REMARKS

On 22 May 2016 at 1236 hours, I, Ofc. Arroyo was dispatched to the area of #45 Wyllys Avenue for a reported Suspicious Person. Central Dispatch advised me that the complainant is reporting a white male with a mustache, approximately 6'02" tall and wearing a black Wesleyan hat backwards, black pants and a

black Polo is walking up to females attempting to grab them and kiss them.

Ofc. Foster, Ofc. Lemieux, Ofc. Puorro & Ofc. Murphy also arrived on scene.

Upon arrival to #45 Wyllys Ave. I began walking to the rear of the building as directed by Central Dispatch. I was told that the male was standing under a light pole at which time I located the complainant; I (21 YO) who was at this time on the phone with dispatch awaiting our arrival. She immediately pointed out the suspect who was later identified as Alexander Blundon (29 YO) by his Colorado Operators License #12-314-0532. I observed that Blundon fit the description provided by the dispatch.

I began speaking with Blundon and immediately observed that he appeared to be under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol. I asked him if he had any weapons on his person. He reached down for his pockets and stated no. I advised him to keep his hands out of his pockets and grabbed a hold of his left wrist to prevent him from reaching into his pocket. I asked him to place his hands behind his back for a pat down. As I was holding his hands behind his back and patting down the exterior of his clothing I felt Blundon attempting to pull his hands from my hold. I advised him to relax and stop pulling his hands away. I advised Blundon that at this time he was not under arrest but being detained until further investigation.

I attempted to handcuff Blundon and placed one handcuff on his right wrist. Blundon suddenly turned around and pulled his hands away. I instantly felt pain to my right pinky as it briefly got caught in the handcuffs when Blundon pulled away. Ofc. Lemieux, Ofc. Murphy and I then attempted to grab a hold of Blundon. Blundon was actively resisting and attempting to pull away from us. The fact that he had one handcuff posed a dangerous situation for both Blundon and officers on scene as the handcuffs could be used as a dangerous weapon. We then brought him to the ground as he continued to resist and not comply with our commands. We were able to gain control of Blundon's hands and handcuff him. He was positioned to his stomach and attempted to kick his legs toward officers on scene. I crossed Blundon's legs and held them down to prevent him from assaulting anyone on scene.

I then searched Blundon's pockets and located a small ziplock bag containing a white powdery substance I was able to identify as suspected cocaine. Blundon continuously asked what was going on and why he was being arrested. It was explained to him numerous times that he was being arrested for breach of peace, interfering with a police investigation and the possession of narcotics. He continually asked throughout the entire incident.

Blundon actively resisted and was uncooperative throughout the entire arrest process. It took several attempts to secure him in a police cruiser. He was then transported to police headquarters for processing. Once back at headquarters Blundon remained uncooperative and had to be carried to the EDP cell. He attempted numerous times to run out of the cell before we finally secured the door shut.

At some point during the constant struggle, Ofc. Lemieux obtained a laceration to his right pinky which was actively bleeding.

I then weighed the white powdery substance (suspected cocaine) which gave a weight of 0.49 grams. I then tested it using NARK Kit No. NAR10013 which tests for Cocaine/Crack which presumptively identified trace amounts of Cocaine by turning blue in color. The evidence seized on scene was placed in Evidence Locker #8.

Based on the above facts and circumstances, the injuries that police officers obtained and the initial complaint; Blundon was consequently charged with CGS: 53a-181; Breach of Peace, 53a-167c; Interfering with Police, 53a-167(c); Assault on a Police Officer (2 counts) & 21a-279(a); Possession of Narcotics. He was released on a \$25,000.00 surety bond and is scheduled to appear at court on 06/07/2016 at 0900

hours located at GA:09. Nothing further.

REMARKS

On Wednesday, 05/18/16 at 1325 hours, it was reported that there was a disturbance occurring at the group therapy home at 59 Flynn Lane and that CANDACE YOUNG (a resident of the home) had made threatening remarks the staff.

