### REMARKS

On Wednesday 02/17/2016 at approximately 1745 hours, Narcotics detectives were conducting surveillance in the area of Liberty St. and Pearl St. Sgt. Yepes observed a male, who he positively identified as Rodney Wiggins from previous

narcotics investigations and arrests, exiting Aresco's Market with an unknown individual. Sgt. Yepes watched as the two men walked in a W/B direction towards Pearl St. where they turned and walked N/B on Pearl towards Grand St. At the intersection, both men turned onto Grand St. and began walking E/B. In the area of 61 Grand St. both men stepped into the driveway, together, where an exchange of money and suspected narcotics was made. Immediately after the exchange Wiggins left the area, walking E/B on Grand St. while the unidentified individual entered a nearby residence. Sgt. Yepes advised Detectives of the observations and stated they were consistent with a narcotics transaction. He maintained visual contact with Wiggins as he continued E/B towards Main St.

As Wiggins turned onto Main St. I, Det. Peck, made contact with him, identified myself as a Police Officer and detained him. As I was placing Wiggins' hands behind his back, he began dropping items on the ground. I observed a folded napkin in Wiggins' hands, which he immediately began crushing. I placed my hands over Wiggins' hands, to avoid losing any evidence and ordered him to release the item. Wiggins hesitated before letting it go. Once he was secured in handcuffs, I determined the napkin held (3) pieces of an off-white soap-like substance which I recognized to be suspected crack cocaine. Wiggins stated, "You got me this time." When asked where he had purchased the narcotics, Wiggins responded, "From a guy on Grand St."

Wiggins was advised that he was under arrest. I began collecting the items Wiggins had dropped on the ground. I located (3) wax bags which contained and light brown granular substance which I recognized to be suspected heroin. Wiggins would later state that it was for "my girl that has a habit." Wiggins was subsequently transported to Middletown Police Headquarters to be processed.

Upon arrival at the booking area, Wiggins was found to be in possession of a total of \$41.11 US currency. In his right front pants pocket, Det. Stead located (2) yellow tablets. These pills were confirmed to be;

(1) Exalgo 16 (hydromorphone 16 mg)-a schedule 2 narcotic with a high potential for abuse.

(1) Clonazepam .5 mg-a schedule 4 controlled substance, classified as a Benzodiazepine with potential for abuse.

In Wiggins' wallet, Det. Stead found (3) Suboxone sublingual strips 8mg/2mg-a schedule 3 narcotic with moderate potential for abuse.

A check of the State of Connecticut prescription monitoring program (CTPMP) would show that Rodney Wiggins has not been prescribed any of these medications.

The suspected crack cocaine was weighed for a total amount of .4 grams and tested positive for the presence of cocaine.

The suspected heroin tested positive for the presence of heroin. All items were tagged as evidence and secured in an evidence locker at Middletown Police HQ.

Wiggins is a convicted felon with previous convictions for; Possession of Drugs/Marijuana, Possession of Narcotics (multiple convictions), Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Criminal Trespass 1, Assault of Personnel (multiple convictions), Probation Violation (multiple convictions), Violation of Protective Order, Possession of Controlled Substance, Larceny 4.

Rodney Wiggins was read his rights and processed. He was charged with violations of;





room. Off of the living room were two closed doors. I went to the door to the right and knocked on it and announced my presence and requested that anyone inside come out. No one responded. I opened the door and discovered that there was no one in the room. I also observed hundreds of wax paper folds, that I know, through my training and experience as a police officer, are commonly used to store heroine. I also observed multiple capped and un-capped syringes all over the room. I did not enter the room further, as there was no one inside, and I needed to locate the male.

I then went to the second bedroom and located the male and the juvenile. I confronted both adults and asked them who was using heroine. Nicole admitted to using heroine and said that the empty bags and syringes inside the bedroom were hers. I then entered the bedroom again, to collect the syringes, and discovered 50 wax folds that contained a powdery substance suspected to be heroine. The substance later tested positive as heroine using NARK test kit 3.

The heroine and syringes were easily within reach of the child, if they had entered the room. The juvenile had the ability to walk and open doors. The door to the bedroom had been unlocked.

Nicole Ford was also found to have an arrest warrant from Newington Police Department. Ford was arrested and charged with Possession of Narcotics and Risk of Injury to a Minor. She was assigned a court date of 2-26-16 and a \$5000 non-surety bond.

She was turned over to Newington Police Department. to be processed for the warrant.

A report of the findings was made directly to a DCF case worker.

## REMARKS

On 2/10/2016, at approximately 0130 hours I, Officer Foster, was patrolling the parking lot of Wesley Inn Suites. I came upon a Mercedes G-Class, bearing CT registration 8AFKD7, parked in the front of the building. A check with dispatch revealed that the plate was coming back stolen. In addition, dispatch also informed me that the plate belonged on a red Chev. 1500. I was able to verify that the vehicle was not stolen by checking the VIN number with dispatch. After speaking to the clerk at the front desk, I was informed that the vehicle in question belonged to a John Mierzejewski who was staying in room #23. With the assistance of Officer Austin Smith, we made contact with Mierzejewski.

Mierzejewski stated that he used the vehicle to drive to work despite the fact that he has a suspended drivers license. Mierzejewski openly admitted that he stole the plate from a vehicle located on Plaza Drive, a short distance away. Mierzejewski apologized and stated that he wasn't in his right mind when he did it.

Mierzejewski was issued a Misdemeanor Summons, MC380448, for violation of C.G.S. 14-147a Theft of Marker Plates and violation of C.G.S. 14-147c Misuse of Marker Plates. Mierzejewski is scheduled to appear at Middlesex Superior Court on February 24, 2016 at 0900 hours. The stolen plate was cancelled from the system and returned to the department DMV box. Attempts to contact the owner of the plate were made but unsuccessful.
