He stated that his child's mother, Ms. McKnight, had awoken him yelling about something on Facebook. He stated that it was his birthday and one of his friends posted a happy birthday. A girl that he had cheated on Ms. McKnight with in the past, posted a "like" on the happy birthday comment.

An argument started between the two and it escalated. Ms. McKnight took a hammer out of Victim's toolbox and began assaulting his truck, smashing the front windshiled, drive's side window, and scratching

the entire driver's side of the truck. Victim had a small scratch on his forehead as well, but was unsure of how it had happened.


The two have been in a relationship for approximately 13 years and have a 9 year old daughter in common. No kids were present during the attack on the truck. They moved in together into this residence approximately 1 week ago with the intent to purchase it.

After this incident, Victim, at the behest of Ms. McKnight and his agreement, removed all of his belongings and will be residing back with his parents and will not be returning to the residence.

Ms. McKnight was released on the scene on an MSC for Criminal Mischief 3rd and Breach of Peace 2nd with a court date of 8-3-16 in GA 9.

### REMARKS

On Tuesday 08/02/2016 Middletown Narcotics Detectives were conducting surveillance in the area of Warwick St. and South Main. Detective Lathrop and I, Det. Peck, were aware that an individual, David Fountain, is the co-owner of a business in the area and that Fountain had an outstanding arrest warrant issued from Middletown Superior Court. At approximately 2025 hours, Detective Lathrop and I observed an individual we believed to be Fountain exit a parking lot in a 2000 Jeep Cherokee. I advised Lt. Davis, who was already in the area and he pulled out behind the Jeep as it stopped at the stop sign at the intersection of Warwick St. and High St. Det. Lathrop and I caught up with Lt. Davis on Bretton Rd. near High St. We followed the Jeep briefly and as the operator turned from Pine St. onto Lawn Ave. Lt. Davis activated his emergency lights and siren and initiating an investigative motor vehicle stop on the vehicle. Detective Lathrop also activated our vehicle emergency lights and positioned our vehicle on the left rear side of the Jeep. I immediately exited the passenger side of my vehicle and approached the driver side door of the stopped Jeep. As I made contact with the operator, I positively identified him as David Fountain, through numerous previous law enforcement interactions. Fountain was instructed to exit the vehicle and place his hands behind his back. He immediately complied. Upon being placed in handcuffs, Fountain was advised that he had an outstanding warrant issued from Middletown Superior Court.

As I was interacting with Fountain, I could smell the strong odor of burnt marijuana coming from both his person and the interior of the vehicle. Fountain was asked if there were any drugs on his person or inside the vehicle. He stated there was not. A search of both his person and vehicle returned negative results.

On his person Det. Lathrop located (2) flip cellular phones, (1) Apple iPhone, \$84.00 US currency. Based on his known narcotics history in conjunction with several active narcotic investigations, all items on his person and the 2000 Jeep Grand Cherokee were seized and tagged as evidence. The iPhone, currency and vehicle were tagged for asset forfeiture. It should be noted that Fountain has several pending cases, at Middletown Superior Court, for narcotics sales to an Undercover Police Officers.

Fountain was subsequently transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where he was read his rights and processed. Fountain was charged with violation of CGS 53a-32 – Violation of Conditional Discharge. He was held on a \$35,000.00 cash-only court set bond. David Fountain was issued an appearance date, at Middletown Superior Court, of 08/03/2016 at 0900 hours.

### REMARKS

On 8/2/16, at approximately 09:34 hours, I, Officer Foss-Rugan along with Officer Kraeger responded to # 78 Stack Street to investigate a reported threatening complaint. It was reported that the accused, James Young showed up at the victim's residence and violated a no contact restraining order. For the remainder of this report the victim will be referred to as Victim # 1.

Upon our arrival, we located Victim # 1 in the backyard of her residence. Victim # 1 was visibly distraught and told officers that she was very afraid of Young. Victim # 1 stated that the restraining order was granted by the court on 8/1/16 at approximately 5:00 PM. Victim # 1 stated on 8/1/16, at approximately 7:44 PM, she received a text message from Young which she showed me on her phone. The message stated the following, "Don't come to my store..everything is mine in it once you stole it...don't make me get ugly..I got the restraining order. Now leave me alone...the jeep is mine if you don't pay the bill fri. or u. can't take it now is mine now!"

Victim # 1 said on 8/2/16, at approximately 09:28 AM, Young showed up at her house. Victim # 1 stated when he arrived, she was in the backyard of her house. Victim # 1 saw Young walk around to the back of the house at which time he said, "Give me my key to my store...you really fucked up now! I'm going to get your sister fired from her job. I'm watching you and I know everyone in town. I know police officers, probation officers and bail


bondsmen...You are going down." Victim # 1 said that she was scared at that point and told Young to leave. Victim # 1 threw the store keys into the yard for him to get away from her. Victim # 1 took a picture of Young on her property to show the police.

Young was located at BU Clothing (175 East Main Street) which is the store he owns. At that time, he was taken into custody and transported to Middletown Police Department for processing.

I spoke with Young in the booking area and initially he denied every knowing about the restraining order. I told him that I had a text message sent from him that dictates otherwise, he acknowledged that he knew that there was a restraining order in place. Young stated that on 8/2/16, at approximately 09:00 AM, Victim # 1 showed up at his store (BU Clothing) and began removing her items from the store. Young said that Victim # 1 left a short time later and he admitted to going to her residence to get his store keys back from Victim # 1. Young replied that Victim # 1 got him real good.

Young was processed and charged with violating a Restraining Order (53a-223b). Young was bonded out by Charles Watson of Watson Bail Bonds. Watson posted a \$25,000.00 surety bond and Young was issued a court date of 8/3/16 at 09:00 hours at Middlesex Superior Court.

### REMARKS

I provided her the opportunity to have someone bring the vehicle insurance card to the scene as proof or look it up on her cell phone. \_\_\_\_\_ was unable to do either.





On 07/31/2016 at approximately 0016 I was dispatched to the area of South Main Street near Highland Avenue for a report of a motor vehicle crash. Upon approach I observed two vehicles on the west side of South Main Street, south of the intersection of Highland Avenue. A Nissan XTerra was partially on the west curb and a Jeep Wrangler had been forced up an embankment over the west curb. Both vehicles had significant damage. All occupants were out of the vehicles and a passenger of the Jeep was crying and complaining of head pain. The above accused was the operator of the Nissan XTerra bearing CT registration 8AJAL0. The vehicle had damage on the front. Upon speaking to Buonanno I asked him what had happened in the crash. As he was explaining what happened I noticed that his eyes were red, glossy and swollen and that his speech was slurred. I asked Buonanno where he was coming from and he said that he had been at La Boca Restaurant. I then asked him how much he had to drink and he answered "two beers". Hunter's Ambulance and South District Fire Department had arrived on scene and began treating Buonanno. Buonanno was cleared by Hunter's ambulance and signed a medical refusal. I asked Buonanno to perform the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and escorted him to a flat surface on the east side of the road where the testing was conducted.

Buonanno failed the tests and was charged with Driving under the Influence in violation of Connecticut General Statute 14-227a, Failure to Drive in Proper Lane in violation of Connecticut General Statute 14-236 and Failure to Carry an Insurance Card or Registration in violation of Connecticut General Statute 14-13(a).

Buonanno was released at approx. 0330 hrs on a \$500.00 non-surety bond.




### REMARKS
