

REMARKS

On 7-18-16 Detective Dirga and I were traveling north on West Lake Drive behind a vehicle bearing CT registration 209VAS. The vehicle's left tail light lens was broken, causing it to emit a constant bright yellow and white light to the rear of the vehicle in violation of CGS 14-96c. The vehicle then failed stop at the stop sign at the intersection of West Lake Dr and Smith St in violation of CGS 14-301.

We followed the vehicle onto Glenwood Rd where Det Dirga attempted to make a motor vehicle stop by activating our

vehicle's emergency lights. At this point the vehicle proceeded even faster and turned north onto East St. From there the vehicle turned left somewhere but I could not tell where as it was so far ahead of us. After canvassing the area, we saw the vehicle again traveling south on East St. We stayed behind the vehicle at a distance and radioed dispatch to get more patrol vehicles in the area, while we were attempting to follow it back to a residence or ending point. OFC Frieman got behind the vehicle on Westfield St and followed it onto Fischer Rd, where it pulled into the driveway of number 45. The operator identified as Craig Outland was taken into custody there. He was transported to the Middletown Police Department for processing. At the police department, Outland was charged with 14-12(a)* operating an unregistered motor vehicle, 14-147(c) misuse of a marker plate, 14-213b failure to have insurance, 14-222 reckless driving, 14-233(a) disobeying an officer's signal, 14-223(b)+ engaging police in a pursuit on UAR 8873248. He was also charged with two counts of 53-21 risk of injury on UAR 8873247. Outland was given a court date of 08-01-2016 at GA-09 in Middletown and released on a \$25,000.00 non-surety bond.

REMARKS

I was able to determine the speed due to the fact that I was keeping pace with the vehicle.

I activated my emergency lights and siren and stopped the vehicle, bearing CT registration 3ANKA1, in the area of DeKoven and Union Street. The driver identified himself as Rodney Johnson, however, it did not possess any form of identification. His identity was confirmed using the Middletown Police in house system, as there was a photograph of Johnson there.

I had Central Dispatch perform an check on Johnson and it was determined that Johnson had a suspended license.

Johnson was arrested. He was charged with Operating with a suspended license. He was issued a misdemeanor summons (MC 378228) and released on scene. He was assigned a court date of 7-22-16. The owner of the vehicle responded and took possession of it. Johnson was issued a verbal warning for traveling fast, the original reason for the stop.

REMARKS

On Tuesday, July 19th, 2016 at 0949 hours, I, Officer Aura Smith and Officer Thompson were dispatched to Middlesex Hospital Emergency Department for the report of a violation of a protective order.

Upon arrival were responded to the 5th floor to speak with a hospital social worker who reported that patient a female patient (victim # 1) is the protected party against a male family member by the name of Maurizio Cardella. Central Dispatch advised the order was active and stipulates no contact between the victim and defendant.

During the investigation it was determined the a male family member visited the victim in the hospital was positively identified the male to be the defendant in the no contact order, Maurizio Cardella.

The accused turned himself into headquarters and was identified via his CT Drivers License. He was processed on the charge of Criminal Violation of a Protective Order in violation of CGS 53a-223*. occupants, we identified ourselves as Police Officers and asked why they were in the park after hours. Juvenile #1 responded that the two were "just hanging out." As we were speaking with occupants we could clearly smell the odor of both burnt and unburnt marijuana emanating from the interior of the vehicle.

Det. Lemieux asked the occupants if there was any marijuana inside the vehicle and both stated there was not. Det. Lemieux then asked Juvenile #1 to exit the vehicle and speak with him. As she was exiting the vehicle, Det. Lathrop made contact with Webb, on the passenger side. While Det. Lathrop was speaking with Webb, I was standing at the open driver side door from which Juvenile #1 had exited. Both Det. Lathrop and I could clearly see a hand rolled cigarette on Webb's lap which appeared to contain marijuana. Det. Lathrop again asked Webb if there was any marijuana in the vehicle and he again stated there was not. Det. Lathrop reached in through the open passenger side window and picked up the marijuana cigarette from Webb's lap and asked him what it was. Webb responded, "Well, that's all there is." Webb was asked if he had identification on him and he stated that he did not. He was then asked to exit the vehicle. Webb exited and Det. Lathrop conducted a search of his person. In Webb's pants pocket, Det. Lathrop located another freshly rolled "blunt" (a cigar wrapper containing marijuana). In Webb's left rear pocket, Det. Lathrop located \$56.00 US Currency. Det. Lathrop asked him again if there was anything else in the vehicle or on his person and again, Webb stated there was not.

