO) who was outside; in front of the residence. Boxley stated that he got into a verbal argument with his girlfriend; Victim #1 and he was planning on leaving for the night.

I then went into the residence and spoke to Victim #1. I observed that she was visibly upset. She was shaking, crying and appeared to be scared. She immediately showed me bruising on her left arm and bruising and scratches to her left breast. (refer to images)

Based on the condition of the kitchen, it appeared as if a physical altercation took place. There was food scattered across the kitchen floor, a broom with a bent handle and other miscellaneous items that were on the floor.

Victim #1 then explained that she arrived home with her daughter; Victim #2 at approximately 0000 hours. She observed that Boxley was in her residence and she did not want him there due to a verbal altercation that took place earlier in the evening. Victim #1 explained that Boxley became angered when she asked him to leave causing a verbal altercation which turned physical when Boxley struck Victim #1 with a broom handle. The arguing continued and Boxley would not allow her to leave the apartment. Victim #1 also explained that Boxley grabbed/restrained her multiple times and pushed her against the refrigerator while she was holding Victim #2. Victim #1 stated that she feared for the safety of herself and Victim #2 and also felt that she could not leave the residence based on Boxley's actions.

Victim #1 provided the following signed, sworn written statement;

Victim #1 stated that it is not the first time that Boxley has been verbally and physically abusive and she no longer wants him there.

I then spoke to the upstairs (2nd floor) neighbor/complainant; Witness #1. Witness #1 stated that she was sleeping when she heard screaming and what sounded like furniture being destroyed coming from the first floor apartment. She stated that she heard Victim #1 screaming for help and also Victim #2 screaming and crying loudly. Witness #1 explained that she was in fear for the safety of both Victim #1 and #2. At this time Witness #1 stated that she went down to the first floor apartment and attempted to open the unlocked door to help when Boxley was trying to push the door shut. Witness #1 was then able to get the door completely open when she observed Victim #1 holding Victim #2 in her arms and they were both crying. Witness #1 stated that she told Boxley to leave in which he went outside. She then took Victim #2 to her apartment upstairs and called 9-1-1. Shortly after the police arrived.

Based on the evidence located on scene, the physical injury on Victim #1, the signed sworn written statement, and the information given by both Victim #1 and Witness #1; Boxley was placed in handcuffs that were double-locked and checked for proper fit. He was then transported back to Police Headquarters where he was booked and processed under UAR #8873434.

Boxley was consequently charged with CGS: 53a-182; Disorderly Conduct, CGS: 53a-61; Assault 3rd Degree, CGS: 53a-96; Unlawful Restraint & CGS: 53-21; Risk of Injury to a Minor. Boxley is being held on a \$10,000.00 surety bond and is scheduled to appear at GA:09 on August 29, 2016 at 0900 hours. He is being held in male cell #1. Nothing further.

REMARKS

Motor Vehicle Complaint-Erratic Operation
08/20/2016
1644 hours

On 08/20/2016 at approximately 1644, the Middletown Police Department received a motor vehicle/erratic driving complaint in the area of Randolph Rd. and South Main St. It was reported that a white pickup truck that was towing a yellow trailer, was all over the road. A short time later this pickup was reported to be in the

area of Pleasant St.

At this time, I was in my marked police cruiser in the area of 10 Main St, facing in a southerly direction. As I made a right turn onto Pleasant St., I observed that said pickup truck was parked on the side of Pleasant St., fronting number 21 Pleasant St.

On 8/20/16 at approximately 1650, I conducted a motor Vehicle Stop on said pickup truck as it was parked in front of 21 Pleasant St. The registration number to said pickup truck was Connecticut Commercial registration number L11059. I explained to the operator, who was later identified as George Plaskowitz 3rd, that the Middletown Police Department had received a complaint of erratic driving and his vehicle matched the description given. I then asked him for his license and proof of registration and proof of insurance. **He then handed me his operators license, an expired registration card as of 4/25/16, and no insurance card.**

During my investigation, I was informed by dispatch that said pickup truck had an expired registration as of 4/25/16 and the trailer that it was towing, which had the Ct. Trailer maker plate of V95108, showed that there was no information found. I was then informed by dispatch that Plaskowitz's had a suspended operator license which was suspended indefinitely as of 4/8/16 for violation of C.G.S 14-111g. He was unable to provide me with any insurance card for said vehicle.

Plaskowitz was then issued misdemeanor summons number MC396891 for violation of C.G.S 14-215-Operating a Motor Vehicle While Under Suspension, 14-213(b)-Operating a Motor Vehicle with Insufficient Insurance, and 14-12(a)*-Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle. He then signed the summons in my presence stating that he would be at his assigned court date of 9/2/16, at GA 9, Middletown. Plaskowitz was also issued an infraction ticket for violation of C.G.S. 14-12(a)*- for Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle in regards to the unregistered trailer that he was towing.

This case is closed by an arrest.

REMARKS

On August 22, 2016, at approximately 1756 hours, I, Officer Bloom, was dispatched to 34 Liberty St. for a report of a female being struck in the face by another female.

When I arrived I spoke to the victim, who said she was driving up Liberty St. from Main St. when a black 4 door vehicle was stopped in the middle of the road. The victim said she drove around the vehicle and beeped her horn. Once the victim got home the other driver, a black female, allegedly starting cursing and hand gesturing at the victim. The victim said the suspect parked her car and walked down to the front of victims residence to confront the victim. At this time a verbal argument occurred until the suspect punched the victim to the victims right side of her face. I observed the right side of her cheek was showing signs of bruising and appeared to be swollen.

I spoke to a witness that lives in close proximity to the victim, who had an unobstructed view to the events as

they unfolded. The witness corroborated the victims recollection of events.

Through my investigation I was able to identify the suspect as Doris White-Privott (49) who immediately told me to arrest her because she, "didn't give a fuck." She said words were exchanged between her and victim but she never punched her. White-Privott did admit that she shoved the victim and could have touched her face in the process.

After speaking with both parties and an independent witness, I determined White-Privott would be getting a Misdemeanor Summons Complaint (MC 330297) for violating CGS 53a-181, Breach of Peace in the Second Degree and 53a-61, Assault in the Third Degree. She was released on scene and given a court date of September 13, 2016, 0900 hours at GA9.

It should be noted that White-Privott accused me of being racist and only arresting her because she was black. Privott proceeded to rip up her carbon copy of her Misdemeanor Summons Complaint (MC 330297) and pieces of the summons fell to the ground on her doorstep. While doing this White-Privott stated, "fuck that, I ain't goin' nowhere" in reference to purposely missing her court date.

REMARKS

On Saturday, 08/27/16 at 1353 hours, MARIA CRISTINA ALICEA was operating her 2015 Nissan CT AA86050 in a westerly direction on Washington Street. As she was approaching the three-way intersection of Washington Street and Old Mill Road, she was struck from behind by a 2005 Dodge CT AD26216.

During the course of the accident investigation, it was determined that MS. ALICEA did not have insurance coverage on her vehicle. She presented an expired insurance card from the Progressive Insurance Company but said that the policy was valid.