When police arrived on scene, MS. YOUNG had fled the area. She could be seen up the street and running into a wooded area. Officer's proceeded in the direction of MS. YOUNG and made contact with her and ordered her to stop. She failed to comply and attempted to flee further into the wooded area. She was apprehended and became combative with the police while being taken into custody.

It was reported by staff that during a meeting, MS. YOUNG became angry because she didn't like what had been put in place regarding her living arrangements at the home. MS. YOUNG then began to make statements that caused alarm and concern for the safety and wellbeing of the staff and residents of the

home.

According to two (2) staff members who were interviewed, they stated that MS. YOUNG angrily told them that she was going to kill them. After they locked her out of the home and called the police, she continued to cause a disturbance while yelling and screaming at them. She was also seen picking up stones while outside the home. This caused the staff and residents fear and concern for their safety and wellbeing.

REMARKS

On 5/17/16 at approximately 16:25 hours I Officer Martz, was on routine patrol in the area of North Main St. under the Arrigoni Bridge. At the North end on the road, under the bridge, is a Rail Yard, leased by Providence & Worcester Railroad. As I approached the rail yard, I observed a person, later identified as being Matthew Bailey, walk across the railroad tracks, toward the area of the rail yard. I entered the rail yard, and exited my vehicle to locate the subject.

I located the subject behind a stack of large metal beams. Bailey was holding in his right hand a can of orange colored spray paint, and was spray painting the side of the metal beam. I instructed him to stop, and place the paint on the ground, and he did so. He was positively identified by his CT ID Card.

He admitted to having created the orange colored graffiti tag, which I had observed him make, but did not admit to having tagged any other locations. The graffiti tag in this case was a stylized word "NAPPY". A total of six cans of spray paint were located on Bailey.

Bailey was issued Misdemeanor Summons and Complaint # MC329666 for violation of CGS 53a-117 Criminal Mischief 3rd Degree. He was given a court date of 5/31/16 at 09:00 hours.

REMARKS

On 5/21/16 at approximately 2130 hours, I, Officer Remotti conducted a motor vehicle stop on High Street near Grand Street. During the course of my investigation, I identified the front seat passenger as Anthony William Popadics. When Central Dispatch ran Popadics, a fully extraditable felony arrest warrant was located out of Fulton County Georgia.

A locate was sent to the originating agency, who confirmed the warrant and its fully extraditable status. Popadics confirmed his date of birth, social security number, tattoos, and admitted to being wanted in Georgia. Popadics was then taken into custody without incident and transported to police headquarters. He was advised of his rights, processed, photographed and printed under UAR# 8873057. All charges associated with Popadics' extradition are felonies in Georgia and subject to greater than 1 year punishment.

REMARKS

DOMESTIC

On 5/20/2016, at approximately 2342 hours I, Officer Foster, was dispatched to an address on Ridgewood Road on the report of an unwanted party trying to gain access to the residence. The initial report from dispatch was that the caller's ex-boyfriend, Jadriel Santiago, was in the rear of the house "banging" on the glass door. In addition, according to the caller the accused was asked to leave, however, was refusing. For the remainder of this incident report, the victim will be referred to as "Victim #1".

Victim #1 stated prior to calling the Police, the accused showed up to the rear of the residence unannounced and began to knock loudly on the door. Victim #1 stated that she could see through the glass door the accused who she recognized as Santiago. Victim #1 stated that the accused became belligerent when she would not answer the door and started to hit her

bedroom window with a closed fist. Victim #1 provided a sworn written statement of her account.

A check with dispatched revealed that there was an active court issued Protective Order in place and the accused was not allowed at the residence of Victim #1 nor was he allowed to have any contact with her in any way. In addition, dispatch informed me that the accused was currently on Adult Probation. After a brief canvas of the area, I was unable to locate the accused. I later located the accused at his residence 8 Traverse Square, Middletown. The accused stated, "I know why you are here", and was taken into custody without incident.

The accused was charged with violation of C.G.S. 53a-223* Violation of a Protective Order and violation of C.G.S. 53a-181 Breach of Peace. The accused was held on a 10,000 dollar surety bond and is scheduled to appear at Middlesex Superior Court on May 23, 2016 at 0900 hours.

