**REMARKS**

On September 11, 2016 at approximately 2301 hours Officer Milardo and I were dispatched to Corner Pocket Bar and Grill located at 73 Ferry Street for a report of a man named Kevin Kinckman in a white Chrysler Lebaron who had a firearm on him and was threatening to kill himself. The caller stated Kinckman had displayed a bullet and handed it to someone in the bar.

Upon arrival, Kinckman was located in the vehicle matching the description given by the caller. Officer Tiano, Officer Terribile, and Officer St. Peter made contact with Kinckman, removed him from his vehicle, and placed him under an investigative detention. Kinckman had a firearm carry permit in Connecticut. A

cursory search of the vehicle was conducted. Due to Kinckman showing that he had ammunition for a firearm, there was reasonable suspicion to believe there could possibly be a firearm in Kinckman's vehicle. Officer St. Peter located a handgun in the trunk of Kinckman's vehicle. The handgun was a Ruger P89DC 9MM. There was one magazine included with the handgun with 4 bullets in it. There were 2 other bullets located on Kinckman's person. Dispatch checked Kinckman's information including any firearms registered to him. Dispatch confirmed he only had one firearm registered to him and it was the one currently in our possession.

While Kinckman was detained, I went to speak to his girlfriend. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that Kinckman had come into the bar to drink and she began serving him. \_\_\_\_\_ stated she served Kinckman at least two vodka and juice drinks and possibly a third. During the course of the night, \_\_\_\_\_ stated her friend who was no longer present, had made the bar manager aware of the fact that Kinckman was carrying a gun on him. \_\_\_\_\_ stated her manager \_\_\_\_\_ made her aware of the situation. Kinckman was apparently upset about something that had to do with \_\_\_\_\_, but she was unaware of what it could be. \_\_\_\_\_ said Kinckman then approached her and placed a bullet in her hand and told her he had a gift for her. Kinckman then left the bar and texted \_\_\_\_\_ saying he was going to kill himself. \_\_\_\_\_ then called the Police after being made aware of Kinckman's statements. \_\_\_\_\_ stated at no time did anyone feel as if they were in danger, but they were concerned for Kinckman's well being. \_\_\_\_\_ showed me the text on her phone from Kinckman which stated he was going to kill himself. \_\_\_\_\_ provided a sworn written statement detailing the incident.

I then spoke to Kinckman who admitted to handing a bullet to \_\_\_\_\_. Kinckman stated he knew he had made a mistake and was not even sure why he had done that in the first place. Kinckman said he had been speaking to a couple of guys in the bar who he did not know, and one of them told him that he was sleeping with \_\_\_\_\_. Kinckman became upset after hearing that his girlfriend was possibly cheating on him with another guy. Kinckman denied wanting to kill himself and stated he had made those statements out of anger to get a reaction out of \_\_\_\_\_. It should be noted that Kinckman had a heavy odor of alcohol emanating from his breath.

Kinckman was placed under arrest and transported to Middletown Police headquarters where he was read his rights, fingerprinted, and processed. Kinckman was charged with Disorderly Conduct (53a-182) and Carrying a firearm while intoxicated (52-206d). Kinckman was released on a \$5,000 non-surety bond pending his appearance in court on September 26, 2016 at GA9 at 0900 hours.


**REMARKS**



**REMARKS**

The Middletown Police Department Narcotics Unit continually receives information regarding illegal drug activity from reliable confidential informants, informants, arrested persons, concerned citizens, anonymous callers and brother police officers. During the month of September 2016, the Narcotics Unit has received reports from the above mentioned sources that John Mengual has been selling marijuana throughout the Middletown area while making food deliveries for local restaurants. Detectives were advised Mengual operated a white, late model Pontiac Grand Prix with CT Combination plates, and a broken driver's side mirror. The information supplied advised that Mengual normally carries 3-4 ounces of packaged marijuana while making his deliveries.

On Friday 09/16/2016 at 1740 hours, Det. Lathrop and I, Det. Peck, were traveling S/B on Pearl St. behind a white 2006 Pontiac Grand Prix bearing CT COMBO registration 3419CX. We observed the vehicle was missing the driver side mirror.

As the vehicle approached the intersection of Pearl St. and Court St., Det. Lathrop enacted our vehicles emergency lights and siren initiating a motor vehicle stop. The operator immediately pulled to the right and stopped. It should be noted that the location of the motor vehicle stop was approximately 1266' from Traverse Square, Middletown Public Housing area, and approximately 1041' from Idella Howell Child Development Center.

Upon making contact with the operator and sole occupant of the vehicle, identified by his CT Driver's License as John Mengual, Det. Lathrop advised him of the broken mirror and requested his registration and insurance paperwork.

Det. Lemieux, Det. Dirga, Off. Ortiz and K9 Off. Schreiner arrived on scene. While Mengual was seated in the vehicle, Det. Dirga noticed the odor of marijuana emanating from the interior of the vehicle. Det. Dirga advised Mengual that he could smell marijuana and asked him to step out of the vehicle. He was advised that he was being detained.

When Mengual was asked about the odor, he began asking again why he was pulled over. He avoided the question about marijuana until he was asked a second time. Mengual then stated there was a small amount of marijuana in a pouch located behind the front passenger seat.

Det. Lathrop opened the door and located a small zippered pouch in the area and removed it from the vehicle. Upon opening the pouch, Det. Lathrop observed a clear plastic baggie containing a green-leafy substance which he immediately recognized as suspected marijuana. Later weighed on a Department scale for a total of 2.8 grams.

