REMARKS

On 3/12/16 at approximately 1642hrs I (Officer Wasilewski) was traveling southbound on Saybrook Road in a marked Police Cruiser. As I continued southbound past the intersection of Tryon Street I observed a gray Ford sedan, bearing CT registration AB39809, traveling northbound at a high rate of speed. I estimated the

vehicle was traveling in excess of 75 miles per hour, over double the speed limit. As the vehicle passed by me I made an immediate U-turn to catch up to the vehicle. As I made the U-Turn the vehicle continued northbound out of my line of sight.

I later found the vehicle stopped in the road on Baer Street. Prior to making a motor vehicle stop I observed the vehicle from the Webster Bank parking lot across the street. I observed a tall black male walk up to the passenger side front window, stick his hand just inside the window, and remove it seconds later. Through my training and experience I believed I had just witnessed a possible hand to hand drug transaction. The male who approached the vehicle did not open his mouth and say anything as someone might do who was walking up to say Hi. The black male then walked away.

After conducting a motor vehicle stop I spoke with the operator (Geremia Basadonna) who initially denied traveling fast or being on Baer Street. Soon after, Basadonna admitted that he had driven the front passenger () to Baer Street to make the purchase because did not have a car. Basadonna stated he did not purchase the drugs himself and put no money forward to pay for them. Officer Remotti and later found two narcotic pills in possession. stated he placed them in his sock to hide them but removed them when asked about the hand to hand transaction on Baer Street. The pills were researched on scene and found to be Acetaminophen Oxycodone Hydrochloride 325mg/10mg and Vicodin 300mg/5mg. Both are listed as a Narcotic Analgesic schedule II Controlled Substance. Copies of the documentation are submitted with the case documents. Both pills were later seized and tagged in Middletown Police Evidence locker #9.

Once back at the Middletown Police Department I read both Basadonna his rights which he waived. I then photographed, fingerprinted, and processed him. Basadonna gave a voluntary sworn written statement regarding his involvement.


Basadonna's stated he was traveling at a high rate of speed on Saybrook Road but never noticed the Officer when it circled around to pull him over. He also stated that was the one who arranged for to buy the two pills. He was aware that he was driving Baer Street to purchase the pills but did not provide any money for the purchase.

Basadonna was charged with violation of CGS 14-222 Reckless Driving, and 53a-48/21a-279(a) Conspiracy to Possess a Controlled Substance/Narcotic. He was given a court date of 3/30/16 at 0900hrs and told he would have to appear at the GA 9 court house on that date and time. He stated he understood. He was then released on a \$2500 non-surety bond.

REMARKS

On 03/20/16 at approximately 0958 I was dispatched along with other officers to 139 Church St. on the fourth floor for a disturbance. The caller reported that two males were at the apartment causing a problem and he believed one of them had a gun.

Upon arrival we located the complainant, [redacted], in the hallway. [redacted] was bleeding from a laceration on his hand [redacted] stated the two males had left on foot on Church St. [redacted] provided a description of the males to include one was wearing a camouflage jacket. [redacted] stated that the male in the camouflage may have a gun or a knife. See Case # 16-06620 for additional details of the disturbance.

I exited the apartment building and observed two males walking east on Church St. One of the males was wearing a camouflage jacket. I contacted Sgt. Fuchs via radio to stop the males.

The two suspects were stopped on Church St. at Hubbard St. I approached the male wearing the camouflage jacket and told him not to move. I conducted a pat down search of the male who was later identified as Davis, Mark A. [redacted]. While conducting the pat down I located a red razor knife in Davis' jacket pocket. As I was removing the knife a bundle of wax paper folds wrapped in a black rubber band fell to the ground. Sgt. Fuchs retrieved the folds which were immediately recognized as suspected

heroin. Each of the eight folds contained a small amount of white powdery substance.

Davis was placed in handcuffs and secured in my vehicle. When asked about the suspected heroin Davis stated that they were not his and he was holding them for his friend. Davis was transported to Middletown Police Headquarters for processing.

I subjected a small amount of the white powdery substance from one of the folds to a NARK #2 Marquis reagent test kit. Positive results for an opium alkaloid were obtained. The items were secured in the Middletown Police Department evidence locker (#11).

Davis was processed and charged with one count of Possession of Narcotics, 21a-279a. Davis was assigned a court date of 03/30/16 at Middletown Superior Court and was released on a \$10,000 non-surety bond.

REMARKS

On 03/19/2016 at approximately 1742 hours, Officer Ward and I were dispatched to 749 Saybrook Road, Tradewinds Plaza, to investigate a narcotics complaint. It was reported that a Hunters Ambulance crew was parked in the Tradewinds Plaza parking lot next to a vehicle that had two people inside of it actively using cocaine. The vehicle was described as a maroon four door vehicle.

When I arrived, I observed the Hunters Ambulance and two parking spots to its right, a maroon Nissan Maxima bearing a North Carolina registration # BJS8613. I observed that there was a sole occupant, who was later identified as Adolph Cherry, in the passenger side of this vehicle. Officer Ward who assisted me, asked Cherry to step out of the vehicle and when he did he had a cut straw clenched in his right hand. When Officer Ward took the cut straw out of Cherry's hand, and I was able to notice that a white powdery substance started to fall from the straw. This white powdery substance was also still inside of the straw. Officer Ward also noticed that Cherry had two white prescription pills in his lap and approximately 8 more


pills scattered about the floor and the seat that Cherry was sitting in. I later found 5 more of the white pills under the seat that Cherry was sitting in.

I observed that the white prescription pills were and oval shape and they had the markings A332 on one side and no marking on the other side. I later researched these pills and discovered that these pills were Acetaminophen and Oxycodone Hydrochloride 325mg/7.5 mg, which is a Schedule 2 controlled substance. It is also a Narcotic Analgesic.

Cherry later admitted in a sworn written statement that he bought two of the above mentioned white pills from the driver of the maroon Maxima because he ran out of his own pain medication.

Cherry was the placed into custody for violation of C.G.S 21a-279(a)-Illegal Possession of Narcotics and 21a-267-Possesion of Drug Paraphernalia. He was then transported to police headquarters for processing. He was booked and processed under UAR 8872782 and issued a court date of 3/21/16 at GA, 9 Middletown. He was held on a \$10,000 Surety bond.




I conducted a motor vehicle stop on Washington Street by Pearl Street. Upon making contact with the

REMARKS

On 3/16/16 at 1427 hours, I responded to 416 East Main St, Stop & Shop, for a Shoplifter.

Upon arrival on the scene, Loss Prevention Officer, stated that she had observed Ms. Rocco pass several items across the self scan isle without scanning them. Ms. Rocco put them in a bag and left the store making no attempt to pay. stated that Ms. Rocco visibly intentionally did not pay for the items. One of the store manager's approached and stated that he had observed Ms. Rocco do this same thing multiple times in the past.


