REMARKS

On 5-25-16 I responded to 25 North Main St for the report of an assault and subsequent gunshots. Upon arrival OFC Ortiz was already on scene interviewing some of the people on scene. The victim, was in the ambulance, and Det Semper responded to Middlesex Hospital to interview him. told Det Semper he had just finished giving someone a haircut at 25 North Main St. He went outside and saw a silver color car drive up and Julian Welch exit. He said Welch was driving the car and another male was in the front passenger seat. Julian ran up to him and "threw a punch at him".


said the punch hit the left side of his face and it hurt. Julian began yelling at him asking for \$50.00 that [redacted] owed to him. Julian continued to punch him however [redacted] said he ducked and the punches missed. He was able to get away from him at this point. Julian returned to his vehicle, to the driver's side door which was still open. Julian retrieved a "Rambo" type knife with a long handle and a long blade. He got more specific saying it wasn't a pocket knife, it was a fixed blade, hunting type knife. He said he came toward him with the knife in his right hand. When [redacted] saw the size of the knife he ran to the side of the house (25 North Main) and picked up a glass bottle for self defense. He said when Julian saw he had the bottle he got back into his car and drove away toward Stack St. [redacted] said a few seconds later Julian drove back toward him in the same car. Someone yelled, "He has a gun" and [redacted] said he saw Julian driving and holding the gun in his right hand, but couldn't describe the gun. [redacted] then heard two gunshots as he was diving for the ground to get behind a parked car. He said Julian then drove away. He provided a sworn written statement to the above.


There were three other witnesses on scene and all of their statements matched regarding the assault and shooting that took place. I was told on scene the suspect was described as a black male approximately 6'02" tall with a close shaved beard, tattooed arms wearing cargo shorts and a grey tee shirt. One witness took a photo of the suspect vehicle after the initial assault took place. The photo showed CT registration AA68910 an 2013 Infinity G37 color silver. The vehicle was registered to Julian Welch. Sworn written statements were taken from all three other witnesses.

On scene at 25 North Main St detectives recovered what appeared to be a projectile from a bullet in the middle of the road. There was evidence that a bullet struck a parked car parked outside in the form of a broken window and a hole in the "A pillar". The projectile was no recovered despite efforts by detectives.

Shortly after the scene was cleared on North Main St OFC St Peter radioed he had located the suspect vehicle at 128 Spring St. Two males were detained, Julian Welch and [redacted]. All three witnesses agreed to participate in a show up identification and all three were able to positively identify Welch as the person responsible for both the initial assault on the victim as well as the shooting incident. He was taken into custody and transported to the Middletown Police Department for processing.

Julian Welch was charged with two counts of 53a-49 criminal attempt at assault in the first degree (53a-59). The first count from the part of the incident was when he attempted use a knife to assault the victim and the second from when he fired two gun shots at the victim after threatening to kill him. He was also charged with two counts of 53a-63 reckless endangerment. He was further charged with 53-203 unlawful discharge of a firearm, 53a-271 criminal in possession of a firearm, 29-38 weapon in a motor vehicle, 53a-151a intimidating a witness, and 53a-61 assault in the third degree on UAR 8873072. He was held on a \$500,000.00 surety bond and given a court date of 5-26-16.





REMARKS

On Wednesday 05/25/2016 Middletown Narcotics Detective Dirga and I, Detective Peck, were advised by credible informant who has provided reliable information in the past, that an individual that had active felony arrest warrants for narcotics sales

would be an occupant in a black Volvo sedan, in the area of South Main St. and Warwick St.

As Detective Dirga and I were traveling E/B on Warwick St., we observed the black Volvo traveling W/B on Warwick St., from the area of South Main St. I activated the emergency lights and siren and attempted to conduct a motor vehicle stop on the operator, there was a motor vehicle collision involving the Volvo and our unmarked Police Vehicle.

