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On 02/7/2016 at about 0055 hours I was traveling North on Berlin Street, approaching the intersection with Liberty Street, in my police cruiser. I observed a white colored pick-up truck stopped at the Westbound stop sign of the intersection. After stopping for the stop sign, the vehicle continued through the intersection. I turned West, onto Liberty Street and followed the vehicle to the next intersection, Newfield Street. I noticed the vehicle accelerated very quickly, up to this intersection. I followed the vehicle North onto Newfield Street. The pick-up truck again accelerated quickly, pulling away from my police cruiser. As an oncoming vehicle passed the pick-up truck, the pick-up began to encroach the double yellow line. After the left side tires crossed the double yellow line, the pick-up returned to its lane, in a quick, snapping, jerking motion. In my police vehicle, I was now pacing the pick-up truck, neither gaining nor losing any noticeable ground. I looked at the speedometer of my police cruiser, which read 70mph. The posted speed limit in this area is 35mph. When I looked back up, the pick-up continued to accelerate, and I attempted to catch up to it, to conduct a motor vehicle stop.

In the area of 106 Newfield Street, the road bends to the right. The pick-up again crossed the double yellow line. Again, it sharply jerked back to the right, returning to the Northbound travel lane. It was at this point, I activated by police cruiser's overhead emergency lights, to conduct a motor vehicle stop.

I made contact with the operator from the passenger side of the vehicle and asked for his license, vehicle registration and insurance. The operator opened the vehicle's glove box, touched a few papers, then closed it. He then touched the outside of his jacket pockets, as to appear his license may have been in one of them. He then stopped, looked at me, bewilderedly. Standing next to the vehicle, I could detect the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the vehicle. I asked Ornek how much he had to drink tonight. He responded, "One or two." I again asked him two more times for his driver's license, vehicle registration and insurance. He again fumbled through some paperwork and stopped, looking confused. I asked Ornek to shut off the vehicle. I went around the vehicle, to the driver's side door. The operator stated he couldn't find his license, because it was with his phone. I asked the operator if he meant the cell phone sitting in plain sight, next to him in the passenger seat. The operator then retrieved and provided his CT Driver's License (CT 197276621) and was identified as Jason Ornek ).

I again asked Ornek how much he had to drink tonight. He responded, "Two or three." I asked Ornek if he would submit to testing, to see if he was ok to drive. Ornek nodded. I asked Ornek if his knew the English alphabet. He stated he did.

I requested Ornek say the alphabet, starting at "D" and ending at "S". Ornek started, "D,(pause) H, I, J, K, L,

M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, V", then, without prompted, "L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S."

I then requested Ornek complete a dexterity test. Using my right hand, I instructed Ornek to use his thumb and make contact with each of his fingers, while counting, (Index finger "1", Middle finger "2", Ring finger "3" Pinky finger "4"), then to count in reverse, while touching each finger with thumb. During the demonstration and instructions, Ornek continued to look away from my hand and looked at me. When asked, Ornek stated he understood the instructions. When advised to begin, Ornek raised his right hand slightly, touched his thumb to his index finger and counted "1, 2, 3, 4", without touching his thumb to each finger. When Ornek stopped for approximately five seconds, I asked if he was done. He nodded.

I asked Ornek to exit the vehicle and to stand at the rear of his vehicle. While walking to the rear of the vehicle, Ornek started to stumble, losing his balance. He raised up his arms to keep his balance, and continued to walk in a zig-zag, to the rear of his vehicle.

At the rear of the vehicle, I noticed Ornek's eyes were glossy and bloodshot. At this time I requested Ornek submit to Field Sobriety Tests, which he acknowledged.

The Standardized Field Sobriety Test was completed unsatisfactorily by Ornek.

Ornek was placed under arrest, handcuffed, searched and transported to Headquarters for chemical alcohol testing and arrest processing.

Ornek's vehicle was towed from the scene by Untouchable Towing.

Ornek was read his Miranda Rights and the DMV Implied Consent Advisory. Ornek was offered an opportunity to contact an attorney at 0146 hours and he declined. I advised Ornek that I would be selecting the breath test and he agreed to submit to the test.

#### Chemical Alcohol Test-Breath Test

Ornek's first test was administered at 0217 hours and registered a blood alcohol content of .1843. Ornek's second test was administered at 0237 hours and registered a .1923.

Ornek's picture was taken as part of the arrest process He was charged with Operating under the Influence, 14-227a; Traveling Too Fast for Conditions, 14-218a\*; Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle, 14-12(a)\*; Failure to Maintain Lane, 14-236. Ornek was given a court date of February 22, 2016 at 0900 hours and released on a five hundred dollar non-surety bond. Ornek was picked up by his girlfriend, Chelsea Brennan. Ornek was provided with all his paperwork upon his release. Ornek driver's license was turned over for the 24-hour revocation period.

## REMARKS

On 09 February 2016 at 0510 hours, I, a Middletown Police Officer was dispatched to an address in Middletown for a reported Assault w/ Injuries. Central Dispatch advised me that the complainant; Victim #1 was struck by Robert Richards and was injured.

Upon arrival to the address, Witness #1 opened the door. I asked him where Robert Richards (22 YO) was and he stated upstairs in his bedroom. I then went upstairs and made contact with Richards whom I recognize from previous instances at this address. Richards was advised of the reason for our presence and was placed in handcuffs. He was also advised that he was being detained for the time being until we investigate further.

As I walked into the kitchen where Victim #1 was sitting on her bed, I immediately observed visible physical injury to her face and right arm. There was blood in the area of her nose, on her nasal cannula that is

connected to an oxygen tank, on her chin, and on a sheet that she was using to wipe the blood off of her face. She also had a laceration on her right forearm. Victim #1 then explained Richards came to her bedside as she was sleeping and asked to use her phone. Once she told him no, he became angry, struck her, and then threw milk at her. I observed a wet area on her bed along with a white liquid substance on her bed frame which I presume to of been milk. She gave the following signed, sworn written statement detailing this incident.

Victim #1 is a 63 year old female.

Witness #1 stated that he was in the living room at the time of this incident and he heard arguing between the Richards and Victim #1 but he did not observe anything.

Richards was transported to Police Headquarters where he was processed. Richards was consequently charged with CGS: 53a-182; Disorderly Conduct & CGS: 53a-61(a); Assault of an Elderly Person 3rd Degree. He is being held on a \$5,000.00 surety bond. Richards was placed into Male Cell #3 pending his arraignment at GA:9 on February 9, 2016 at 0900 hours. Nothing further.



Bryant stated that she recently purchased the vehicle and used her friends plates to operate the vehicle for the time being. Bryant was unable to produce any valid form of a insurance policy. A check with dispatch revealed that Bryant's operator license had expired on 10/12/2015 as well. The plates were removed from the vehicle and it was towed from the scene by Personal Automotive.

Bryant was issued a Misdemeanor Summons, MC378610, for violation of C.G.S. 14-147c Misuse of Marker Plates, violation of C.G.S. 14-12(a)\* Operating a Unregistered Motor Vehicle, violation on C.G.S 14-213b Failure to Maintain Minimum Insurance and violation of C.G.S. 14-36(a) Operating a Motor Vehicle without a License. Bryant is scheduled to appear at Middlesex Superior Court on February 22, 2016 at 0900 hours.


