**REMARKS**

On 13 September 2016 at 0157 hours, I, was dispatched to a residence in Middletown, Connecticut. Central Dispatch advised me that the complainant is reporting that he was attacked by his landlord.

Upon arrival to the residence I made contact with the complainant; Victim #1. He stated that his landlord/ boyfriend; Benjamin Lowry (35 YO) attacked him. I had to ask him a few times why Lowry attacked him and he repeatedly stated "because he is drunk." Victim #1 was hesitant to provide me with information because he "did not want to get his boyfriend in trouble." At this point I observed that it appeared that Victim #1 was under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. I asked him if he had been drinking and he stated "yes."

Victim #1 then admitted that the reason he called 9-1-1 was because Lowry arrived at their residence with his ex-boyfriend; Witness #1. This angered him and an argument ensued. Although he stated that he was attacked, he would not specify as to how it was done. I asked Victim #1 if he was injured and he stated no, but showed me a scratch on his left shoulder that appeared to be old. I did not observe any other visible physical injury on Victim #1's person. I asked Victim #1 where Lowry was at this time and he stated that he was probably at Witness #1's residence. He explained that his vehicle is a silver Nissan Juke.

I then located Lowry at Witness #1;s residence.

I asked Lowry to explain what happened between him and Victim #1. Lowry explained that about a month ago he ended his relationship with Victim #1 and has been trying to get him to move out. He revealed that he is not willing to leave. I explained to Lowry that it would be in his best interest to go through the eviction process to prevent future problems. Lowry then explained that earlier in the night he was hanging out with some friends when Victim #1 became upset with him. Victim #1 then called Lowry and began talking about his two dogs. Lowry explained that he could hear the dogs barking in the background so he went home because he did not want anything to happen to them. When he arrived at the residence with Witness #1 to retrieve his dogs and leave he got into an argument with Victim #1 in the bathroom. Lowry then admitted to pushing Victim #1. Lowry stated that it is not like him to put his hands on someone but Victim #1 kept pushing his buttons. Lowry also admitted to drinking alcohol earlier in the night.

Lowry was consequently issued a Misdemeanor Summons and Complaint ticket #MC330396 for CGS: 53a-182; Disorderly Conduct. He was released on scene with a PTA and is scheduled to appear at GA:09 on September 13, 2016 at 0900 hours. I also issued Lowry a Conditions of Release Family Violence form with all boxes checked.

I asked Poole where her child was and Poole stated on the second floor.

Officer Waugh stayed with A. Poole and I walked up the stairs to the main living area of the residence. On the second floor I gave an announcement of Middletown Police. A male appeared from the rear of the residence who would be identified as [redacted] and another male who would be identified as [redacted]. I observed that the living conditions on the second floor were horrible, trash, garbage, soiled diapers, dirty dishes, spoiled food left out everywhere.

Based on my observation I requested a supervisor to respond to the scene. Lt. Desena responded to the scene. I asked [redacted] where his son was and [redacted] stated that he was in the back bedroom. I asked [redacted] if the bedroom was his son's or his. [redacted] stated that it was his bedroom and A. Poole's. [redacted] walked into his bedroom and closed the door behind him. [redacted] emerged from the bedroom

with juvenile #1. I immediately observed that the juvenile was rail thin, had a bandage on his forehead, dark circles under his eyes and was only wearing a diaper which was full and appeared to be 6-7 years in age. [redacted] stated that his son was autistic and would not really talk to me. I asked [redacted] why the juvenile was wearing a diaper that was completely full and [redacted] did not answer my question. Based on my observation I requested that a detective respond from the Special Investigations Unit. [redacted] further appeared that Juvenile #1 was malnourished. I asked [redacted] why his son was not going to school and [redacted] stated that he did not like the school that he was attending in town.

I stated to [redacted] that I was going to request an ambulance to arrive at the scene to do an evaluation on his wife and his son. Lt. Desena arrived on scene. Hunters paramedics arrived on scene.

I further contacted the Department of Children's and Family's to make an oral report over the phone which was made to [redacted]. I further requested that a D.C.F. worker respond to the scene. Detective Puorro from S.I.U. responded to the scene.

DCF worker, [redacted] began speaking to [redacted] Poole in the living room I walked into the back bedroom where Juvenile #1 originally came out of. I observed approximately 10-15 empty and half full bottles of liqueur which were all over the place and were in reach of Juvenile #1. I further observed from training and experience empty clear plastic baggies that were torn open at the end that once contained narcotics. These baggies were in plain view and throughout the bedroom.