Mengual was asked if there was any additional marijuana in the vehicle and Mengual responded that there was not. Off. Schreiner and his K9 partner "Otto" then conducted a search of the interior of the vehicle.

In the center console of the vehicle, Off. Schreiner/Otto located;

A silver Digiweigh scale with marijuana residue on the weighing surface.

A metal marijuana grinder with residual amount of suspected marijuana.

(2) glass pipes with marijuana residue.

Based on the contraband found, Det. Dirga advised Mengual of his Miranda Rights.

Under the front passenger seat, Off. Schreiner/Otto located a brown metal tin containing (9) bags of a green-leafy substance which he suspected to be marijuana. Later weighed on Department scale --

11.4 grams

In the trunk of the vehicle, Off. Schreiner/Otto located a black plastic bag containing (2) large bags of a green-leafy substance which he suspected to be marijuana. Later weighed on a Department scale –

26.8 grams

28.1 grams

TOTAL (trunk) – 54.9 grams

Throughout the vehicle, Detectives located (8) empty plastic baggies with residual amounts of marijuana. No additional contraband was found in the vehicle.

Based on the evidence, John Mengual was transported to Middletown Police Department. Upon arrival, Mengual was again advised of his rights and acknowledged them in writing.

The amount of marijuana found in Mengual's possession (much more than personal use) in conjunction with the manner of packaging and the digital scale led to the determination that Mengual is actively conducting drug sales utilizing his vehicle. Based on the investigation, Mengual was advised that Detectives would be applying for a search warrant for his residence. Mengual stated that he would sign a consent form to avoid the search warrant process.

Upon arrival at Mengual's residence, Sgt. Yepes, Det. Lathrop and Det. Lemieux made contact with his father and advised him of the situation. They informed him of the consent to search Mengual's bedroom and were escorted to the room. In an envelope located in Mengual's top desk drawer, Det. Lemieux located an envelope containing \$540.00 US currency. The money was seized. No additional contraband was located in his bedroom. The currency was transported to Middletown Police HQ where it was tagged as evidence/asset forfeiture and secured in an evidence locker.

Mengual was photographed, fingerprinted and processed. He was charged with violations of;

CGS 21a-278a(b)-Possession of Drugs Within 1500'

CGS 21a-267(a)-Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

CGS 21a-277(b)-Possession of Drug With Intent to Sell

CGS 21a-279(a)-Possession of More Than 4 Ounces of Marijuana


CGS 14-99-Missing/Broken Mirror

The marijuana seized was transported to Middletown Police Department where it was tested and weighed by Det. Lathrop. The suspected marijuana weighed a total of 114 grams (4.07 ounces) and tested positive for the presence of THC using NARK Kit #9. It was then secured in an evidence locker.

John Mengual has been previously convicted of Disorderly Conduct, and Operating Under Suspension.

John Mengual was released on a \$50,000.00 non-surety bond and issued a court date, at Middletown Superior Court, on 09/30/2016, at 0900 hours.

### REMARKS

On 9/27/2016, at approximately 1539 hours, Officers were dispatched to the area of Sal's Package Store (326 East Main St) on the report of a possible car jacking. Upon my arrival, I met with the victim who was present in front of Sal's Package Store. The victim was suffering from what appeared to be a laceration below her right eye and her right eye was swollen shut. The victim was bleeding heavily from her facial area and nose. Witnesses on scene reported seeing the victim getting assaulted inside a orange colored Mazda driven by a black male. They reported that the black male was operating this Mazda while assaulting the victim in the back seat. It was reported that the vehicle took off while the rear door was open

and the victim's feet were hanging out of the vehicle. A witness followed the vehicle onto Hillside Avenue where the black male exited the vehicle and entered a residence on Hillside Avenue.


Officers responded to the residence that the suspect reportedly entered and located a black male fitting the description of the suspect hiding in a closet. The black male was identified as Karl Smith. Smith was detained until the victim positively identified him through a "Show Up" identification as the person who assaulted her.

In summary, the victim explained that she was in the vehicle with Smith and her boyfriend when they went to Sal's Package Store. When the boyfriend exited the vehicle to enter the package store, the victim and Smith began to argue due to Smith having the boyfriend's vehicle for an extended amount of time. It was determined that the boyfriend had previously loaned Smith his Mazda.

The victim explained that her boyfriend went inside to make a purchase when Smith unprovoked began to strike her in the face with closed fists while she was in the back seat of the vehicle. The victim explained that she tried to exit the vehicle to flee, however, Smith put the vehicle into reverse and fled with her trapped in the vehicle. The victim stated she was screaming for help and told him to stop the vehicle. Smith eventually deserted the vehicle on Hillside Avenue and fled on foot. The victim stated with what little effort she had left she drove the vehicle back to Sal's package store to notify Police. The victim stated she was struck approximately 10 times in the face by Smith and suffered a broken nose and a fractured orbital. This was confirmed by her provider at Middlesex Hospital. The victim provided a signed written statement.

Smith was charged with violation of C.G.S. 53a-94 Kidnapping 2nd, violation of C.G.S. 53a-95 Unlawful Restraint 1st, and violation of C.G.S. 53a-60 Assault 2nd. Smith was held on \$200,000 surety bond. Smith was unable to post bond and will appear in Middlesex Superior Court on September 28, 2016 at 0900 hours.
