On August 07, 2016 at approximately 0347 hours I was dispatched to 271 Woodbury Circle for what sounded like a Physical Domestic in progress.


Upon arrival, the door to the apartment had been kicked in and the victim had several facial injuries including cuts on her forehead, eye, and mouth.


The suspect, Edward Tucker, had fled the scene and was ultimately found hiding in the woods utilizing a K9 track. It was determined through my investigation that Tucker had kicked in the door at the victim's residence after already striking her in the face earlier in the night. Tucker proceeded to attack the victim again before fleeing the scene.

Tucker was transported to Middletown Police headquarters where he was read his rights, fingerprinted, and processed. Tucker was charged with Burglary 3rd Degree (53a-102), Risk of Injury to a Minor (53-21), Assault 3rd Degree (53a-61), Criminal Mischief 3rd Degree (53a-117) and Interfering with an Officer (53a-167a).

Tucker was held on a \$150,000 surety bond pending his appearance in court at GA9 on Monday August 08, 2016 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 8/5/2016 at approximately 0825 hours I was dispatched to the Connecticut Department of Probation office on Main Street in Middletown. Dispatch advised that a client, Tarik Shabazz-Alliah (identified by his probation officer, fingerprints and Connecticut identification card) was in there office and that he had an extraditable arrest warrant from the Rockbridge County and City of Lexington Sheriff's Office in Virginia for drug sales. The warrant and extradition were confirmed through dispatch.

Upon my arrival I placed Shabazz-Alliah in custody. He was transported to the Middletown Police Department where he was fingerprinted, photographed and processed. He waived his Miranda rights in writing, but did not make any relevant statements.

I contacted the Sheriff's office and spoke with Mary Beth Moran (phone 540-463-7329). She confirmed that the warrant was extraditable by the authority of Commonwealth Attorney Chris Billias (phone 540-463-7337 fax 540-463-6628). I confirmed that the original charges were two counts of Sell/Provide Resale of a Schedule I/II controlled substance VA code 18.2-248(c) and two counts of Drug Sale on/near School VA code 18.2-255.2. These offenses are punishable by more than one year in jail.

Shabazz-Alliah was held as a fugitive from justice under CGS 54-169 on a \$150,000 surety bond. He is

scheduled to appear at GA9 in Middletown on 8/8/2016 at 0900 hours.



REMARKS

This incident is a domestic violence assault between a female and Michael Ciccarello. The female is the VICTIM and Mr. Ciccarello is the SUSPECT in this incident. Herinafter, the female will be referred to as Victim 1.

On 08/07/2016 at approximately 0100 hours I responded to the Middlesex Hospital Emergency Department for a report of a past domestic assault. Upon my arrival I spoke to a nurse who informed me that she had just spoken to a patient who reported to her that she had been assaulted by her boyfriend and was awaiting treatment.

I entered the hospital room and spoke to the victim of the alleged assault who explained that she has had a very tumultuous relationship with her boyfriend Michael. Victim 1 stated that she really did not want to report anything because she was afraid of Michael. She said that she should have had him arrested months ago but never did. Victim 1 initially said that she did not know Michael's last name however Officer Magnano remembered from the previous night that Victim 1 had reported that her boyfriend was suicidal. Officer Magnano recalled that her boyfriend's name was Michael Ciccarello and Victim 1 confirmed.

Victim 1 stated that after she located Ciccarello last night, the two of them went to a friend's apartment for

the night. Victim 1 said that they stayed in the apartment all day and afternoon. Victim 1 further stated that during the day, Ciccarello convinced her to give him \$300 so that he could purchase drugs. Then later at approximately 11pm, Victim 1 told Ciccarello that she wanted to go home. Ciccarello began to get argumentative with her because he wanted her to go to the bar with him and drink but Victim 1 said that she wanted to go home. Victim 1 said that she told Ciccarello that she would bring him to the bar and they began to drive. Victim 1 went on to say that they continued to argue on the car ride because Victim 1 kept telling him that she wanted to go home and she did not want to go out drinking which angered Ciccarello. Victim 1 stated that during the ride to Matty's Pub in Middletown, Ciccarello punched her in the side of the head at least three times with a closed fist. Victim 1 said that she knew he wouldn't stop until she gave in so she told him that she would go with him but when they arrived, Victim 1 waited for Ciccarello to exit the vehicle and then she drove away and went to the hospital. Victim 1 believed that Ciccarello would stay at the bar and drink but was unsure where he would go after closing. Victim 1 did not want to provide a written statement.