## REMARKS

On Wednesday, 09/07/16 at approximately 0135 hours, I, Officer Jeffries observed a motor vehicle bearing CT registration 2973CL traveling unreasonably fast in a easterly direction on Washington Street.

I pulled out of CVS and was traveling approximately sixty (60) miles per hour to keep up with this vehicle. The posted speed limit on Washington Street is thirty-five (35) miles per hour. I activated my emergency lights and conducted a motor vehicle stop of this vehicle at Sunoco on Washington Street(519 Washington Street).

Once the vehicle stopped in the parking lot of Sunoco, the operator, Isaias Calderon immediately got out of the vehicle and began to walk into Sunoco. I explained to him the reason for the traffic stop and told him he was not allowed to go into Sunoco at this time.

During my initial investigation, Isaias stated he fully understood English and was communicating without issues. When I asked for his license, registration and insurance, Isaias began to tell me, in English, that he did not understand English and began to be uncooperative.

I asked Isaias for his name and date of birth and he provided me with false information. I observed a passport in the vehicle and was able to positively identify Isaias Calderon with his passport.

An inquiry was made with Middletown dispatch on Isaias Calderon's license, which came back suspended indefinitely with a three hundred (300) number, License # 300895151.

Isaias was issued a Misdemeanor Summons MC397012 for violations of C.G.S. 14-218a, Traveling Unreasonably Fast, 14-215(a), Operating while License Suspended.

Isaias is scheduled to appear at Middletown Superior Court, GA-09, on Wednesday, 09/21/16 at 0900 hours.

On 9/1/2016, at 1256 hours, the accused was involved in a motor vehicle collision on Newfield Street, in the area of # 1003. The accused was operating an unregistered and uninsured motor vehicle.


The accused was traveling northbound on Newfield Street, when she lost control of her vehicle. The roadway was wet from a rain shower. When she attempted to stop her vehicle, she began to skid. This caused her to make an evasive move to the right and off the roadway. She initially avoided the stopped vehicles in front of her, passing them on the right. Unfortunately she was not able to avoid the utility pole on the right shoulder. The collision cause heavy damage to the vehicle and the pole.

Due the force of the collision, the vehicles transmission apparently went into reverse causing the vehicle to back up at a forceful speed colliding into the two vehicles that she initially avoided. Minor injuries were reported by their occupants.

After the accused was transported to Middlesex Hospital for minor injuries, Dispatch advised that the vehicle had a cancelled registration plate. The accused advised that the vehicle was previously owned by her sister. She had cancelled the registration and the vehicle was hers now. She said it was not registered or insured. In addition to these charges she was charged with traveling too fast for conditions. She was issued MSC # MC 228005, and scheduled to appear in court on 9/15/16.

## REMARKS

On 09/12/2016 at approximately 1830 hours, Officer Haddad and I, Officer DiMassa went to Suffield Police Department to pick up James Cillizza who had an active arrest warrant out of Middletown stemming from a domestic violence incident that occurred on or about 8/17/16.

When transfer of custody was given to this officer, I placed Cillizza in the rear seat of my cruiser for transport to police headquarters. On 9/12/16 at approximately 1907 hrs, Officer Terribile and I, Officer Tiano, responded to 656 Main Street for a reported domestic between a male and female. Prior to our arrival, it was reported that a white female wearing a pink shirt and a white male wearing a tye dye t-shirt where in a physical fight.

While walking to this location from the area of Main Street and Green Street, we were approached by numerous people who were stating that a male and female were in a physical fight and pointed towards VICTIM 1 and OFFENDER 1. One of these witnesses were identified as WITNESS 1, who is the mother of OFFENDER 1.

WITNESS 1 agreed to provide a sworn written statement where she described how she saw OFFENDER 1 slap VICTIM 1 in the face multiple times and kick him in the legs. The witness also stated she knew her daughter was a frequently PCP user and was believed to be under the influence today.

During interview of VICTIM 1, he claimed OFFENDER 1 had slapped him in the face during an argument,

kicked him in the legs and smashed his phone on the ground. VICTIM 1 refused to provide a reason as to why OFFENDER 1 did this other than that she was in a bad mood and angry with him. In viewing VICTIM 1's face where he claimed to be slapped, I saw redness in the area of the left side of his mouth near his left cheek, however he claimed this was not caused by OFFENDER 1.

During interview of OFFENDER 1, she refused to make any statements at this time nor were any injuries observed on her person.

Both of whom reported OFFENDER 1 had slapped VICTIM 1 in the face numerous times and smashed his phone on the ground during an argument. OFFENDER 1 was charged with the offense of C.G.S. 53a-181 Breach of Peace.