As the vehicles came to a stop a party, later identified as Oscar Bazemore, rapidly exited the Volvo through the passenger side and began running E/B on Warwick St. Detective Dirga exited our vehicle, made contact with Bazemore and detained him. I cleared the vehicle and determined Bazemore had been the operator and sole occupant.

Upon conducting a search of Bazemore's person, Det. Dirga located a plastic baggie containing a large round piece of an off-white substance, which he immediately recognized as suspected crack cocaine in Bazemore's front pants pocket. Also found in Bazemore's front pocket was, \$937.00 US Currency.

In plain view on the front driver side floor, Sgt. Yepes observed a plastic baggie containing a white powder, which he recognized as suspected cocaine.

Due to the seriousness of the motor vehicle crash, Bazemore was transported to Middlesex Hospital for treatment/evaluation. Upon further searching his pants at the hospital, Lt. Davis located a blue tablet and several empty plastic baggies.

A check of Bazemore's license revealed his operating privileges were suspended 02/02/2009. Bazemore is a convicted felon with 19 previous convictions;

Carrying a pistol without a permit, Strangulation 3rd Degree, Assault 1st Degree (multiple convictions), Reckless Endangerment, Weapon in Motor Vehicle, Assault Personnel (multiple convictions), Possession Drugs/Marijuana (multiple convictions), Possession with Intent, Assault 3rd Degree (multiple convictions), Escape 1st Degree, Sale of Illegal Drugs, Interfering/Resisting, Possession Narcotics (multiple convictions), Failure to Appear 1st Degree, Sale of


Hallucinogen/Narcotic, Probation Violation, Forgery 2nd Degree, Larceny 1st Degree, Larceny 3rd Degree, and Threatening. It was determined that Bazemore was currently on Parole. Per requirements, Bazemore's Parole Officer was advised of the incident and has since filed a Remand to Actual Custody Order.


All contraband located at the scene was transported to MPD HQ where it was weighed by Det. Lathrop for a total weight of, Crack - 15.9 grams, Cocaine - 1.8 grams. Det. Lathrop tested the suspected crack cocaine using NARK Kit #13 which returned a positive result for the presence of cocaine. He then tested the suspected cocaine using NARK Kit #4, which returned a positive result for the presence of cocaine. The blue tablet was tested using NARK Kit #32, which returned a positive result for the presence of MDMA/ecstasy. The items were tagged as evidence and secured in a locker at MPD HQ.

Bazemore was subsequently released from the hospital and transported to Middletown Police HQ where he was read his rights, fingerprinted and processed. He was charged with violations of;

- CGS 21a-279(a) – Possession of Narcotics
- CGS 21a-278(b) – Possession with Intent to Sell
- CGS 21a-279(d) – Possession of Narcotics within 1500' of Daycare
- CGS 53a-167(a) – Interfering with an Officer

Oscar Bazemore was held on a \$250,000.00 Surety bond and issued a court date, at Middletown Superior Court, on 05/26/2016 at 0900 hours.

All contraband located at the scene was transported to MPD HQ where it was weighed by Det. Lathrop for a total weight of, Crack - 15.9 grams, Cocaine - 1.8 grams. Det. Lathrop tested the suspected crack cocaine using NARK Kit #13 which returned a positive result for the presence of cocaine. He then tested the suspected cocaine using NARK Kit #4, which returned a positive result for the presence of cocaine. The blue tablet was tested using NARK Kit #32, which returned a positive result for the presence of MDMA/ecstasy. The items were tagged as evidence and secured in a locker at MPD HQ. Bazemore was subsequently released from the hospital and transported to Middletown Police HQ where he was read his rights, fingerprinted and processed. He was charged with violations of;

CGS 21a-279(a) - Possession of Narcotics

CGS 21a-278(b) - Possession with Intent to Sell

CGS 21a-279(d) - Possession of Narcotics within 1500' of Daycare


CGS 53a-167(a) - Interfering with an Officer