The nurse that was treating Victim 1 said that she did notice some redness on the right side of her head, behind her ear but nothing serious enough to cause swelling.

I contacted Headquarters from the hospital and apprised Captain Wallace of the situation. Captain Wallace sent Sergeant Yepes and other patrol units to Matty's Pub to attempt to locate Ciccarello. During their canvass, Sergeant Yepes located Ciccarello walking on South Main Street near the pub. When I arrived on scene I spoke to Ciccarello who denied any type of altercation between him and Victim 1. Ciccarello's version of the story was very similar to Victim 1 reported except that Ciccarello denied punching Victim 1. Ciccarello said to me that he was a pretty big guy and that if he punched her then she would have a mark and since she did not have any marks that was proof that he did not touch her. Ciccarello further defended himself by saying that he and Victim 1 are both crack cocaine users and when Victim 1 gets high on crack she has a history of making up stories.

Ciccarello was placed under arrest and transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where he was charged with Assault 3rd, held on a \$500.00 surety bond and given the next available court date of 08/08/2016.


According to State Police Records, Ciccarello is a convicted felon with past convictions for the following charges: Assault 2nd(x2), Larceny 3rd (x2), Larceny 4th, Larceny 5th (x2), Larceny 6th, Tampering with a Witness, Unlawful Restraint, Hindering Prosecution, Interfering with Police, Credit card Fraud, Breach of Peace (x2), Criminal Mischief (x2), Possession of Marijuana (x2), Failure to Appear and Probation Violation (x4). Additionally, according to the Interstate Identification Index, Ciccarello has convictions for Driving While Intoxicated in New York, and Possession of Marijuana, Public Drunkenness, Burglary, and Probation Violation out of Mississippi.

REMARKS

On August 07, 2016 at approximately 1417 hours, Officer Terribile and I (Officer Stroud) were dispatched to the incident location for a reported domestic.

Upon arrival I was met by Cohabitant 1, Cohabitant 2, who was the initial caller, and the Victim. All three of those parties resided at that location.

Cohabitant 1 stated the Accused had recently moved out, and returned to that location to gather the rest of his belongings. Cohabitant 1 said the Accused initiated an argument with her and the above individuals. Upon inspecting the interior of the residence, she saw the kitchen trash and been thrown around the kitchen, and Hershey's chocolate syrup had been splattered against the front of her bedroom door.

The Victim corroborated Cohabitant 1's version of the events, saying the kitchen and Cohabitant 1's bedroom door did not have that mess prior to the Accused's arrival.

The Accused stated he had returned to gather his belongings at the incident location, and got into a verbal argument with Cohabitant 1, Cohabitant 2, and the Victim. The Accused denied squirting the chocolate syrup, but admitted to throwing the trash in the kitchen.

The trash and chocolate syrup did not cause any property damage, but Cohabitant 1 and the Victim stated it would require effort to clean.

Due to the result of my investigation, the Accused was placed under arrest for the following violation of the Connecticut General Statutes:

53a-182, DISORDERLY CONDUCT

REMARKS

On 8/5/16 at approximately 1636 hours I responded to a walk in complainant of a domestic dispute.

Upon arrival at headquarters I spoke with victim 1 (hereinafter referred to as V1). V1 explained that Joseph Nagy, suffers from autism but is functioning however she is his caretaker. She stated he also suffers from depression and PTSD. Nagy resides with V1 at her residence along with his 7 year old brother.

V1 stated that for the past month Nagy has been refusing to take any and all medication related to his psychological issues. She stated during that time he had become increasingly violent and threatening towards her and that he consciously takes these actions. Nagy has been intimidating by blocking doorways, hovering over his mother, and also saying things to her such as telling her to kill herself. V1 stated that Nagy's behavior towards her has made her scared and has become so bad that today she told him she would be moving to New York and not taking him if he did not start taking his medication again. V1

stated that this upset Nagy and his behavior escalated during the day to the point that she advised him she could not care for him and was going to call his biological father to come take him.

V1 stated that she took her 7 year old son and her mother into her bedroom. V1 was utilizing mother's cell phone to call her uncle to discuss the situation and also get Nagy's father's phone number from him which she did not have. At this time V1 stated Nagy barged into the room, slamming the door. Nagy is approximately 6'2" and weighs 240 pounds. He came to the bed where V1 was laying and laid on top of her pinning her down. V1 stated she was yelling for Nagy to stop and let her up. Nagy pinned her arms down and pried the cell phone away from her finger by finger. V1 stated she told Nagy she was going to call the police. This further upset him due to the fact that Nagy does not like the police due to past experiences with police.