REMARKS

On 05/20/16 at 6:43 p.m., I, Officer Ortiz was dispatched to in front of 460 Main Street, Middletown on a reported assault complaint.

Eckstein, who was obviously intoxicated, said that he was assaulted by _____ is a middle age black male. He was accompany by his wife, _____, who is a middle age black female. Eckstein said that he was hit in the back of his head, but he had no obvious injury. Eckstein would not answer any of my questions, he just wanted _____ arrested. The landlord, _____, who witnessed the incident said that they prevented Eckstein from entering the building when he tried to gain access via the rear door. _____ said the incident was not physical.

Eckstein kept pointing to _____ and his wife, calling them "fucking niggers." Eckstein was advised numerous times by this officer to stop calling them the "N" word, but he ignored me anyway. The area was heavily populated with pedestrian traffic, many of them family with children's.

As he was walking away, he approached several patrons, who were having dinner outside and told them that he fucking hate niggers. I afforded Eckstein ample opportunity to calm down, however, he turned around and looked at _____ and his wife and continued to call them niggers, dumb niggers. At this point, I

advised Eckstein that he was under arrest.

At police headquarters, he kept repeating that he's a racist and that he hates black people, he wanted me to be aware of it. Eckstein also said that he was going to "kill that fucking nigger" referring to [redacted] when he gets out. His behavior and attitude continued throughout the entire booking process, yelling, screaming and banging on the cage to the booking room.

Eckstein was processed and charged with breach of peace 2nd degree, 53a-181. Eckstein is currently being held in police lockup on a \$2500 surety bond due to the nature of the incident and the threats of violence if he's released.

Case considered closed.

REMARKS

On 5/23/2016, at approximately 0213 hours I, Officer Foster, was conducting parking enforcement on Lincoln Street in a marked Middletown Police cruiser. As I approached the intersection of High Street and Lincoln Street, I observed a white Honda Accord, bearing CT registration AC28476, parked in front of a fire hydrant. As I approached the vehicle on foot, I observed that the vehicle was occupied by a white male operator. I made contact with the operator of the vehicle who was later identified by his Connecticut Driver's License as Michael Rascati.


Rascati stated that he was waiting for his girlfriend to answer his text and was having a cigarette in the meantime. While I was speaking to Rascati I noticed that he appeared to abnormally nervous and had visible shake to his hands when he produced his driver's license. In addition, outside of the driver's window, I observed a torn wax glassine baggie. Through my training and experience, I found illicit narcotics to be sold and packaged in this material. I retrieved the glassine baggie and showed it to Rascati and asked him if it was his. Rascati replied, "No. I have no idea how that got there".

Rascati gave this Officer verbal consent to search his vehicle at which time I located three baggies of suspected heroin and a single Ziploc of suspected cocaine in a Marlboro cigarette pack. Rascati was placed under arrest and transported to Police HQ.

The suspected heroin was weighed to .63 grams using a department scale. The suspected heroin was tested with NARK kit #4 which yielded positive presumptive results for heroin. The small Ziploc baggie was weighed to .37 grams and was tested with NARK kit #3 which yielded positive presumptive results for cocaine.

A check with dispatch revealed that Rascati was currently on DOC parole out of New Haven. Rascati's parole Officer, Giovanna Harris, was contacted and completed a "remand to custody". Rascati was held without bail and will appear in Middlesex Superior Court on May 23, 2016 at 0900 hours. Rascati was charged with two counts of violation of C.G.S. 21a-279(a) Illegal Possession of Narcotics.

On 5/2/16 at approximately 1858 hours central dispatch received an anonymous call that a female, hereinafter referred to as V1 (victim 1), had just been assaulted by her husband, Brian Deren, and had posted photos of the injuries onto her facebook account.

Officers were able to view the photographs on facebook as well as comments made by V1 stating that Deren had assaulted her face with closed fists and that she was fearful to go to police due to the fact that Deren had threatened her and was the sole income earner in the relationship.
