REMARKS

On July 25, 2016 at approximately 2345 hours, Officer Jeffries, Officer Murphy, and I (Officer Stroud) were dispatched to (the Accused's residence) for a reported domestic.

Upon arrival at that location we were met by the Accused, who resided at that location, and the Victim.

Both the Victim and the Accused stated they had been in a verbal argument regarding their relationship, and that their argument had never been physical.

The Victim stated she had been invited to that location by the Accused, and showed me text messages she had received from him inviting her there. The Accused admitted to allowing the Victim entry into his residence.

Dispatch performed an inquiry of the Accused's CT Operators License. Dispatch confirmed there was a protective order in place with the Victim as the protected party, and the Accused as the respondent. That protective order had the following conditions:

CT 01 - Do not assault, threaten, abuse, harass, follow, interfere with, or stalk the protected person.

CT 03 - Stay away from the home of the protected person and wherever the protected person shall reside.

CT 05 - Do not contact the protected person in any manner, including by written, electronic or telephone, and do not contact the protected person's home, workplace or others with whom the contact would be likely to cause annoyance or alarm to the protected person.

CT 14 - Respondent may return to the protected person's home one time with police to retrieve belongings.

CT 15 - Protected party information is confidential.

Due to the Accused being in violation of CT 05 of the above conditions, he was placed under arrest for the following violation of the Connecticut General Statutes:

53a-223, CRIMINAL VIOLATION OF A PROTECTIVE ORDER

The Accused was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters in my marked patrol cruiser, where he was processed under UAR # 8873277. The Accused was held in lieu of a \$10,000 surety bond, and is scheduled to appear at G.A. 09 on July 26, 2016 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 7/26/16 at approximately 0032 hours while on patrol, I was driving southbound on Main Street. I observed a black male on a bicycle at the corner of Main Street and Rapallo Avenue. I immediately recognized the bicycle to be a stolen bicycle which was discussed in Middletown Police roll call. A picture of the bicycle was shown to Officers during roll call.

The bicycle was a matte black CG model Virus, with a white front fork, white handle bars and red grips. The bicycle was valued at \$175

D'Shaun Watson was in possession of the stolen bicycle. While attempting to detain Watson he pulled away and got into a fighting stance. While attempting to handcuff Watson he continued to pull away. Once in custody a total of 6 bags of black powder, which would later test positive for PCP were found in Watson's pockets.

NOTE: The corner of Main Street and Rapallo Avenue is within 1500 feet of both Macdonough School and the Green Street Art Center.



He was given a court date of 7/26/16 at GA09 in Middletown and held on a \$25,000 surety bond.

REMARKS

On 7/19/16 at approximately 1809 hours, I was dispatched to 28 Crescent Street for a report of an assault. Ofc. Wasilewski assisted as a back-up to this call.

Upon arrival, I was informed by _____ that he was assaulted by a patient. The patient was identified as Thomas Musa _____ stated that Musa had already been discharged from the hospital. Musa approached _____ with a bag full of medications and struck _____ in the face.

_____ informed me that he was able to lean back a little as the bag was approaching his face. He then in self-defense, struck Musa in the abdomen and with both arms grabbed Musa in an attempt gain control of him. _____ then assisted Musa with both arms to the floor where he was able to gain control.

When speaking with Musa, he was unaware of what happened. Musa did not recall hitting anyone at the hospital.

I was able to review video footage of the incident. During that time, I observed Musa walking down the hall with a bag. Musa walked by three other staff members without incident. As he approached _____, whom _____ was standing at a counter doing paperwork, he lifted his right hand with the bag and struck _____ in the

face. In the footage, I did observe : leaning back, in an attempt to avoid being struck, however the bag did hit his face. I then observed striking Musa in the abdomen and with both arms assisting Musa to the floor to gain control of him.

Musa was identified through Hospital records. He was also positively identified as Thomas Musa by staff. I was informed by and other staff members that Musa is a regular at the hospital. I was also informed that Musa has a history of being vulgar and combative when being treated at the Hospital.

~~I did not observe any injuries to face. did not claim any injury as a result of the incident.~~

Musa was given a Misdemeanour Summons (MC 330265) for the charge of C.G.S 53a-181 Breach of Peace In The Second Degree. Musa is to appear in Middletown Court GA #9 on 8/2/16 at 0900 hours.