Due to the fact we had no positive identification for Webb and were continuing to find additional contraband on his person, Det. Lathrop placed him in handcuffs. Webb was advised that he was not under arrest and was only being detained while we conducted the investigation. As Webb was being walked away from the vehicle by Det. Lathrop, he again asked me why he was being handcuffed for "no reason." I advised Webb that he was being detained due to the fact that he was in possession of illegal drugs, we could not identify him and he had repeatedly lied to us. Webb was not happy with my answer and began to raise his voice and tell me that we had no right to place him in handcuffs. I attempted to explain it to him a third time however he yelled over me while I spoke.

Det. Lathrop stood by with Webb while I conducted a search of the interior of the vehicle. In a blue backpack which was located on the floor in front of the seat where Webb had been seated I located;

1. A black and silver "Digiweigh" scale with marijuana residue.
2. A glass mason jar containing a green leafy substance suspected to be marijuana.
3. (2) plastic baggies containing a green leafy substance suspected to be marijuana.
4. An opened package of cigars.
5. A plastic baggie containing the remnants of an unwrapped cigar.
6. CT Identification card issued to Isiah Webb. (which he claimed not to have)

Webb was advised that he was under arrest and would be transported to Middletown Police Headquarters to be processed. As Det. Lathrop was escorting Webb to a marked Middletown Police vehicle for transport, Webb began to twist his body in an attempt to pull away from him. Det. Lathrop managed to hold onto Webb's arm and keep him from completely pulling away, but not without a slight struggle. I stepped towards the two and placed my hand on Webb's chest in order to keep the two from falling into the side of the suspect vehicle. I advised Webb to calm down and after several seconds he relaxed. He was then secured in a marked vehicle without further incident. As Det. Lathrop placed him in the vehicle Webb stated "Fuck you, you fuckin nigga"

A further search of the vehicle returned negative results. Juvenile #1 identified an iPhone which plugged into the charger, as Webb's phone.

Prior to being transported Webb claimed all the contraband that had been found inside the vehicle and stated the Juvenile #1 was not aware. Due to the fact that Juvenile #1 is only 17 years old, Det. Lemieux made contact with her father, via

telephone and advised him of the situation.

The marijuana seized from Webb was later transported to Middletown Police Headquarters where Det. Lemieux weighed it, on a department scale, for a total of 30.8 grams and tested it, using NARK kit #8, which returned a positive result for the presence of THC. The marijuana was tagged as evidence and secured in an evidence locker.


All additional items listed were also tagged as evidence and secured in the locker.


Upon arrival at MPD HQ Isiah Webb was advised of his rights, which he waived in writing. He stated to Det. Lathrop that he "shoulder checked" him to get his attention away from Juvenile #1 and that it was "just a little weed."

Webb was charged with violations of CGS 21a-279(b) – Possession of Marijuana Under 4 Ounces, CGS 21a-277(a) – Possession of Marijuana With Intent to Sell, CGS 53a-167a – Interfering/Resisting.

He was held on a \$10,000.00 Surety bond and issued a court date, at Middletown Superior Court, on 07/20/2016 at 0900 hours.



She said that he had hit her so hard that she saw lights and instantly got a headache. There were no visible marks on her face. The victim said that she didn't know if he had punched her with a fist or open hand. The victim refused medical treatment. The victim said that her husband then said that he'll be gone, she'll be gone and there's one more and he pointed to their daughter's room. She told him that was the Muslim in him and then she called the Police and he left. The victim is concerned for the safety of her and her children.

The accused was found walking on South Main Street and Officer Vinci transported him back. The accused


agreed that they had argued over money but denied punching the victim but said that his elbow might have hit her face. He denied making any threats towards her or his children. However the accused was difficult to understand because of his heavy accent.