V1 stated that once Nagy pried the phone away from her he got up and stood in the doorway blocking the phone. He then stated "If you keep pushing people they can do some scary things to you." V1 stated that she took the statement as a threat and was extremely fearful. She believed that Nagy would follow through and harm her and her family because he was off his medication. V1 stated that Nagy then left the doorway. She grabbed her other son and fled from the room out of the house. V1 stated that her mother was slightly behind her and had been attempting to calm Nagy down. A short time later her mother also came outside and advised V1 that Nagy had stated he was getting a knife and would be waiting on the couch for police to arrive and that when they did he was going to stab the first officer that came through the door and force the others to kill him. V1 then went to police department to report the incident and left Nagy at the residence.

V1 provided a sworn written statement in regards to the incident. It should be noted that while I was speaking with her V1 appeared very upset and flustered and did not have any shoes on as a result of running out of the residence away from Nagy.

I also spoke with mother of V1 who confirmed V1's version of events that took place in the bedroom and also provided a sworn statement.

Hunter's Ambulance responded to the scene and transported Nagy to Middlesex Hospital for a police emergency examination request. V1 also responded to the hospital to assist staff in providing information regarding Nagy and his conditions. A note was located in Nagy's possession which he admitted to writing. The note alluded to suicidal and details previous incidents which resulted in his PTSD and mental conditions. This note was provided to hospital crisis staff along with PEER paperwork.


Nagy was issued a misdemeanor summons for disorderly conduct (53a-181) and threatening 2 (53a-62) in violation of the CT General Statutes. He was issued a court date of 8/8/16 due to the domestic nature of the incident. Nagy was also issued a conditions of release form. V1 and hospital crisis staff were to work together to find Nagy housing and proper care.



Upon the arrival of OFC. Buller and Lt. Desena the male was identified through in house records as Timothy Rau, of 32 Evergreen Ave. Middletown. The two females were identified as _____ and her daughter _____ Both reside at the above address. I _____ explained to me briefly that Rau is an associate of her husband and had showed up uninvited asking for a ride. _____ stated that when she would not let Rau in he began screaming obscenities at her and her daughter. _____ stated that she told Rau

numerous times to leave and he wouldn't.

I attempted to conduct a pat down of Rau's person. Rau was still agitated and was yelling at the two females and the officers on scene. I placed his hands behind his back and asked if he had any weapons. Rau stated "yeah right here" and pulled his right hand away from me and attempted to grab something from his pocket. Lt. Desena and I forcefully removed Rau's hands and placed him in handcuffs. Lt. Desena then removed a Snap on folding pocket knife from the area Rau was attempting to grab. Rau was secured in the rear of my vehicle.

OFC. Buller obtained a written statement from () that on this date at approximately 1125am she was in her kitchen at the above address. () stated that she heard a loud banging at the back door. () stated that when she answered a guy she knows as Tim asked if her father was home. () stated that she told him no and the male asked for a glass of water. () stated that she went to get the water and Tim stated "you're going to leave me out here" () stated that she said yes and Tim started screaming obscenities. () stated that her mom went out and told Tim to leave. () stated that Tim began grabbing his crotch stating "come get some of this." () stated that she had the cup of water in her hand and threw the water at Tim to get him to leave. () stated that Tim ran over and grabbed her by the shoulders and shook her yelling "call the cops you assaulted me with water." () stated that Tim continued to yell and scream obscenities at them. () stated that her mom then flagged down a police car. () stated that she wished to press charges for this incident.

While dealing with Rau he remained agitated and was yelling and speaking very rapidly. Lt. Desena advised me that Rau had a long narcotics history. It appeared based on Rau's behavior that he was currently under the influence of narcotics. Rau was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing.

During transport Rau calmed down and stated that he went to 77 Evergreen Ave. to see his friend () and ask for a ride. Rau stated that when he was told () wasn't home he asked to come in for a drink of water. Rau stated that he asked () daughter "you're just going to leave me out here" and she stated "yes." Rau stated she was "being a bitch" and began yelling at him. Rau stated that () wife told him to leave and he was in the process of leaving when () s daughter threw water on him. Rau stated he didn't think he did anything wrong.

Rau was processed and charged with Breach of Peace 2nd Degree, 53a-182. Rau was released on a \$2,500.00 non-surety bond with a court date of 08/16/16.
